

BLESSING OF THROATS NEXT WEEKEND

FEBRUARY 4-5, 2023

"Through the intercession of St. Blaise, bishop and martyr, may God deliver you from ailments of the throat and from every other evil. In the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." Amen.

These are the words of a special blessing imparted in our Churches on the Feast of St. Blase. Legend tells us that an anxious mother scurried to St. Blaise with her little boy. A fish bone had lodged in his throat. The Saint called for two candles, lit them and placed them in the form of a Cross under the boy's chin, recited some prayers and gave his blessing.

Almost immediately, the fish bone loosened and was easily removed.

Many such cures obtained through prayer to this Saint gave foundation to the hope that the Blessing of St. Blaise will prevent troubles of the throat. From such physical troubles we all want and need protection –from hoarseness, choking, colds and cancer.

There are also spiritual diseases of the throat, much more harmful than the physical. "Evils of the throat and every other evil" from which St. Blaise's blessing begs protection, include particularly these spiritual troubles, which are beyond the cure of the greatest throat specialists. These include: the hoarseness of unkind speech, choking curses, gagging lies, sexual mouth canker, etc.

The Apostle Paul had on his mind such diseases in one of his letters. Quoting Psalm 5, Verse 10, he wrote to the Romans, "Their throat is an open sepulcher. With their tongues they have dealt deceitfully. The venom of asps is under their lips. Their mouth is full of cursing and bitterness." (Romans 3:13). Such spiritual diseases for the throat indeed are the most harmful and these we want cured through the intercession of St. Blaise.

Keep these thoughts in mind when the Priest touches with the crossed candles your throat and asks God, through the intercession of St. Blaise, to deliver you from every evil, especially from physical and spiritual evils of the throat.

ear Parishioners, Friends and Visitors of St. Gianna Parish:

Our Catholic Church has a long and beautiful history of being concerned for those in need. From the time of the Apostles, when people sold what they owned and laid it at the Apostles' feet to care for the needy down to this present day our people have been generous and compassionate. Christ has made it very clear in the Gospels that if we are to be numbered among his disciples, we must care for the poor, sick, hungry and homeless. "Whatsoever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did it for me" (Matt. 25:40).

On the weekend of February 11th & 12th our Parish will kick off the **South Jersey Catholic Ministry Appeal 2023** (House of Charity). The Annual Appeal will carry on as it has, but now with a new name, a new logo, and a new color scheme. The change was made to give better clarity in the name. The new name references both our region and the supported ministries as its scope and purpose. Also, by removing the specific word 'charity', we eliminate a common confusion with Catholic Charities, which is a separate organization.

The Annual Appeal will continue to run as it has with an In-Pew Solicitation Weekend and a series of mailings, relying on parish staff to organize and mail gifts to the Development office.

This Appeal helps fund several Catholic nursing homes, a home for retired Priests, and the formation of seminarians and permanent deacons. It also helps to provide counseling services, food, housing, medical and legal assistance for the poor, campus ministry and formation programs for lay Liturgical and Catechetical Ministers.

In the coming days you will receive—or may have recently received, a special brochure and letter from our Diocese about this year's Diocesan appeal. When you receive your information, please review the materials carefully. This year the assigned goal for our Parish is \$103,600.00. A little less than a 5% increase from last year's goal. The Parish will receive 10% of the total goal amount once is reached and 75% of everything raised above goal amount.

As you know, charity never ceases. We are, therefore, appealing to your generosity. Together, we will make our gifts to this Appeal as one Parish family in support of the needs that are so prevalent in our world today.

I thank you for all you have done in the past for your Parish and my sincere gratitude for whatever you can do to help make the 2023 South Jersey Catholic Ministry Appeal 2023 a success.

Estos incluyen: la ronquera del habla desagradable, maldiciones de asfixia, mentiras amordazadas, llagas sexuales en la boca, etc.

El Apóstol Pablo tenía en mente tales enfermedades en una de sus cartas. Citando el Salmo 5, versículo 10, escribió a los romanos: "Sepulcro abierto es su garganta. Con su lengua han obrado con engaño. Veneno de áspides hay debajo de sus labios. Su boca está llena de maldición y amargura". (Romanos 3:13).

Tales enfermedades espirituales de la garganta son en verdad las más dañinas y las queremos curar por intercesión de San Blas. Ten presente estos pensamientos cuando el Sacerdote toque con las velas cruzadas tu garganta y pida a Dios, por intercesión de San Blas, que te libre de todo mal, especialmente de los males físicos y espirituales de la garganta.
