

GETTING READY FOR OUR PARISH MISSION



The Parish Mission has its roots in the mission of the prophets and acquires its mandate from the Divine commission given to the Apostles and to their successors.

The Parish Mission in its present form is a product of the 17th Century. In substance, however, missions for the faithful have long been a feature of the general apostolate of the Church. Popular preaching received great impetus with the founding of the mendicant orders in the 13th Century. Both Franciscans and Dominicans dedicated themselves as popular missionaries whose primary tasks were to implant the Faith in the people, refute error and renew Christian fervor in the faithful.

Then came the Catholic Counter-reformation with a needed emphasis on catechetical instruction. Preachers were urged to concentrate on the fundamental doctrines of the Church, for it was realized that many had fallen away from the faith through ignorance of their religion.

Once again today, there is a tremendous need for us to be rooted in our Catholic faith. We are living in an age where our society has almost become pagan with an ignorance of the faith and a shallow level of Christian morality. The symptoms of the disease or spiritual virus that has plagued us are very obvious—the temptations are all around us, and just like a deadly virus it is eating away at our Church and society.

Abortion, contraception, immorality, pornography, lack of faith, poor attendance at Mass, disrespect for the teachings of Christ and His Church, irreverence for Our Lord in the Most Blessed Sacrament, sacrileges and general diminution of the faith—all are symptoms of the virus that has infected all of us to a lesser or greater degree. And so, once again there is a great need for solid Catholic Parish Missions to call us all to a greater conversion—to call us to renew and regenerate our spiritual lives! The answer for all of us is our Parish Mission—it's just "what the doctor ordered."

We will be blessed to have once again a priest who is a member of the Fathers of Mercy. The Fathers of Mercy, in fact, were founded in Lyons, France in 1808 by a very zealous and holy Priest, Father Jean Baptiste Rauzan. Fr. Rauzan brought together a small group of Priests to form a missionary band with the idea of counteracting the disastrous effects of the French Revolution on the faith of the people. The society came to the United States in 1939 and it continues the mission work of Fr. Rauzan. Just as it counteracted the effects of the French Revolution on the faith of the people then, so today once again the Fathers of Mercy are helping to counteract the ill effects of modernism on the faith of the people. They continue to preach the truth of the Gospel and will help us all to get to Heaven and save our souls—the whole purpose of our life here on earth. On the weekend of February 25 & 26, Fr. William Casey, CMP will speak at all our Masses to inspire us to make the Parish Mission! Let us welcome him, and let us pray together!

South Jersey Catholic Ministry Appeal 2023 Rebranding of the House of Charity Bishop's Annual Appeal

Dear Parishioners, Friends and Visitors of St. Gianna Parish:

Our Catholic Church has a long and beautiful history of being concerned for those in need. From the time of the Apostles, when people sold what they owned and laid it at the Apostles' feet to care for the needy down to this present day our people have been generous and compassionate. Christ has made it very clear in the Gospels that if we are to be numbered among his disciples, we must care for the poor, sick, hungry and homeless. "*Whatsoever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did it for me*" (Matt. 25:40).

This weekend our Parish will kick off the **South Jersey Catholic Ministry Appeal 2023** (House of Charity). The Annual Appeal will carry on as it has, but now with a new name, a new logo, and a new color scheme. The change was made to give better clarity in the name. The new name references both our region and the supported ministries as its scope and purpose. Also, by removing the specific word 'charity', we eliminate a common confusion with Catholic Charities, which is a separate organization.

This Appeal helps fund several Catholic nursing homes, a home for retired Priests, and the formation of seminarians and permanent deacons. It also helps to provide counseling services, food, housing, medical and legal assistance for the poor, campus ministry and formation programs for lay Liturgical and Catechetical Ministers.

In the coming days you will receive—or may have recently received—a special brochure and letter from our Diocese about this year's Diocesan appeal. When you receive your information, please review the materials carefully. This year the assigned goal for our Parish is **\$103,600.00**. A little less than a 5% increase from last year's goal. The Parish will receive 10% of the total goal amount once it is reached and 75% of everything raised above goal amount.

As you know, charity never ceases. We are, therefore, appealing to your generosity. Together, we will make our gifts to this Appeal as one Parish family in support of the needs that are so prevalent in our world today.

I thank you for all you have done in the past for your Parish and my sincere gratitude for whatever you can do to help make the 2023 South Jersey Catholic Ministry Appeal a success.



A READING FROM THE HOLY GOSPEL ACCORDING TO MATTHEW

Jesus said to his disciples: "Do not think that I have come to abolish the law or the prophets. I have come not to abolish but to fulfill. Amen, I say to you, until heaven and earth pass away, not the smallest letter or the smallest part of a letter will pass from the law, until all things have taken place. Therefore, whoever breaks one of the least of these commandments and teaches others to do so will be called least in the kingdom of heaven. But whoever obeys and teaches these commandments will be called greatest in the kingdom of heaven. I tell you, unless your righteousness surpasses that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will not enter the kingdom of heaven. "You have heard that it was said to your ancestors, *You shall not kill; and whoever kills will be liable to judgment.* But I say to you, whoever is angry with his brother will be liable to judgment; and whoever says to his brother, 'Raqa,' will be answerable to the Sanhedrin; and whoever says, 'You fool,' will be liable to fiery Gehenna. Therefore, if you bring your gift to the altar, and there recall that your brother has anything against you, leave your gift there at the altar, go first and be reconciled with your brother, and then come and offer your gift. Settle with your opponent quickly while on the way to court. Otherwise your opponent will hand you over to the judge, and the judge will hand you over to the guard, and you will be thrown into prison. Amen, I say to you, you will not be released until you have paid the last penny. "You have heard that it was said, *You shall not commit adultery.* But I say to you, everyone who looks at a woman with lust has already committed adultery with her in his heart. If your right eye causes you to sin, tear it out and throw it away. It is better for you to lose one of your members than to have your whole body thrown into Gehenna. And if your right hand causes you to sin, cut it off and throw it away. It is better for you to lose one of your members than to have your whole body go into Gehenna. "It was also said, *Whoever divorces his wife must give her a bill of divorce.* But I say to you, whoever divorces his wife - unless the marriage is unlawful - causes her to commit adultery, and whoever marries a divorced woman commits adultery. En sustancia, sin embargo, las misiones para los fieles han sido durante mucho tiempo una característica del apostolado general de la Iglesia. La predicación popular recibió un gran impulso con la fundación de las órdenes mendicantes en el siglo XIII. Tanto los franciscanos como los dominicos se dedicaron como misioneros populares cuyas tareas primordiales fueron implantar la fe en el pueblo, refutar el error y renovar el fervor cristiano en los fieles. Luego vino la contrarreforma católica con un énfasis necesario en la instrucción catequética. Se instó a los predicadores a concentrarse en las doctrinas fundamentales de la Iglesia porque se dio cuenta de que muchos se habían apartado de la fe por ignorancia de su religión. Una vez más hoy, existe una tremenda necesidad de que estemos arraigados en nuestra fe católica. Vivimos en una época en la que nuestra sociedad casi se ha vuelto pagana con una ignorancia de la fe y un nivel superficial de moralidad cristiana. Los síntomas de la enfermedad o virus espiritual que nos ha plagado son muy obvios: las tentaciones están a nuestro alrededor y, como un virus mortal, están carcomiendo nuestra Iglesia y nuestra sociedad. El aborto, la anticoncepción, la inmortalidad, la pornografía, la falta de fe, la escasa asistencia a Misa, el irrespeto a las enseñanzas de Cristo y de Su Iglesia, la irreverencia a Nuestro Señor en el Santísimo Sacramento, los sacrilegios y la disminución general de la fe, todos son síntomas de la virus que nos ha infectado a todos en mayor o menor grado.

Y así, una vez más, hay una gran necesidad de Misiones Parroquiales Católicas sólidas que nos llamen a todos a una mayor conversión, ¡que nos llamen a renovar y regenerar nuestras vidas espirituales! La respuesta para todos nosotros es nuestra Misión Parroquial: es simplemente "lo que recetó el médico". Seremos bendecidos de tener una vez más un sacerdote que sea miembro de los Padres de la Misericordia. Los Padres de la Misericordia, de hecho, fueron fundados en Lyon, Francia en 1808 por un Sacerdote muy celoso y santo, el Padre Jean Baptiste Rauzan. Padre Rauzan reunió a un pequeño grupo de sacerdotes para formar una banda misionera con la idea de contrarrestar los efectos desastrosos de la Revolución Francesa en la fe del pueblo. La sociedad llegó a los Estados Unidos en 1939 y continúa el trabajo misionero del Padre Rauzán. Así como contrarrestó los efectos de la Revolución Francesa en la fe de la gente, así hoy, una vez más, los Padres de la Misericordia están ayudando a contrarrestar los efectos nocivos del modernismo en la Fe de la gente. Continúan predicando la verdad del Evangelio y nos ayudarán a todos a llegar al Cielo y salvar nuestras almas, el propósito total de nuestra vida aquí en la tierra. El fin de semana del 25 y 26 de febrero, el Padre William Casey, CMP hablará en todas nuestras Misas para inspirarnos a hacer la Misión Parroquial! ¡Acojámoslo y recemos juntos!

Y si tu mano derecha es para ti ocasión de pecado, córtatela y arrójala lejos de ti, porque más te vale perder una parte de tu cuerpo y no que todo él sea arrojado al lugar de castigo. También se dijo antes: *El que se divorcie, que le dé a su mujer un certificado de divorcio*; pero yo les digo que el que se divorcia, salvo el caso de que vivan en unión ilegítima, expone a su mujer al adulterio, y el que se casa con una divorciada comete adulterio.
