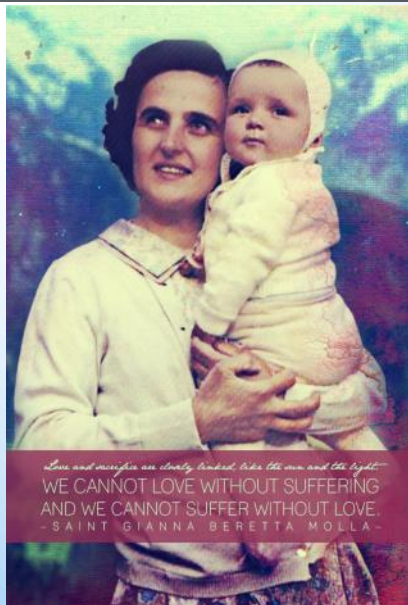

## R.C.I.A. BEGINS IN OCTOBER

In the Fall we will begin instructional classes for anyone interested in becoming Catholic or in taking A refresher course. The class will start in October and we'll be meeting in the Parish Hall.

*What is the RCIA?* The letters R-C-I-A, stand for the Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults. Basically, it is a group of adults coming together each week, who wish to become Catholic, or baptized Catholics who have really never been instructed in the Catholic faith. These people, for one reason or another, never made their Holy Communion or Confirmation.



The beauty of the R.C.I.A. process is that you are not alone in your conversion – you are part of a community of people who seek to deepen their relationship with Christ in the Catholic faith! The question one person is afraid to ask, another one will ask. You are not alone. as a community we will support each other to move forward.

We will be meeting every Thursday evening from 7 to 8 p.m. Only one hour each week, leading up to the Easter Vigil when the non-Catholics will be received into the Church, and the baptized Catholics will receive the Sacraments of Holy Communion and Confirmation. It is a beautiful and moving ceremony.

The R.C.I.A. is not really new. After our Lord's resurrection, remember that in the early Church most of your converts were adults who went through the process we now call R.C.I.A. They were prepared and instructed in the faith over a period of time so that not only did they learn about Christ and His Church, but they began to live a new way, the Catholic Christian Way! Part of the teaching of the second Vatican Council was to bring back the R.C.I.A. process when dealing with the Faith.



So be a Missionary!! Spread the word to your non-Catholic friends and relatives or to those Baptized Catholics who have never really been instructed in the Faith and have not received Holy Communion or Confirmation. Bring to them a copy of the Parish bulletin so they can fill out the short form provided on the next page. Everyone interested can return the form via the Sunday collection basket, or bring it to the Parish office, Monday through Thursday from 9 a.m. – 4 p.m.

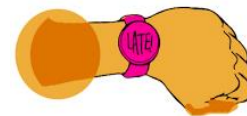
## THE LORD'S REAL PRESENCE

It is right to acknowledge the **Lord's Real Presence** with a brief act of worship on entering or leaving the Church and every time passing by the Sanctuary. Normally, a *genuflection* in the direction of the place of Reservation is enough. One who is physically unable to genuflect may substitute a *profound bow* at the waist.

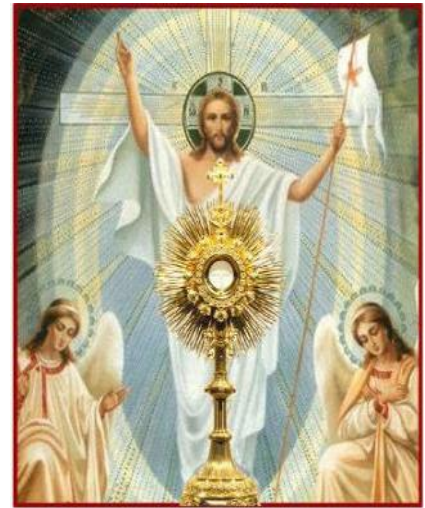
### SODALITY OF ST. GIANNA BERETTA MOLLA PARISH

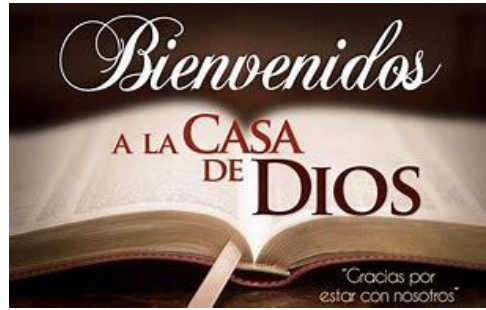
