FORTY HOURS DEVOTION

How to Make a Holy Hour

The following is just a suggestion as to how to make a Holy Hour. It may be divided into a half hour of silence and a half hour of vocal prayer.

1. First 15 minutes – The Rosary
2. Next 15 minutes – Quiet Prayer and Meditation
3. Next 15 minutes – Prayer of Divine Love
4. Last 15 minutes – Quiet Prayer and Meditation

Appropriateness of These Prayers

The Church imparts a Plenary Indulgence to those who pray the Rosary before the Most Blessed Sacrament. People all over the world find the Divine Love Prayer very spiritually beneficial since it combines all the Gospel values. Because the Most Blessed Sacrament is the Throne of Mercy, the Divine Mercy Prayer is an effective way of asking God to embrace all mankind with His merciful love.

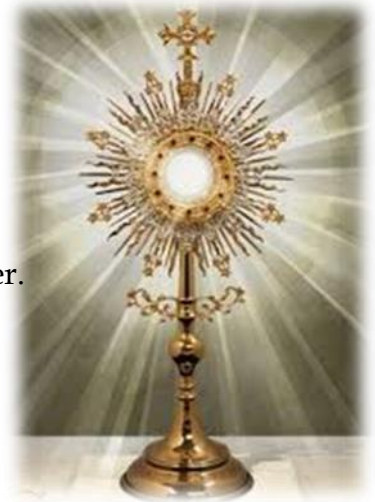
The Divine Love Prayer

Prayed on the beads of the Holy Rosary, this inspirational prayer is very easy to learn and to follow. Each prayer is repeated ten times, followed by a "Glory Be." This Divine Love Prayer to the Eucharistic Heart of Jesus takes only seven to ten minutes to pray. It is prayed as follows: "Eucharistic Heart of Jesus, we adore You and we praise You in union with the Nine Choirs of Angels." This is repeated ten times, followed by a "Glory Be."

Below are some additional prayers that may be said on your Rosary beads:

1. Eucharistic Heart of Jesus, we adore You and we praise You – **in union with the Nine Choirs of Angels!**
2. Eucharistic Heart of Jesus, burning with love for us – **in flame our hearts with love for You!**
3. Eucharistic Heart of Jesus – **Thy Kingdom come!**
4. Eucharistic Heart of Jesus – make us one in mind, heart and will – **with You, the Father and the Holy Spirit.**
5. Eucharistic Heart of Jesus, gentle and humble of Heart – **make our hearts like unto Thine.**
6. Eucharistic Heart of Jesus, through the Infinite value of each Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, offered now and until the end of time – **have mercy on us and on the whole world!**
7. Eucharistic Heart of Jesus, thank you – **for the personal love You have for me in the Blessed Sacrament**
8. Eucharistic Heart of Jesus, with all my heart – **I Love You!**
9. Eucharistic Heart of Jesus – **I put all my trust in You!**

Jesus will spend all Eternity thanking you and loving you in Heaven for your faithful commitment on Earth of spending one hour with Him in the Blessed Sacrament. This hour Jesus wants you to spend with Him is spent any way you want. You may bring your own prayer books, use the books in the Church, read the Bible, pray the Rosary or just sit and relax and enjoy the sweet peace that comes from simply being in the presence of God. You may feel you can't pray well. Don't let this discourage you. The mere fact that you take time out, at a specific time, to spend an hour with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament pleases Him very much and is in itself a prayer of great Faith.

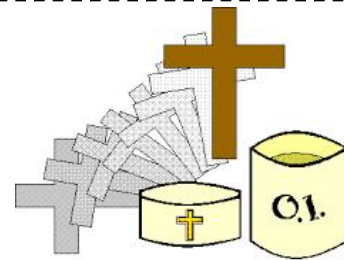

The Anointing of the Sick and the Forty Hours Sunday, October 23, 2022



On Sunday, October 23rd we will open our Parish celebration of “Forty Hours” i.e., Solemn Exposition of the Most Blessed Sacrament.

We, the Priests of St. Gianna Beretta Molla Parish, invite you to be *a part* of these three very special days. They are days filled with spiritual growth for you and your loved ones. We will begin with our celebration on Sunday, October 23rd at 4:00 PM with the Sacrament of the Sick.

The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is, as the words of St. James make clear, for the sick! It is no longer considered Last Rites. This sacrament is for anyone who is sick, i.e., chronic sickness and also for anyone over the age of 65. In the Sacrament of the Sick, the Church extends the healing hand of Christ to the sick. It is an encounter with Christ the Healer, Christ the Divine Physician. The woman in the Gospel was eager to touch only the Lord’s cloak. “If I touch even His garment,” she thought, “I shall be made well.” The sick person today “touches” Him and experiences His power through the Sacramental Anointing.

This Sacrament is NOT for people who are dead. It is for anyone who is ill. Won’t you join us and welcome Christ into your life in this unique way? What more beautiful way to begin our “Forty Hours” than by recognizing Jesus, the Bread of Life, reserved in the Most Blessed Sacrament for our adoration and for the sick.

Dear Parishioners,

So often moms come to me with an ache in their hearts for their children’s return to the Catholic faith. We know that true peace and joy can only be found in the fullness of the Catholic faith, but they’re being deceived by the world, by the selfishness and self-centered tendency of the body, encouraged by the whispers of the enemy. “Forgive them; they know not what they do!” I hear the women cry. “We were made for You, O Lord, and our hearts are restless until they rest in you.” ~St. Augustine

There are so many reasons the world has been able to pull our children away from the faith; such as, poor catechizing, scandals, and all the misinformation propagated in the news and social media. Add to these things our own desire for comfort, our desire to fit in, and perhaps a non-confrontational nature toward issues on which we haven’t educated ourselves, and -- perhaps slowly at first -- the path away from the Truth of the Gospel has begun. This pain in the hearts of mothers is not to be wasted! Jesus didn’t die in his sleep; He suffered and died for our sins. When we join our hearts with Jesus on the cross, this sacrificial love is a powerful prayer! Let us join our aching hearts with the aching heart of the Blessed Mother at the foot of the cross, asking her to bring our children to the Father, through the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

Millions of Monicas

“Praying together one hour, one purpose, our children.”

The parish of St. Gianna Beretta Molla is bringing a new ministry to its people, in honor of the aching hearts of its mothers, grandmothers, godmothers, Confirmation sponsors, and aunts, called “Millions of Monicas.” Let us ask for the intercession of St. Monica, the mother of one of the Catholic Church’s greatest saints, St. Augustine of Hippo, Bishop and Doctor of the Church.

In one of St. Augustine’s greatest writings, *Confessions*, he speaks of the ache in his mother’s heart for his return to the Catholic faith. Augustine recalls his mother’s warnings to him about sinfulness. He realizes later that God spoke to him through his mother and that he should have heeded her words. He dismissed her warnings as womanish advice and rejected her counsel, rushing headlong into a life filled with lust and theft, taking pleasure in his own disgrace.

“And now you stretched forth your hand from above and drew up my soul out of that profound darkness because my mother, your faithful one, wept to you on my behalf more than mothers are accustomed to weep for the bodily deaths of their children.”
“She was fully confident that you who had promised the whole would give her the rest, and thus most calmly, and with a fully confident heart, she replied to me that she believed, in Christ, that before she died she would see me a faithful Catholic.”

The pain of her motherly heart, lifted as prayer - and with prayer - for her child, in complete and total confidence of Christ’s promise to His people, knowing only God can change hearts, we then read:
“Then we went in to my mother, and told her what happened, to her great joy. We explained to her how it had occurred, and she leaped for joy triumphant, and she blessed You.”

Join us on Wednesday, November 16th at 6:30 in the Church of St. Gianna’s as we gather together to pray with confidence for our children’s full return to the Catholic faith.

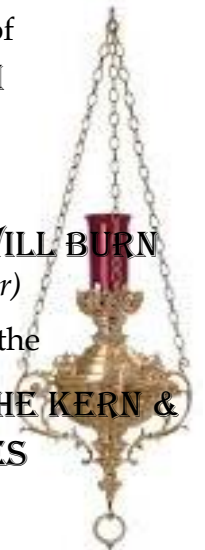

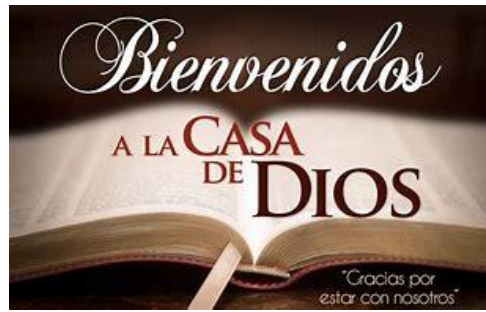
