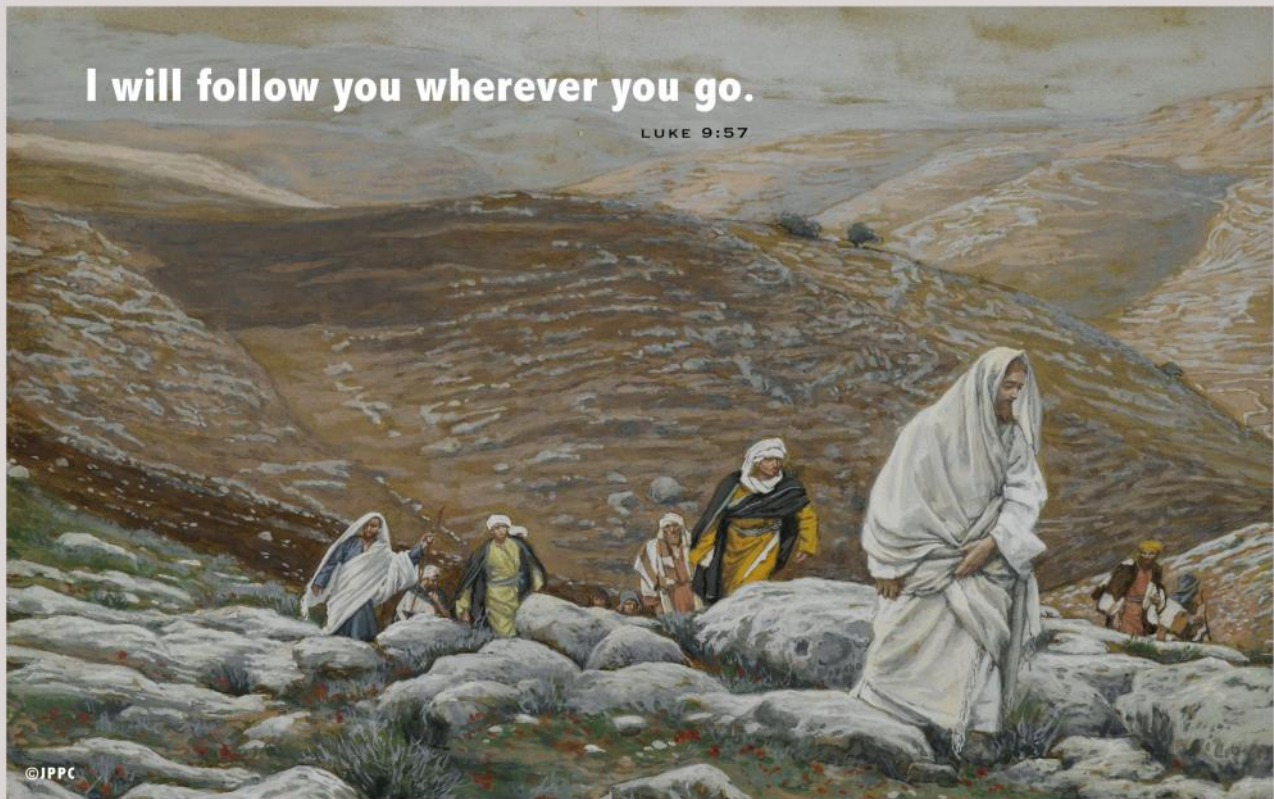

Divine Blood Transfusion

Imagine, if you will; a man lying on a hospital bed motionless, eyes closed, breathing so shallow that the faint movement is hard to detect. He is dying. The natural color of life has left his face. His heart has all but stopped beating. With closed eyes he sees not his friends stand about his bed; anxiously concerned about his condition. Nor does he hear their sobs; asking, “Can’t something be done to help him?” “Yes, something more can be done, which we shall try shortly, says the doctor, a blood transfusion may help. We are locating a matching donor and through the assistance of medical instruments the blood of the well man will flow into the body of the sick one.”



A change comes over the sick man. Why, it is almost a miracle! He moves! Color returns to his features! His eyes open! He speaks! He is now on the way to recovery. And it doesn't take long before he is completely well. The dying man is alive! Not because of his own blood, but because of someone else's blood. The dying man living on the blood of his friend. A blood transfusion is a marvelous thing. Still more marvelous are its effects. A miracle in the very truth.

You and I are dying. It is our immortal nature that is in such bad shape. Our Soul is dying. A blood transfusion is the **ONLY** thing that will save us. Because our soul is immortal and its destiny is eternal, no human help, no human blood can save us. The only one who can save us is one that is “large” enough; one who is at least equal to our immortality and eternity. More than such a helper is our Savior.

Jesus offers His blood to us. We receive it, live by it in the Sacraments, especially in Holy Communion. In Holy Communion, a blood transfusion takes place. Our soul receive life and strength for our heart pumps and in our veins flow the blood of God within us. We who before were weak and anemic, yes, destined for certain doom, now gather strength and vigor. As the “death” of the soul would have lasted forever, so now its life, nourished on the **blood of the Lamb**, is **eternal**.

Holy Communion – Divine Blood.

Transfusion! Never fear! No one, nothing can hurt you. Jesus is with you. Not even death, bodily or spiritual. Jesus conquered them both. Now He imparts His own strength, His own life, to you for HIS OWN BLOOD flows in you!

Fear nothing! There is help – unfailing help – for EVERYONE! It has to for HE bled for each one. His Sacred Body was tapped for all of us on calvary. The Host delivers that Blood to our body and soul the moment it touches our tongue in Holy Communion. And --- WE LIVE!

If a physical blood transfusion is a miracle, what are we to say of the wonders of the Divine Blood Transfusion – Holy Communion.

We who before were dying–dead–live! We live on the blood of our friend! We live in Godly royalty! Eternally! “And I live, now not I: but Christ lives in me.” (Gal. 2:20)

Purgatory is God's Hospital. DID YOU KNOW...

Purgatory is God's hospital for souls, where those who do not love God enough to enter heaven are cured by fire. Only those who love God perfectly can enter heaven. But even many good people die with only a weak love of God. They had more interest in the people and the things of this earth than they did in God. They did not love Him with their whole heart and soul. They wasted many opportunities to please Him. Love is purified, increased and perfected by suffering. This means not only bodily pain, but crosses of all kinds. God sends everyone all the sufferings they need on earth to cleanse, strengthen, and perfect their love. But most people waste their sufferings. They do not want them, complain about them, and try to escape them in every manner possible, even by committing sin. Because of this attitude, the fires of their sufferings are unable to burn away the selfishness from their love, so that it will be perfect. Then they must go to purgatory where they will have to suffer much more intensely than they would have if they had accepted the sufferings of earth. Their love is purified in purgatory, but it does not grow, whereas the sufferings of earth which we accept from God not only purify our love, but make it grow. In purgatory, God's cleansing fires burn away the soul's selfishness till its love becomes perfect and it is ready to fly to heaven. Its sufferings only purify love, they don't increase it. *St. Joseph Baltimore Catechism*

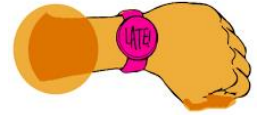
THE LORD'S REAL PRESENCE

It is right to acknowledge the **Lord's Real Presence** with a brief act of worship on entering or leaving the Church and every time passing by the Sanctuary. Normally, a *genuflection* in the direction of the place of Reservation is enough. One who is physically unable to genuflect may substitute a *profound bow* at the waist.

Please make every effort to arrive on time for the start of Holy Mass, which begins with the **Sign of the Cross** and ends with the dismissal, "**Go in Peace.**" It is the Lord we insult when we do not give Him our time. He is never too busy to be with us!



Sacrament of Marriage

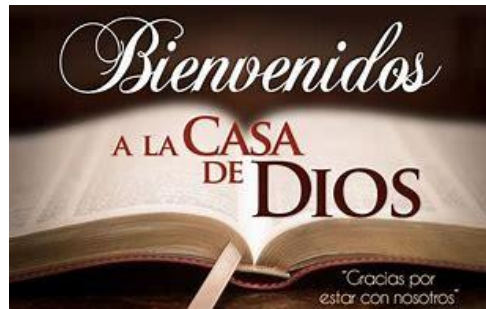
