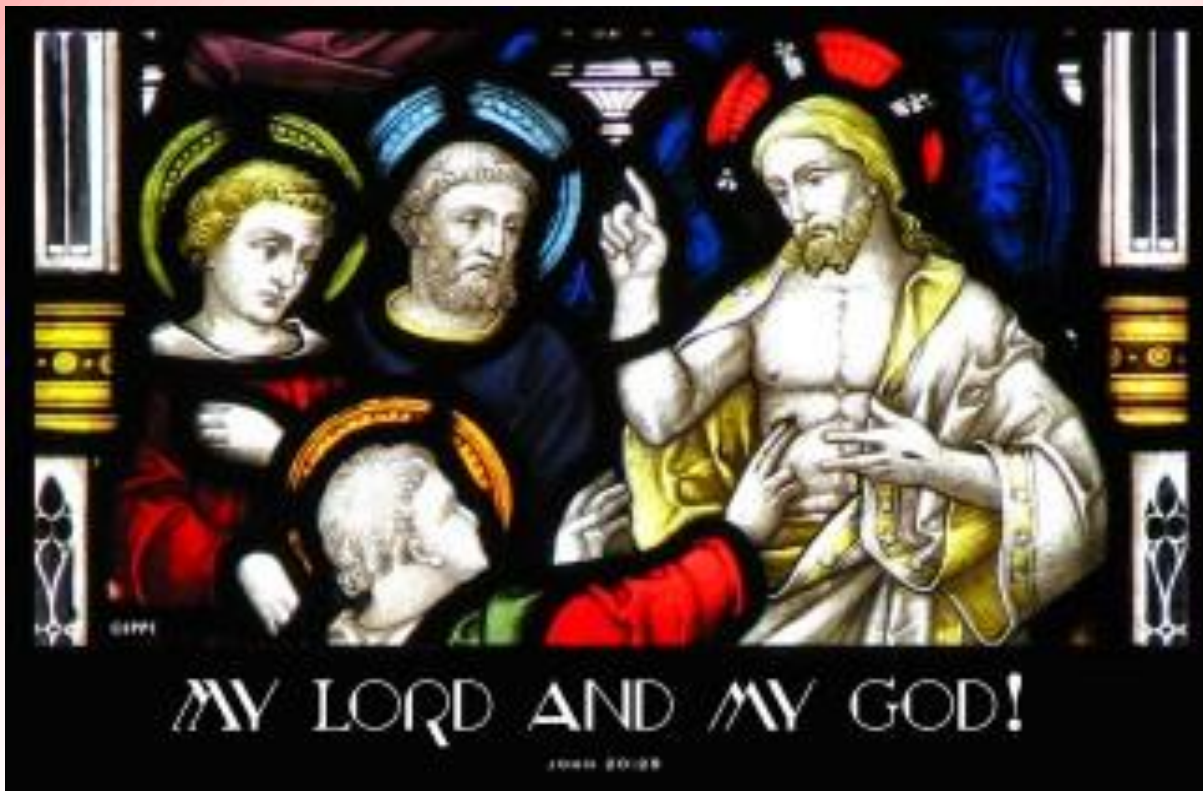

Triduum to St. Gianna, Our Beloved Patroness



Just like when we have a novena, which comes from the Latin word for nine NOVEM—it is nine days of prayer to a particular saint, or to the Holy Spirit, etc. — so too the word triduum comes from the Greek word from three — TRI so it is three days of prayer to St. Gianna.

Why should we make this triduum to St. Gianna?

1. She is the patroness of our Parish. That means she is the saint entrusted to us by the Bishop to watch over, protect and guide the priests and people of our Parish.
2. She therefore, has a special love for our priests and parishioners because she is devoted to her task — Patroness of the people of this Parish in Northfield, in the Diocese of Camden. St. Gianna is our “right hand man.”
3. Because of her role as our patroness she will be all ears to us who make this triduum. Her task will be to take our prayers, for whom we are praying, and present those intentions to her Lord and Master Jesus Christ.
4. Her prayers for us who make this triduum will be very powerful. After all, she was a very devoted mother and wife and she will “mother us” here in our parish named in her honor.
5. What should we pray for? St. Gianna is especially powerful in terms of family life, children, marital problems, birth issues, etc. So, this triduum would be very beneficial for families to attend or at least one or two family members. She is also very receptive to prayer from people with cancer tumors.

All in all, we owe St. Gianna a debt of gratitude for all the blessings she has wrought upon our parish family. It’s an occasion for us all to say thank you and yet incur a new debt to her by asking for her help.

I will be preaching the triduum. These three days will consist of opening hymn to St. Gianna, triduum prayers, sermon, benediction of the most Blessed Sacrament, and veneration of her relic (a lock of her hair).

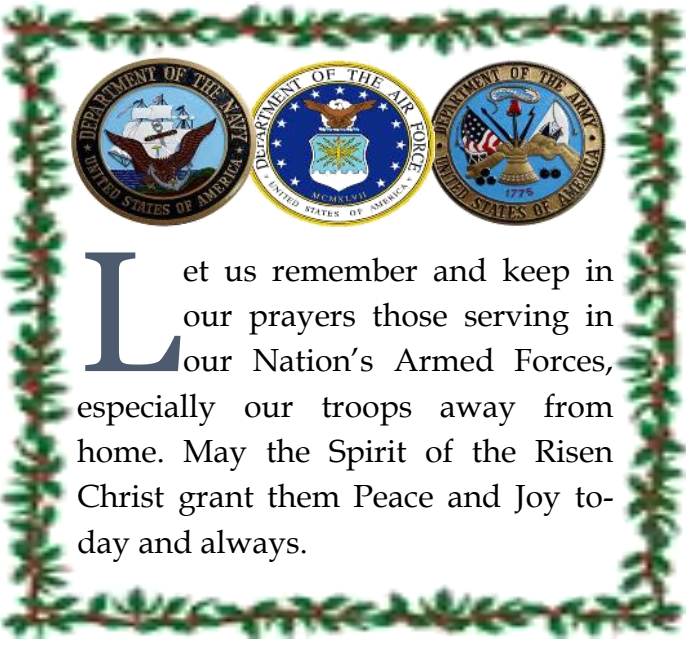




Dear Parishioners, Visitors and Friends,

Spot light on...

Easter Duty Obligation: After they have received their First Holy Communion, Catholics are bound by the obligation of receiving Holy Communion at least once a year. This precept should be fulfilled during the Easter Season. Catholics are also bound to confess serious (mortal) sins at least once a year, but this is not limited to the Lenten/Easter Season. The time for fulfilling the Paschal Precept (Easter Duty*) extends from the First Sunday of Lent, February 26, 2023 to the Solemnity of the Holy Trinity, June 4, 2023.

DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

The world was in the midst of the Great Depression in 1931 and the memories of World War I were still very much alive in the minds of Europeans when in Poland a sister of the Congregation of Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy, Faustina Kowalska (1905-1938), is said to have been personally visited by Jesus.

According to her diary, which was listed on the Index of Forbidden Books for more than 20 years, an image was revealed to her of the Risen Lord, from whose heart shone two rays, one red (representing blood) and the other "pale" (symbolizing water), with the words "Jesus, I trust in you" at the bottom. Faustina wrote in her diary that Jesus told her, *"I promise that the soul that will venerate this image will not perish."*

When she was canonized in 2000 under the direction of fellow countryman Pope John Paul II, he proclaimed that the Second Sunday of Easter would henceforth be known as Divine Mercy Sunday, thereby widely promoting the devotional practices associated with Faustina's visions, already popular in many communities.

St. Faustina, a poorly educated daughter of a humble Polish family, kept a 600-page diary of the apparitions she claimed continued for years. Her entries focus on God's mercy, the call to accept God's mercy and to be merciful, the need for conversion, and the call to trust in Jesus. It had been Jesus' own wish, she wrote, to establish a feast day: *"I [Jesus] desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls. . . . I am giving them the last hope of salvation; that is, the Feast of My Mercy."*

Among the practices associated with the devotion are its novena, the Chaplet of the Divine Mercy (a series of prayers organized similarly to a rosary), the Hour of Great Mercy (a time of prayer traditionally celebrated at 3 p.m.), and the Plenary Indulgence granted to those who confess and receive the Eucharist ten days before or ten days after Divine Mercy Sunday. *May 2011 issue of U.S. Catholic (Vol. 76, No. 5, page 46).*

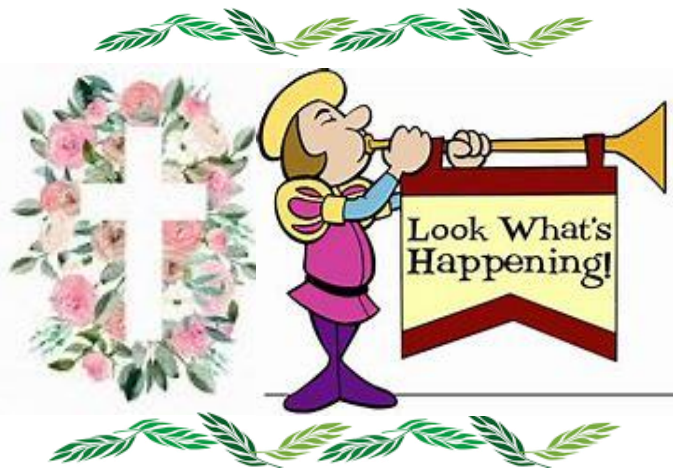

Solemn Mass in Honor of St. Gianna 7:00 PM

The Latin-rite Diocesan Bishops of the Ecclesiastical Province of Newark met last week and unanimously decided to permanently transfer the observance of the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord Jesus from the Thursday of the 6th Week of Easter to the following Sunday. Therefore, the observance of the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord Jesus will be celebrated on the Seventh Sunday of Easter. For this year, it will be observed on May 21st.



In the past, the Parishioners of St. Gianna have made memorial contributions to the **Easter Flower Fund**. This has become one of our loveliest traditions. Your contributions help defrays the cost of the flowers and present a beautiful, living memorial to your deceased loved ones. A READING FROM THE HOLY GOSPEL ACCORDING TO JOHN

On the evening of that first day of the week, when the doors were locked, where the disciples were, for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood in their midst and said to them, "Peace be with you." When he had said this, he showed them his hands and his side. The disciples rejoiced when they saw the Lord. Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you." And when he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained." Thomas, called Didymus, one of the Twelve, was not with them when Jesus came. So the other disciples said to him, "We have seen the Lord." Now, Jesus did many other signs in the presence of his disciples that are not written in this book. But these are written that you may come to believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that through this belief you may have life in his name. BAPTISMS

Baptisms are celebrated on the **LAST** Saturday of the month at 11 AM. Please call the Parish office to make the necessary arrangements two months prior to the Baptism date. Parents are expected to attend a Pre-Jordan Baptism class which is to be held on the **LAST Friday** of every month at 7 PM. in the Parish Hall. **Both Parents** are expected to attend the brief class (approximately 45 minutes).

PARENTS, PLEASE NOTE:

Be aware of the following qualifications before you ask someone to be the Godparent of your child. According to Canon Law the Godparent...

- ◆ Must be at least 16 years of age
- ◆ If the sponsor is married must be married in accord with the laws of the Catholic Church
- ◆ Must have received all the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Communion).
- ◆ Be a practicing Catholic; i.e., attend Mass regularly on Sunday and Holy Days of obligation and receive the Sacraments of the Church regularly

If you have any additional questions, please do not hesitate to call the Parish office (646-5611).

REQUESTS FOR ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATES

The role of a sponsor is primarily a Spiritual role to model a Christian life for the child. Therefore, anyone requesting a certificate **must** be a registered, **participating** member of St. Gianna Beretta Molla Parish, a **practicing** Catholic in good standing (not living in violation of the Church laws), at least 16 years of age and **have received the sacraments of initiation** (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist). Please call the Parish office for an appointment.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Couples planning to marry at St. Gianna are expected to contact the Priest to arrange a date and time **FIRST**. Second, they must attend the Pre-Cana conferences as mandated by the Most Reverend Bishop. The period of preparation for marriage is a minimum of **six** months to ensure completion of all arrangements before the wedding day. Please contact the Parish office for more information.

Triduo a Santa Gianna, Nuestra Querida Patrona

Cuando oramos por nueve días consecutivos a un Santo en especial o al Espíritu Santo decimos que estamos haciendo una "novena." La palabra, "novena", proviene de la palabra latina NOVEM, que significa nueve." Así también tenemos la palabra "triduo" que proviene de la palabra griega TRI que significa tres. Esto es precisamente lo que vamos a hacer en honor a la Patrona de Nuestra Parroquia, Santa Gianna. Un TRIDUO, es decir tres días consecutivos de oración en su honor.



¿Por qué deberíamos hacer este triduo a Santa Gianna? Les voy a enumerar 5 razones...

1. Ella es la patrona de nuestra parroquia. Eso significa que ella es la santa que el Obispo nos ha confiado para vigilar, proteger y guiar a los sacerdotes y a las personas que componen esta, nuestra Parroquia.
2. Por lo tanto, ella tiene un amor especial por nosotros, los sacerdotes y por todos los feligreses. Santa Gianna esta dedicada especialmente a ser la Patrona de esta parroquia aquí en este Northfield y en esta diócesis. St. Gianna es nuestra "mano derecha".
3. Debido a que su tarea como patrona de nuestra iglesia es escucharnos, ella escuchará muy especialmente a todos los que hacen este triduo. Tomara nuestras oraciones y a todos por quienes estamos orando, y presentara nuestras intenciones a su Señor y Maestro, Jesucristo.
4. Su intercesión por nosotros, los que hacemos este triduo, será muy poderosas. Después de todo, ella era una madre y esposa ejemplar y como tal, nos "amará y guiará" como una madre guía y ama a sus hijos puesto que esta parroquia fue consagrada y nombrada en su honor.
5. ¿Por qué deberíamos orar? Porque St. Gianna intercede muy poderosamente en lo que se refiere a términos de familia, niños, problemas maritales, problemas de nacimiento, etc. Es muy importante que las familias participen en este triduo., al menos uno o dos miembros de sus miembros. Ella también es muy receptiva a la oración de personas con tumores cancerosos.

En general, tenemos con St. Gianna una deuda de gratitud por todas las bendiciones que ha obrado sobre nuestra familia parroquial. Es una oportunidad para que todos le agradezcamos e incurramos en una nueva deuda con ella pidiéndole ayuda.
