Feast of Christ The King

Kings and Queens are not part of my experience of life. The names of kings and queens who are surviving today in our world do not easily come to mind. I can think of England and Queen Elizabeth. I can think in all the pomp and circumstance which surrounds her life. I can think of all the respect which the English people have for her.

But the word "KING" recalls a type of government that exists today in very few places. When I think about kings, I think of their power and their majesty, but the humanness escapes me. They don't seem to be like the rest of us humans. Their lives don't seem to be theirs. From time to time, kings and queens seem to be people that are brought out, dusted off and displayed in huge parades.

- ◆ Christ, our King, is not that kind of a king.
- ◆ Christ, our King, did not sit on a gold-plated throne.
- ◆ Christ, our King, got down on His knees and washed the feet of His Apostles and told us to do the same.
- ◆ Christ, our King, forgave the adulteress when everybody else was ready to stone her.
- ◆ Christ, our King, told us to forgive those who offend us when everybody else was preaching revenge.
- ◆ Christ, our King told us to be loving, understanding, and compassionate as He was.
- ◆ Christ, our King, was described as a friend of the publicans and sinners.



Among all of His followers were the outcasts of society. Christ our King, high on that hill called Calvary, was crucified, nailed to a cross and shared that spotlight with two criminals. Tradition has given names to these two criminals. One of the two criminals, named Gestas by tradition, joined the crowd in making fun of Jesus, "If You are the Messiah, save Yourself and us!" But words cannot describe adequately the scene and the interaction which goes on between Christ the King and the other criminal which tradition names, Dismas.

I cannot read those lines without chills running up and down my spine. It's one of the most moving and most emotional pictures in all the Bible. It happened when Dismas turned his head towards Jesus and said, "Jesus, remember me when You come into Your Kingdom." Dismas knew that Jesus was not going to get him down off that cross. Jesus was dying and he was dying. Dismas believed that this Man, this Jesus, was Lord of a Kingdom beyond death and the grave. Dismas wanted to be part of that Kingdom. And Jesus turned His head gently towards Dismas and replies with an extreme act of Love "This very day you shall be with Me in Paradise."

This is the kind of king we are honoring today on this great Feast of Christ the King. He is the same King who comes upon our Altar and upon every Catholic Altar all over the world. It is the same King who gives Himself to us in Holy Communion. Perhaps, we need to say more often... "Jesus, remember me."

And then perhaps we will also hear on our deathbed those very moving and reassuring words, "This very day you shall be with Me in Paradise!"



Nuestro Señor Jesucristo, Rey del Universo

Reyes y Reinas no son parte de mi experiencia de vida. Los nombres de los reyes y las reinas de nuestro presente no me vienen fácilmente a la mente. Cuando pienso en Inglaterra y en la reina Isabel me vienen a la mente la pompa y las circunstancias que rodean su vida y todo el respeto que el pueblo inglés tiene por ella. Pero la palabra "KING" me recuerda un tipo de gobierno que existe hoy en muy pocos lugares.

Cuando pienso en reyes, pienso en su poder y majestad, pero no el pensar en su humanidad se me escapa. No parecen ser como el resto de los seres humanos. Sus vidas no parecen ser de ellos. De vez en cuando, los reyes y las reinas parecen personas que son sacadas, despojadas y exhibidas en enormes desfiles.

*Cristo, nuestro Rey, no es ese tipo de rey.

*Cristo, nuestro Rey, no se sentó en un trono dorado.

*Cristo, nuestro Rey, se arrodilló y lavó los pies de Sus Apóstoles y nos dijo que hiciesemos lo mismo.


*Cristo, nuestro Rey, perdonó a la adúltera cuando todos los demás estaban dispuestos a apedrearla.

*Cristo, nuestro Rey, nos dijo que perdonáramos a los que nos ofenden cuando todo el mundo estaba predicando venganza.

*Cristo, nuestro Rey, nos dijo que fueran amorosos, comprensivos y compasivos como Él era.

*Cristo, nuestro Rey, fue descrito como "un amigo de los publicanos y pecadores."

Entre todos sus seguidores estaban los marginados de la sociedad. Cristo, nuestro Rey, en lo alto de esa colina llamada Calvario, fue crucificado, clavado en una cruz y compartido ese foco con dos criminales. La tradición ha dado nombres a estos dos criminales. Uno de los dos criminales, llamado Gestas por tradición, se unió a la multitud para burlarse de Jesús, "¡Si eres el Mesías, salva a tí mismo ya nosotros!" Pero las palabras no pueden describir adecuadamente la escena y la interacción que se desarrolla entre Cristo Rey Y el otro criminal que la tradición denomina, Dismas. No puedo leer esas líneas sin escalofríos corriendo arriba y abajo de mi espina dorsal. Es una de las imágenes más emocionantes y emocionantes de toda la Biblia.



Sucedió cuando Dismas gira su cabeza hacia Jesús y dice: "Jesús, acuérdate de mí cuando entres en tu reino." Dismas sabía que Jesús no iba a bajarlo de esa cruz. Jesús estaba muriendo y se estaba muriendo. Dismas creyó que este hombre, este Jesús, era Señor de un Reino más allá de la muerte y de la tumba. Dismas quería ser parte de ese Reino. Y Jesús volvió suavemente la cabeza hacia Dismas y respondió con extremo amor: "Este mismo día estarás conmigo en el Paraíso."

Este es el tipo de Rey que estamos honrando hoy en esta gran fiesta de Cristo Rey. Él es el mismo Rey que viene sobre nuestro Altar y en todos los Altares católicos del mundo entero. Es el mismo Rey que se entrega a nosotros en la Santa Comunión.

Tal vez, necesitamos decir más a menudo... "Jesús, acuérdate de mí." Y tal vez también escucharemos en nuestro lecho de muerte esas palabras tan conmovedoras y tranquilizadoras: "Este mismo día estarás conmigo en el Paraíso."
