**HONORING MARY IN MAY
MAY CROWNING AND PROCESSION
THIS SUNDAY, MAY 15, 2022, 4:00PM**



One of the most beautiful traditions we have in the Catholic Church in the United States is the annual crowning of Mary in the month of May. This is a tangible way where our faith and love for Mary comes alive. Our Lady is most pleased at this celebration but even more is Her Son as He sees the love we bestow upon His dear Mother. It was the Most Blessed Trinity who crowned Mary Queen of Heaven and Earth because Mary is the daughter of God the Father, the Mother of Jesus our Redeemer, and she is the spouse of the Holy Spirit. We in our simple and humble way seek to imitate what God did to Mary – make her our Queen and Mother.

We will all meet in front of the hall with our rosaries and form the procession in this order:

- ◆ Altar Servers
- ◆ First Communion Children
- ◆ Grades Pre-School, K, 1, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8
 - ◆ Banners
- ◆ St. Gianna Sodality
- ◆ Legion of Mary
- ◆ Congregation
- ◆ Priests

We will pray Mary's favorite prayer as one family community not just as a community of children but as adults, as well men and women and children. The May procession and crowning is not just a "children's thing" Mary is for all of us – children, teenagers, men and women.

So as a Parish of men, women, and children we need to be a part of showing our special love to her. So many of us have incurred a debt to Mary, every time she answers our prayer! Now is the time to pay back that debt to her. But as we are paying back the debt we incurred every time she answered our prayer, we will incur a **new** debt because each of us will ask her for new favors, new intentions.

Bring your new intentions with you on Sunday and place them in her maternal hands so she can present them to Her Divine Son. There is so much we need to ask her: our families, our Parish, the state of the Church, peace in Ukraine and around the world, financial difficulties due to inflation, families members who are sick, especially with cancer, our children and teenagers who have drifted away from God, young people addicted to drugs and alcohol. The list of our prayers is endless and as far as the lives of all of us and our loved ones. Don't miss out on this beautiful day when we come to say, "Thank you Mother Mary. Help me Mother Mary."

Spot light on...

Easter Duty Obligation: After they have received their First Holy Communion, Catholics are bound by the Obligation of receiving Holy Communion at least once a year. This Precept should be fulfilled during the Easter Season. Catholics are also bound to confess serious (mortal) sins at least once a year, but this is not limited to the Lenten/Easter Season. The time for fulfilling the Paschal Precept (Easter Duty*) extends from the First Sunday of Lent, March 2, 2022 to the Solemnity of the Holy Trinity, June 12, 2022.

As Christians, we are called to help those in need. As you know, our Parish regularly hosts food collections (1st weekend of the month) to benefit local food pantries and to provide for those in great need. Parents are expected to attend a Pre-Jordan Baptism class which is to be held on the **last Friday** of every month at 7:00PM in the Parish church. Please call the Parish office to register for the class.

REQUIREMENTS FOR SPONSORING A CHILD FOR BAPTISM/CONFIRMATION (GODPARENTS)

- ◆ Baptized Catholic having received the Sacrament of Confirmation
- ◆ 16 years of age or older
- ◆ If single, they are living a chaste life, that is, not "living together" with someone
- ◆ Attend Mass faithfully on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation
- ◆ If not registered in this Parish must present a Sponsorship Letter from the Parish that he/she belongs.



THE LORD'S REAL PRESENCE

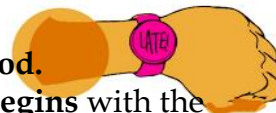

Making Time For Prayer Strengthens Our Connection with God.

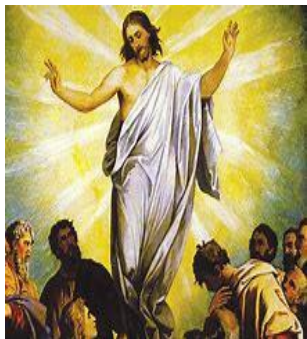

THE ANGELS. DID YOU KNOW...



Angels are created spirits, without bodies, having understanding and free will. But to picture them we have to draw bodies or heads with wings. When God created the angels He bestowed on them great wisdom, power and holiness. But not all the angels remained faithful to God; some of them sinned. The angels who remained faithful to God entered into the eternal happiness of heaven, and these are called good angels. In heaven, the good angels see, love, and adore God. The good angels help us by praying for us, by acting as messengers from God to us, and by serving as our guardian angels. Our guardian angels help us by praying for us, by protecting us from harm, and by inspiring us to do good. The angels who did not remain faithful to God were cast into hell, and these are called bad angels, or devils. The chief way in which the bad angels try to harm us is by tempting us to sin. Some temptations come from the bad angels, but other temptations come from ourselves and from the persons and things about us. We can always resist temptations, because no temptation can force us into sin, and because God will always help us if we ask Him.

MAY, THE MONTH DEDICATED TO THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

Since the 16th century Catholic piety has assigned entire months to special devotions. Toward the end of the 18th century a zealous Jesuit priest, Father Lalomia, started among the students of the Roman College of his Society the practice of dedicating May to Our Lady.

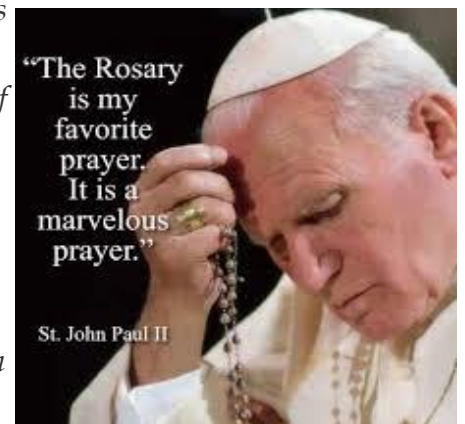
The devotion, which others had promoted in a small way, soon spread to other Jesuit colleges and to the entire Latin Church. In the early years of the 19th century, it quickly spread throughout the Western Church, and, by the time of Pope Pius IX's declaration of the dogma of the Immaculate Conception in 1854, it had become universal, and since that time it has been a regular feature of Catholic life.



There is no firm structure as to the content of a May devotion. Catholics offer Mary special honor in May: pilgrimages, visits to churches dedicated to her, little sacrifices in her honor, periods of study and well-finished work offered up to her, and a more attentive recitation of the rosary.

This specific devotion has been supported by several popes including Pope Pius XII in his encyclical *Ingruentium malorum*:

The custom of the family recitation of the Holy Rosary is a most efficacious means. What a sweet sight - most pleasing to God - when, at eventide, the Christian home resounds with the frequent repetition of praises in honor of the August Queen of Heaven! Then the Rosary, recited in the family, assembles before the image of the Virgin, in an admirable union of hearts, the parents and their children, who come back from their daily work. It unites them piously with those absent and those dead. It links all more tightly in a sweet bond of love, with the most Holy Virgin, who, like a loving mother, in the circle of her children, will be there bestowing upon them an abundance of the gifts of concord and family peace. A READING FROM THE ACTS OF THE APOSTLES

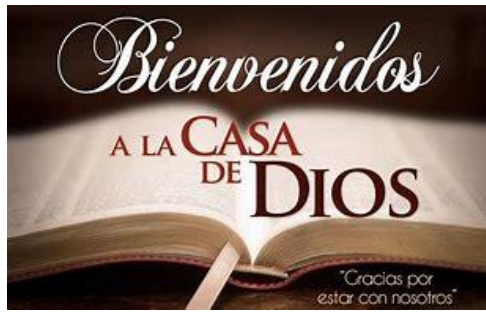
en una nueva deuda porque cada uno de nosotros le pedirá nuevos favores y nuevas intenciones.
