



Weekdays of Lent:

There is no obligation to fast. However, voluntary acts of self-denial are recommended.

Ash Wednesday & Good Friday:

These are days of Fast & Abstinence from meat. There is a limit of one full meal on these days for all between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive.

Days of Abstinence: (All Fridays in Lent)

All who have reached their 14th year are bound to abstain totally from meat.

Easter Duty Obligation:

After they have received their First Holy Communion, Catholics are bound by the obligation of receiving Holy Communion at least once a year. This precept should be fulfilled during the Easter Season. Catholics are also bound to confess serious (mortal) sins at least once a year, but this is not limited to the Lenten/Easter Season.

The time for fulfilling the Paschal Precept (Easter Duty) extends from the First Sunday of Lent, March 6, 2022 to the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, June 12, 2022.

CLASSIC ITALIAN CHEESECAKE



- 1 Cup Honey Maid Graham Cracker Crumbs
- 3 Tbsp. butter or margarine, melted
- 2 Tbsp. sugar
- 4 cups Polly-O Original Ricotta Cheese
- 1 1/4 cups of sugar
- 1/4 cup of flour
- 1/2 cup whipping cream
- 2 tsp. vanilla
- 1 tsp. grated lemon peel
- 5 eggs

Preheat oven 350°F if using a silver 9-inch springform pan, or 325°F if using a nonstick 9-inch springform pan. Mix crumbs, butter and 2 tbsp. of sugar. Press firmly in bottom of pan. Bake for 10 minutes. Meanwhile, beat ricotta cheese, 1 1/4 cups of sugar and flour in large bowl with a mixer on medium speed until well blended. Add whipping cream, vanilla and lemon peel. Add eggs, 1 at time, mixing just until blended after each addition. Pour over crumbs. Bake 1 hour and 20 minutes or until center is almost set. Run a knife or metal spatula around rim of pan to loosen cake; cool before removing rim of pan. Refrigerate 4 hours or overnight.

FIRST READING FROM THE BOOK OF GENESIS

The Lord God took Abram outside and said, "Look up at the sky and count the stars, if you can. Just so," he added, "shall your descendants be." Abram put his faith in the LORD, who credited it to him as an act of righteousness. He then said to him, "I am the LORD who brought you from Ur of the Chaldeans to give you this land as a possession." "O Lord GOD," he asked, "how am I to know that I shall possess it?" He answered him, "Bring me a three-year-old heifer, a three-year-old she-goat, a three-year-old ram, a turtledove, and a young pigeon." SEE WITH THE EYES OF CHRIST

LECTURA DEL PRIMER LIBRO DEL GENESIS

En aquellos días, Dios sacó a Abram de su casa y le dijo: “Mira el cielo y cuenta las estrellas, si puedes”. Luego añadió: “Así será tu descendencia.” Abram creyó lo que el Señor le decía y, por esa fe, el Señor lo tuvo por justo. Entonces le dijo: “Yo soy el Señor, el que te sacó de Ur, ciudad de los caldeos, para entregarte en posesión esta tierra”. Abram replicó: “Señor Dios, ¿cómo sabré que voy a poseerla?” Dios le dijo: “Tráeme una ternera, una cabra y un carnero, todos de tres años; una tórtola y un pichón.” Tomó Abram aquellos animales, los partió por la mitad y puso las mitades una enfrente de la otra, pero no partió las aves.
