

Importance of Parental Blessing

From the Pastor's Desk

As your children return to school in a couple of weeks, I am suggesting to parents that they return to the age-old custom of blessing their children. Start a new chapter in your family's history. A half century ago—and far beyond—the parental blessing used to be a common custom. In recent years, as conveniences, we gradually abandoned many of our precious spiritual values. Does this mean that we don't need spiritual blessings anymore? Indeed, the opposite is true. We need them more than ever before! Because along with our increasing worldliness we have suffered a corresponding loss of spiritual values. Let's not just talk about our loss and bewail it, but get moving and rebuild our Catholic faith, our Catholic customs.

Fathers and mothers are the priests and sisters of their own "little churches"—their homes! They are placed there to teach and to bless. It is a solemn scene, a touching sight for a mother or a father passing from one kneeling child to another, imparting their blessing. Open hands are laid momentarily on the child's head. You may wish to add a few words, admirations, petitions, etc. Parental blessing is as old as the human race! It began with the oldest patriarchs. Throughout the Old Testament it was the usual method of transmitting divine favors. The blessings conferred on their children by Abraham, Isaac and Jacob are known to all who read the Bible. The Bible gives us an authoritative statement on parental blessing: "*In word and deed, honor your father that his blessing may come upon you, for a father's blessing gives a family firm roots, but a mother's curse uproots the growing plant.*" Ecclesiastes 3:8-9 Our Lord used to gather the little children around Him and bless them. He said, "Suffer the little children to come unto Me!" Then, embracing them and laying His hands upon them, He blessed them.

Parents love their children but so rarely bless them. One is inclined to think that the privilege no longer exists. Nevertheless, JESUS WANTS CHILDREN TO BE BLESSED! Certainly, the blessing bestowed by Jesus is more efficacious than the blessing bestowed by parents. Even so, parental blessing is something so holy, so powerful, that it deserves to be called the *Sacrament of the Domestic Hearth*. The picture of a young mother placing hands of benediction on an innocent child is beautiful to behold. No less inspiring is the sight of an aged parent giving with trembling hands a blessing to a full-grown son or daughter! This is a privilege that belongs to fathers and mothers. Here you are urged to use a privilege. This is yours by divine grant—a privilege that goes with the dignity of parenthood. *SO, WHY NOT BLESS YOUR CHILDREN?*

If this "Sacrament of the Domestic Hearth" were more frequently administered, there would be many more happy, contented families. The two indispensable factors for happiness in the home are amiable authority on the part of the parents and loving obedience on the part of the children. If your home is not all that you would like it to be, try blessing your children regularly. It will encourage oneness, love, reverence and obedience.

Some years ago, the newspapers attracted the attention of readers with the headline: "Bishop Kneels for Mother's Blessing." The bishop was Bishop Roach of India. He met his mother at the railway station, then in the presence of a crowd of people, he knelt before his mother to receive her blessing and the grand old lady, placing her wrinkled hands on the head of her illustrious son, moved many spectators to tears. Fathers and mothers, open up to your children this effective means of Grace. Make a diligent and frequent use of this great privilege. Pray over them, "May you live a long life in holiness and happiness in Christ."

When ought parents bless their children?

*At night is a very good time to give a daily blessing



*Before going on a trip, undertaking an important or dangerous task, during sickness, children ought to receive their parent's blessing. At the more important turning points in life, e.g.: entering school; First Holy Communion, entering Marriage or upon entering the convent, monastery or seminary.

*Send a Blessing to your absent children before you go to bed at night, think of your absent sons or daughters. They may be in real need of your help.

Your blessing is the most powerful help you can give them. Protect them with the Sacred Sign of the Cross that you make over them or in their direction.





REQUIREMENTS FOR SPONSORING A CHILD FOR BAPTISM/CONFIRMATION (GODPARENTS)

- ◆ Baptized Catholic having received the Sacrament of Confirmation
- ◆ 16 years of age or older
- ◆ If single, they are living a chaste life, that is, not "living together" with someone
- ◆ Attend Mass faithfully on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation
- ◆ If not registered in this Parish must present a Sponsorship Letter from the Parish that he/she belongs.

Sacrament of Marriage

Couples planning to marry at St. Gianna are expected to contact the Priest to arrange a date and time **FIRST**. Second, they must attend the Pre-Cana conferences as mandated by the Most Reverend Bishop. A READING FROM THE HOLY GOSPEL ACCORDING TO LUKE

On a sabbath Jesus went to dine at the home of one of the leading Pharisees, and the people there were observing him carefully. He told a parable to those who had been invited, noticing how they were choosing the places of honor at the table. "When you are invited by someone to a wedding banquet, do not recline at table in the place of honor. 

Cremation and Proper Handling of Cremated Remain – Your Choices Don't Stop with Cremation

While you may have chosen to be cremated, remember to choose your final resting place. Although the Church earnestly recommends the pious custom of burying the bodies of the dead be observed, it does not however, forbid cremation unless it has been chosen for reasons which are contrary to Christian teaching. Cremated remains are the body of the deceased in a changed form. We should honor them as we honor the body. They must be reverently buried or entombed in a place reserved for the burial of the dead. Dentro de pocas semanas sus hijos regresan a la escuela y quisiera sugerir a los padres que vuelvan a la antigua costumbre de bendecir a sus hijos. Comience un nuevo capítulo en la historia de su familia. En la antiguedad, la bendición de los padres solía ser una costumbre común. Sin embargo, en los últimos años dejamos de practicar esta costumbre. ¿Significa que ya no necesitamos bendiciones espirituales? Todo lo contrario. ¡Los necesitamos más que nunca!



Los padres y las madres son los sacerdotes y religiosos de sus "pequeñas iglesias", sus hogares! Están allí para enseñar y bendecir. Un espectáculo conmovedor es ver a una madre o un padre pasar de un niño arrodillado a otro, impartiendo su bendición. Las manos abiertas se ponen momentáneamente sobre la cabeza del niño y se pueden agregar algunas palabras o peticiones. La bendición de los padres es tan antigua como la raza humana. Comenzó con los patriarcas más antiguos. A lo largo del Antiguo Testamento fue el método habitual de transmitir los favores divinos. Las bendiciones conferidas a sus hijos por Abraham, Isaac y Jacob son conocidas por todos los que leen la Biblia. La Biblia nos da una declaración autorizada sobre la bendición de los padres: "*De palabra y de obra, honra a tu Padre para que su bendición caiga sobre ti, porque la bendición de un padre da raíces firmes a la familia, pero la maldición de la madre desarraigá la planta en crecimiento.*" Eclesiastés 3: 8-9

Nuestro Señor solía reunir a los niños pequeños a su alrededor y bendecirlos. Podemos encontrar en el Nuevo Testamento que decía, "*Dejen que los niños vengan a Mí.*" Luego, abrazándolos y poniendo sus manos sobre sus pequeñas cabecitas, les impartía su bendición.

Los padres también aman a sus hijos y a menudo, los abrazan. ¿Por qué no impartir sobre ellos una bendición? Es una costumbre tan poco practicada que a veces uno se inclina a pensar que ese privilegio ya no existe. ¡JESÚS QUIERE QUE LOS NIÑOS SEAN BENDECIDOS!

Ciertamente, la bendición otorgada por Jesús es más eficaz que la otorgada por los padres. Sin embargo, la bendición de los padres es algo tan santo y poderoso, que merece ser llamado el Sacramento del Hogar Doméstico. La imagen de una joven madre impartiendo su bendición sobre su pequeño es algo hermoso de contemplar. No menos conmovedor es ver a un anciano extendiendo sus manos temblorosas impartiendo su bendición a sus hijos. Este es un privilegio que les pertenece a los padres por concesión divina. Un privilegio que está conectado intimamente con la dignidad de la paternidad.

Si este "Sacramento del Hogar Doméstico" fuera administrado con mayor frecuencia, reinaría la paz y la felicidad en muchas familias. Los dos factores indispensables para la felicidad en el hogar son la autoridad por parte de los padres y la obediencia por parte de los niños.

Bendigan a sus hijos antes de que se vayan a dormir, antes de irse a la escuela o cuando estén por emprender una nueva etapa en sus vidas. Inclusive, piensen en sus hijos que viven lejos. Impartan sus bendiciones a la distancia y eleven sus pensamientos a nuestro Padre celestial. Pueden estar necesitando su ayuda y la bendición hará que Dios los fortalezca y los guie.
