

The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

AUGUST 15, 2021

Mary's Assumption has many meanings. For the American worker it comes along at a time when it's too hot to work and too late for a vacation. For the school child, it's one of the impossible Latin words that he/she always gets mixed up with the Ascension and he/she can't spell either one.

Mary's Assumption, however, means much more than that. We call it Her Crowning Feast because it is the logical result of Her dignity as the Immaculate Virgin Mother of God. She gave all the credit to God by saying simply; "From henceforth all generations shall call me Blessed for He Who is Mighty hath done great things to me and Holy is His name." What Mary was saying is that all credit goes to God, and yet that Her own participation in giving Christ His flesh was so marvelous a deed that people (all generations) to the end of time will not be able to exhaust the honor due Her as His mother.

Mary's Assumption has two distinct aspects:

- 1) Her bodily Assumption into Heaven.
- 2) Her Coronation in Heaven with all the pomp and circumstance that only Heaven can lavish and which we poor mortals can scarcely imagine.



Mary's Assumption has a much more personal meaning for us. It is both a reminder and a rebuke. It comes along in the middle of August each year to remind us of the age-old fundamental Catholic truth of the existence of Heaven. It is a rebuke to our society which has lost the meaning and importance of Christian modesty!

Regarding Registering in the Parish...

Please keep in mind that if you are not receiving envelopes or regular mailings from us and you usually join us for worship please register! *You are important to us and hopefully we are to you.* Let us know who you are. Registration forms can be taken from a yellow binder placed in the vestibule of the Church. Registration in the Parish facilitates access to PREP-Religious Education and other Parish ministries. Also, it enables the parish to provide Certificates of Eligibility to serve as Sponsors at Baptism and Confirmation.

Sacrament of Baptism

Baptisms are celebrated the 4th Saturday of the month at 11:00AM. Please call the Parish office to make the necessary arrangements two months prior to the Baptism date. Parents are expected to attend a Pre-Jordan Baptism class which is to be held on the Last Friday of every month at 7:00PM in the Rectory.

REQUIREMENTS FOR SPONSORING A CHILD FOR BAPTISM/CONFIRMATION

1. Baptized Catholic having received the Sacrament of Confirmation
2. 16 years of age or older
3. Single or married according to the Church's Law, i.e. not a civil ceremony.
4. Attend Mass faithfully on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation
5. If not registered in this Parish must present a Sponsorship Letter from the Parish that he/she belongs.

Sacrament of Marriage

Couples planning to marry at St. Gianna are expected to contact the Priest to arrange a date and time FIRST. Second, they must attend the Pre-Cana conferences as mandated by the Most Reverend Bishop. The period of preparation for marriage is a minimum of six months to ensure completion of all arrangements before the wedding day. Please contact the Parish office for more information.

Where did holy days of obligation come from?

Saturday is the Sabbath, but Sunday is the day of the Lord (the day of Resurrection), and Christians worshipped Christ as the Son of God on Sunday from the very beginning, even when they were still part of the Jewish religion. But where did the other days come from? Christianity was born from Judaism and the Jewish religion is loaded with religious feasts and holidays that commemorate a religious event in salvation history, seek God's blessings on seasons of the year for bountiful harvest, or celebrate mysteries of faith.

Likewise, the Christian Church developed its own religious feasts and holidays in addition to the regular Sunday worship of God. The first and foremost holy day is Easter because it is the day of Resurrection. Forty days after Easter, Jesus ascended into heaven, so the feast of the Ascension soon followed. Ten days later, and fifty days after Easter, the Holy Spirit came upon the apostles and the Virgin Mary in the upper room at Pentecost.

After deciding on a liturgical celebration of the birth of Christ (December 25), eight days later would have been his circumcision, so January 1 was initially when that feast was celebrated. Later, that date changed to the feast of Mary, the Mother of God (after the Second Vatican Council). Twelve days after Christmas (January 6) is the feast of Epiphany, which is a holy day in most of the world. In United States, it is celebrated on the first Sunday after New Year's. The Assumption (August 15) and Immaculate Conception (December 8) of the Virgin Mary go back to antiquity, but are not considered the actual historical calendar dates since those specifics are unknown. All Saints Day (November 1) is better known by the secular world as the day after Halloween. The word Halloween actually means "All Hallows' Eve." Hallows is an old English word for Saints.

Catholics in England and in the American Colonies until 1777 had thirty-four holy days of obligation. The following year, Pope Pius VI reduced them to eleven. The 1983 Code of Canon Law lists ten universal holy days, but national conferences of bishops can ask for dispensations from particular holy days for their countries. The ten universal holy days are:

Immaculate Conception (December 8) - Christmas (December 25) - Mary, the Mother of God (January 1) - Epiphany (January 6) - Solemnity of St. Joseph (March 19) - Sts. Peter & Paul (June 29) - Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary (August 15) - All Saints (November 1) - Ascension of the Lord (40 days after Easter) - Corpus Christi (sixty days after Easter)

The USA is exempt from four of those ten and therefore has six holy days of obligation

- 1)** Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God. **2)** Solemnity of the Ascension. **3)** Solemnity of the Assumption
- 4)** Solemnity of All Saints. **5)** Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception. **6)** Solemnity of the Nativity of our Lord



THE LORD'S REAL PRESENCE



El 15 de Agosto se celebra el dogma católico de la Asunción de María, la madre de Jesús, a los cielos. El Papa Pío XII definió como dogma de fe la Asunción de María al cielo en cuerpo y alma el 1 de Noviembre de 1950. Es una de las celebraciones más solemnes de la Iglesia.

La Asunción de María tiene muchos significados. La Asunción de María, sin embargo, significa mucho más que eso. La llamamos la Fiesta de su Coronación, ya sabes, porque es el resultado lógico de su dignidad como la Virgen Inmaculada Madre de Dios. Le dio todo el crédito a Dios al decir simplemente: "De aquí en adelante todas las generaciones me llamarán Bienaventurada, porque Aquel que es Poderoso hizo grandes cosas para mí y Santo es Su nombre." Lo que María estaba diciendo es que todo el crédito va a Dios, y sin embargo su propia participación en dar a Cristo su carne fue una acción tan maravillosa que las personas (todas las generaciones) hasta el fin del tiempo no podrán agotar el honor debido a Ella como su Madre.

La Asunción de María tiene dos aspectos distintos:

- 1) Su Asunción corporal al cielo.

La Asunción de María tiene un significado mucho más personal para nosotros. Es a la vez un recordatorio y un reproche. Viene a mediados de agosto cada año para recordarnos la antigua verdad católica fundamental de la existencia del Cielo. Es un reproche a nuestra sociedad que ha perdido el significado y la importancia de la modestia cristiana.
