



This year we marked 50 years since our beautiful church was built. It certainly is an occasion for us to celebrate!

Exactly what have we seen over these last 50 years at St. Bernadette? How many souls have been changed? How many people have been brought into the Catholic Church? How many of our young people have we sent into the world with a Catholic foundation to face the world? How many weddings, baptisms, funerals and First Masses can one church have? If the past 50 years are any indication, there are no limits with our God.

We can't imagine the extraordinary things that God is going to do in the next 50 years.
