Celebrating Pentecost Sunday

Today, Pentecost Sunday, we recall our Confirmation Day and are reminded of the great gifts the Holy Spirit has given to us. It's easy for us to forget these gifts that are so necessary in the spiritual life because they flower into the fruits of the Holy Spirit. The effects of the seven gifts are seen in the 12 fruits of the Holy Spirit. To refresh oneself, the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit you received are:

1. **Wisdom** – to help us make wise decisions about important matters.
2. **Understanding** – for us to know and understand the real purpose and meaning of life.
3. **Counsel** – to advise and help others make morally right decisions.
4. **Courage** – for us to be strong and uphold and do what is right and to condemn and avoid what is wrong.
5. **Knowledge** – to know the truths of our Faith.
6. **Piety** – to give true worship and adoration to God alone and to honor our Blessed Virgin Mother and the Saints.
7. **Fear of the Lord** – to fear ever offending God by mortal sin and to take our Holy Religion seriously.

If we incorporate these seven gifts into our lives, if we unwrap these Pentecostal gifts, we then go even deeper into our spiritual lives because they produce 12 fruits of the Holy Spirit. In other words, the seven gifts are fertilized by our prayers, meditations and Sacraments – especially Penance and Holy Communion – and should produce beautiful fruits – 12 of them to be exact.

These fruits are the virtues produced in our lives when we exercise the gifts of the Holy Spirit. Meditate on these 12 fruits and see if you have them, and if you don't – why not?

Peace	Faithfulness
Patience	Modesty

Novena to Saint Anthony

Saint to the Whole World

What is a Saint? To speak in a dictionary manner, a Saint with a capital "S" is one of those persons recognized by the Church as having by holiness of life and heroic virtue attained a high place in heaven and as being, therefore, entitled to the veneration of the faithful, fit to serve them as a spiritual model and able to intercede for them in the Courts of Heaven. The men and women thus recognized as Saints do not, of course, include all the holy or exhaust all the possibilities of holiness. But, of them we are certain!

The Saint's place in heaven is fixed in the mind of God. His place between heaven and earth at God's Altar, in the liturgy – is also fixed on the mind of the Church. But, his place in the world is in the mind and hearts of men, always shifting ground. A saint can go out of fashion in one century – come in again in another, as the world's understanding of his life wanes or waxes. His "popularity" depends on the seemingly "timeliness" of his personal mode of holiness or his particular spiritual message.

All but for St. Anthony of Padua! His popularity has never waned in the minds and hearts of Catholics throughout the world! For over 800 years, Catholics and even non-Catholics have turned to St. Anthony for help. *Why is this so?* Why is St. Anthony of Padua always so popular – always so admired – always so prayed to? It seems to me it is because his message is universal and timeless: love God above all things, practice charity to the poor, live the Gospel message and love our Blessed Mother and the Holy Eucharist!!

It seems to me he has always been such a popular saint because his prayers are very, very powerful to Jesus! After all, he is one of only two saints that holds the Infant Jesus in his arms. So much did God love him, He gave him that great grace, a great privilege to hold the Christ Child in his arms. WOW! He is so popular because you can ask myriad peoples and they will all tell you, "St. Anthony heard my Prayer. St. Anthony helped me in a desperate time."

Below are some reasons why you might consider making this powerful Novena to Saint Anthony:

- ♦ *Are you looking for a job? Make the Novena!*
- ♦ *Are you sick or someone in your family is ill with cancer, heart trouble, whatever? Make the Novena!*

- ♦ *Are you worried about a difficult pregnancy or perhaps unable to conceive? Make the Novena!*

If you do the novena to St. Anthony, you will find a powerful and true friend who will listen to you and help you.



Man's Need of a Redeemer. DID YOU KNOW...

Every one born into the world had original sin on his soul and was therefore a slave of the devil. Even those who did die without mortal sin on their souls could not enter heaven, but had to wait in a place or state of rest called the Bosom of

Abraham by Christ (Luke 16, 22) and a prison by St. Peter (1 Peter 3, 19) until after the death of Christ. Men could not understand why there was sickness and suffering on earth and did not know what happened after death. God did not send the Redeemer right away, so that men would see from



all these things what a terrible thing sin was and how much they needed a Redeemer. When the fullness of time had come, God prepared to send His Son into the world as the Redeemer. He had already planned the kind of Mother He wanted for His Son, so He created her soul and united it to her body in the womb of her mother, St. Ann. But Mary's soul, unlike all other souls which had come into this world after Adam and Eve, had no original sin on it. It was immaculate. God looked into the future and saw the day on which His Son would die on the Cross. He accepted in advance the Precious Blood of His Son as the price of Mary's redemption. He used the Precious Blood to redeem her ahead of time by preserving her from all sin. This privilege which God granted to Mary of being conceived and born without original sin is called her Immaculate Conception. *St. Joseph Baltimore Catechism*


THE LORD'S REAL PRESENCE




