Easter Duty Obligation

After they have received their First Holy Communion, Catholics are bound by the obligation of receiving Holy Communion at least once a year. This precept should be fulfilled during the Easter Season. Catholics are also bound to confess serious (mortal) sins at least once a year, but this is not limited to the Lenten/Easter Season. The time for fulfilling the Paschal Precept (Easter Duty*) extends from the First Sunday of Lent, February 19, 2021 to the Solemnity of the Holy Trinity, May 30, 2021.



A READING FROM THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO JOHN

On the evening of that first day of the week, when the doors were locked, where the disciples were, for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood in their midst and said to them, "Peace be with you." When he had said this, he showed them his hands and his side. The disciples rejoiced when they saw the Lord. Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you." And when he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit.

Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained." Thomas, called Didymus, one of the Twelve, was not with them when Jesus came. So the other disciples said to him, "We have seen the Lord." But he said to them, "Unless I see the mark of the nails in his hands and put my finger into the nail marks and put my hand into his side, I will not believe." Now a week later his disciples were again inside and Thomas was with them. Jesus came, although the doors were locked, and stood in their midst and said, "Peace be with you." Then he said to Thomas, "Put your finger here and see my hands, and bring your hand and put it into my side, and do not be unbelieving, but believe." Thomas answered and said to him, "My Lord and my God!" Jesus said to him, "Have you come to believe because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed." Now Jesus did many other signs in the presence of his disciples that are not written in this book. But these are written that you may come to believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that through this belief you may have life in his name.





FIESTA DE LA DIVINA MISERICORDIA

La Fiesta de la divina Misericordia es el domingo siguiente a la Pascua de Resurrección. Jesús prometió a santa Faustina su misericordia: el perdón total de los pecados y penas a quien ese día comulgue. Esto significa que la persona si confiesa y comulga ese día gana inmediatamente indulgencia plenaria, y obtiene el perdón total de las penas y culpas merecidas por haber pecado, es decir al perdonar todos los pecados, y no hay penas que purgar en el purgatorio. Esta fiesta ha sido declarada oficial en la liturgia por la Iglesia católica el rito romano en el año 2000.

Santa Faustina Kowalska escribió en su diario, en relación a la fiesta, las siguientes palabras que ella experimentó en su interior que Jesús le decía:

Deseo que la Fiesta de la Misericordia sea refugio y amparo para todas las almas, especialmente para los pobres pecadores. En ese día se abrirán las puertas de Mi Misericordia. Derramo todo un mar de gracias sobre las almas que se acercan a la fuente de Mi Misericordia. El alma que se confiese y reciba la Santa Comunión obtendrá el perdón total de las culpas y de las penas. En ese día están abiertas todas las compuertas divinas a través de las cuales fluyen las gracias. Que ningún alma tema acercarse a Mi, aunque sus pecados sean como escarlata. [...] Esta fiesta, nacida de lo íntimo de Mi Misericordia, queda confirmada en sus profundidades. [...] Hija Mía, di que esta fiesta ha brotado de las entrañas de Mi Misericordia para el consuelo del mundo entero. Diario 699, 420, 1517

Esta gracia, como explica el padre profesor Ignacy Różycki, es mayor que la indulgencia plenaria: Consiste sólo en el perdón de las penas temporales debidos a los pecados cometidos, pero nunca se trata del perdón de las culpas mismas. Esta gracia particular también es mayor que los seis sacramentos, excepto el sacramento del santo Bautismo; esto es así porque el perdón de todas las culpas y penas es sólo una gracia sacramental reservada al sacramento del bautismo. En cambio, en las promesas de Jesús vinculadas con la Fiesta, el Señor asoció el perdón de culpas y penas a la Santa Comunión recibida el día de la fiesta, es decir, al hecho de comulgar en la Fiesta de la Misericordia; con ello, Jesús elevó la Sagrada Comunión recibida en este día al rango de un “segundo bautismo”.
