The Preacher of our Parish 2023 Mission is Rev. William Casey, C.P.M.

Father William Casey was born on November 3, 1955, and is a native of Philadelphia, Fr. Casey graduated from Temple in 1979 before serving as an officer in the U.S. Army. Upon completion of his military service, Father studied for the priesthood at Holy Apostles Seminary in CT. He has been a member of the Congregation of the Fathers of Mercy since 1986.

Originally founded in 1808 as "the Missionaries of France," the order set out to evangelize following years of Catholic persecution during the French Revolution. After the suppression of the order by a new revolutionary regime some three decades later, many priests of the community came to America where today's Fathers of Mercy were established.

Father Casey attributes his call to the priesthood to the Divine Mercy, his love for the study of Sacred Scripture and his strong devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

During our Parish Mission, Father will challenge us to make a stronger, deeper personal commitment to Christ and His Church. Among his Lenten topics: the reality of personal sin and the need for sincere conversion and repentance, the theology of Christian love and morality, the Blessed Virgin Mary and the biblical & historical foundations of the Catholic Church, specifically the Mass and the Holy Eucharist. Father Casey served as Superior General of his Congregation from 1997 to 2009. Since 1995, he has worked extensively with St. Joseph Communications, making regular appearances on EWTN since 1999.

## REQUESTS FOR ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATES

The role of a sponsor is primarily a Spiritual role to model a Christian life for the child. Therefore, anyone requesting a certificate **must** be a registered, **participating** member of St. Gianna Beretta Molla Parish, a **practicing** Catholic in good standing (not living in violation of the Church laws), at least 16 years of age and **have received the sacraments of initiation** (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist). Please call the Parish office to make an appointment.

## Sacrament of Marriage

Couples planning to marry at St. Gianna are expected to contact the Priest to arrange a date and time **FIRST**. Second, they must attend the Pre-Cana conferences as mandated by the Most Reverend Bishop. **A READING FROM THE HOLY GOSPEL ACCORDING TO MATTHEW**

**J**esus said to his disciples: "You have heard that it was said, *An eye for an eye and a tooth for a tooth*. But I say to you, offer no resistance to one who is evil. When someone strikes you on your right cheek, turn the other one as well. If anyone wants to go to law with you over your tunic, hand over your cloak as well. Should anyone press you into service for one mile, go for two miles. Give to the one who asks of you, and do not turn your back on one who wants to borrow. "You have heard that it was said; *You shall love your neighbor and hate your enemy*. But I say to you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, that you may be children of your heavenly Father, for he makes his sun rise on the bad and the good, and causes rain to fall on the just and the unjust. For if you love those who love you, what recompense will you have? Do not the tax collectors do the same? And if you greet your brothers only, what is unusual about that? 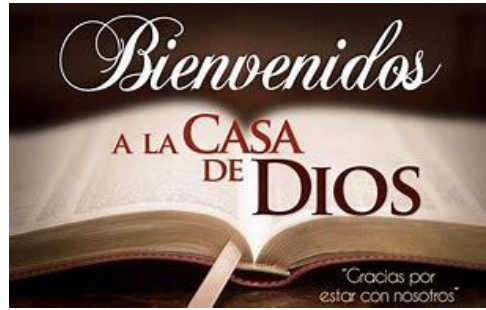

El padre William Casey nació el 3 de noviembre de 1955 y es nativo de Filadelfia, el p. Casey se graduó de Temple en 1979 antes de servir como oficial en el Ejército de los EE. UU. Al completar su servicio militar, el Padre estudió para el sacerdocio en el Seminario de los Santos Apóstoles en CT. Es miembro de la Congregación de los Padres de la Misericordia desde 1986. Originalmente fundada en 1808 como “los Misioneros de Francia”, la orden se propuso evangelizar luego de años de persecución católica durante la Revolución Francesa. Después de la supresión de la orden por un nuevo régimen revolucionario unas tres décadas después, muchos sacerdotes de la comunidad vinieron a América donde se establecieron los Padres de la Misericordia de hoy. El Padre Casey atribuye su llamado al sacerdocio a la Divina Misericordia, su amor por el estudio de la Sagrada Escritura y su fuerte devoción al Sagrado Corazón de Jesús y al Inmaculado Corazón de María. Durante nuestra Misión Parroquial, el Padre nos desafiará a hacer un compromiso personal más fuerte y más profundo con Cristo y Su Iglesia. Entre sus temas de Cuaresma: la realidad del pecado personal y la necesidad de conversión y arrepentimiento sincero, la teología del amor y la moral cristiana, la Santísima Virgen María y los fundamentos bíblicos e históricos de la Iglesia Católica, específicamente la Misa y la Sagrada Eucaristía. El Padre Casey se desempeñó como Superior General de su Congregación de 1997 a 2009. Desde 1995, ha trabajado extensamente con St. Joseph Communications, haciendo apariciones regulares en EWTN desde 1999.
