

St. Gianna Beretta Molla Parish presents a teaching and exposition of Sacred Relics on


**Thursday February 24 at 6:30 pm.**

Father Carlos Martins, a Vatican-appointed expert on relics will be here with an extraordinary Vatican collection of over 150 relics, some as old as 2,000 years. Among the treasures will be relics of St. Joseph, St. Maria Goretti, St. Therese of Lisieux (the "Little Flower"), St. Francis of Assisi, St. Anthony of Padua, St. Thomas Aquinas, and St. Faustina Kowalska. There will also be a portion of the Veil of Our Lady and one of the largest remaining pieces of the True Cross in the world. Those in attendance will be able to examine and venerate each relic. Throughout history, many healings have been worked in the presence of relics; and thousands have occurred through this ministry. Do not miss this opportunity. You are encouraged to bring your articles of devotion (such as rosaries, holy cards, etc.) and pictures of ill friends/family members, which you will be able to touch to the reliquaries as a means of intercession.

# Sacred Relics of the Saints: Treasures of the Church

**Thursday February 24 at 6:30 p.m.**

## **SPECIAL PLENARY INDULGENCE FROM POPE FRANCIS:**

The Holy Father has issued a special plenary indulgence for all attendees of a Treasures of the Church exposition. The indulgence is granted under the usual conditions:

1. Prayer for the Holy Father and for his intentions.
2. Reception of Sacramental Confession within 20 days of attending the exposition.
3. Reception of The Holy Eucharist within 20 days of attending the exposition.
4. Complete detachment from all sin, even venial.

Father Martins will speak to these on the day of the exposition.

### **COST:**

There is no cost for hosting the exposition. This is to allow all parishes – even poor ones – the opportunity to host an exposition. All expenses are absorbed by Treasures of the Church. There is also no collection taken. The only financial commitments to which parishes are obligated are:

1. To allow free will baskets for those who desire to make a donation.
2. To not have any simultaneous collections of fundraising in the church hall during the exposition.

### FIRST READING FROM THE FIRST BOOK OF SAMUEL

In those days, Saul went down to the desert of Ziph with three thousand picked men of Israel, to search for David in the desert of Ziph. So David and Abishai went among Saul's soldiers by night and found Saul lying asleep within the barricade, with his spear thrust into the ground at his head and Abner and his men sleeping around him. Abishai whispered to David: "God has delivered your enemy into your grasp this day. Let me nail him to the ground with one thrust of the spear; I will not need a second thrust!" ## Sagradas Reliquias de los Santos: Tesoros de la Iglesia

Nuestra Parroquia St. Gianna Beretta Molla presentara una enseñanza y exposición de Reliquias Sagradas el dia Jueves 24 de febrero a las 18:30 p.m. El padre Carlos Martins, un experto en reliquias designado por el Vaticano, estará aquí con una extraordinaria colección vaticana de más de 150 reliquias, algunas con una antigüedad de 2000 años.

### LECTURA DEL PRIMER LIBRO DE SAMUEL
