

My Dear Parishioners:

Once again, we find ourselves starting the Holy Season of Lent! Perhaps for many of us this beginning of Lent is a little like the beginning of a New Year. It's time for resolutions, but Lent is not really about changing some small aspect of our behavior. This is not the time to only focus on our diet or try to quit smoking. We can do those things any time of the year. Lent is really about a change of mind and heart, not just about changing some habits we may have picked up along the way. It's important to note that there are basically two holes or empty spaces in our lives.



One kind of empty space is the kind we create ourselves. For example, the man or woman who doesn't work at their marriage is responsible for creating a very dangerous empty space with the idea someone else can fill up that empty space. Or the person who lives a very isolated life, creates an empty space which is open to the temptation of pornography or sexual self-abuse. The person who is never satisfied with what they have creates a space that is open to greed and possessiveness. The second kind of an empty space we do not create. This is the space God has placed within us. It is a restlessness, a yearning for completion which only God can satisfy. When we experience this God-given empty space, and are able to discern exactly what it is, then we must realize it's a sign that we will never be really satisfied until we come face to face with God Who loves us. The danger is when we try to fill this empty God-given space with things not of God! Some examples are: materialism, consumerism, addictions, search for ultimate security, denial, shallow relationships, etc.

And so, as we move into this Lenten Season, it seems that one of our primary tasks is to come to know ourselves better. Self-knowledge is a basic building block of our Spiritual lives. This Lent should be for all of us a time to look deeply into ourselves and discern the empty spaces we find there and, hopefully, during this Lent we will allow Our Lord into those empty parts of our lives.

On behalf of myself, Fr. Mathew and Deacon Del Rossi, we pray your Lent will bring you to a greater self-awareness so you can be filled with the grace of Our Lord Jesus Christ!


Remember, the *kneelers* are for kneeling. We kindly ask that you not use them, up or down, as *foot-rests*. Thank you!

Second, they must attend the Pre-Cana conferences as mandated by the Most Reverend Bishop. The period of preparation for marriage is a minimum of six months to ensure completion of all arrangements before the wedding date. *No Exceptions.*


