Our Parish Novena to Saint Anthony begins on Monday, June 5th at 7:00 PM with a Sermon, Novena Prayers and Benediction and continues until June 13th, Feast of St. Anthony. The Novena schedule is:

June 5-13, 2023

~Sermon, Novena Prayers & Benediction nightly at 7:00 PM.

~Feast of St. Anthony, Tuesday, June 13th: on this day the Novena will conclude with Holy Mass at 7:00 PM.

Among the many Saints of Christendom, there are some who seem to endear themselves to the faithful more than others. One of these saints is St. Anthony of Padua. For over 800 years people of every nation have turned to him for help in times of need. He has never lost his popularity with Catholics and even non-Catholics especially when they have misplaced their keys, lost their wallets, diamond rings or husbands! But, besides being the saint one prays to for lost things, he is a saint one can invoke for all things needed.

Our Lord must love him very, very much because the child Jesus appeared to St. Anthony and we can see the Child Jesus on his arm. One of the reasons St. Anthony never lost his popularity is because he is a friend you can depend on. He just doesn't listen to our requests, he always acts on them. When you pray to him, you become his friend. He takes your friendship very seriously. He takes your prayers with tremendous love and concern and brings them to Jesus, the Infant Jesus who appeared to him and caressed his face.

The upcoming Solemn Novena to St. Anthony which begins on Monday night, June 5th at 7:00 PM, will be a constant petition for nine days to him to take our special intentions, whatever they may be – perhaps you have a very serious decision to make, a job to find, a relationship to heal, illness whether it be you or a family member or a friend looking to be cured, financial difficulties, emotional problems, depression –

whatever special favors you need granted, turn to Saint Anthony. People have continued to pray to him for 800 years because he never lets his friends down.

Won't you join his very devoted clients and make the Solemn Novena?

It will take sacrifice and time for nine days, but hey, that's what friends are for!

I'll be looking forward to seeing you during the Novena and please encourage your own friends, relatives and neighbors to join in making the Novena culminating on June 13th with a Solemn Mass at 7 PM with the distribution of blessed Saint Anthony's Bread.

The format each night will be opening hymns to Saint Anthony, Novena prayers, Sermon on a particular aspect of Saint Anthony's life followed by Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament and Veneration of the First Class Relic of Saint Anthony, which I have procured, from Saint Anthony's Basilica in Padua where Saint Anthony is buried.



FEAST OF THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST

"At that time Jesus said to the multitude of the Jews: 'My Flesh is food indeed and my Blood is drink indeed. He who eats my Flesh and drinks my Blood abides in Me and I in him. As the living Father has sent me, and as I live because of Him. This is the bread that has come down from heaven; not as your father ate manna and died. He who eats this bread shall live forever.'" John 6: 56-59

The heart and soul of Catholicism is the Blessed Eucharist. It is the center of all Catholic love, the divine focus of all Catholic thinking. From the Most Blessed Sacrament there flows into the bloodstream of Catholicism all the riches, all the treasures, all the Graces which God has allowed to men on earth. There could hardly be Catholicism were there is no sanctuary, no tabernacle, no sacramental Presence. For the Roman Catholic, preaching alone does not constitute this religion, nor Bible alone, nor the singing of hymns: The Blessed Sacrament is more important than all these. It is His life, it is His all, it is His everything. This is not just a sentimental excursion into the region of the Divine, the Sacrament of Love. It is a fact, branded deeply upon the soul of the Catholic, and is the most certain portion of his heritage, the finest part of one's religious life! One knows that Jesus is present in his church! One can leave the bland world outside and enter one's church not just for rest, not for ease, not for consolation necessarily – but to VISIT and ADORE the living CHRIST one knows is there! *Why does one genuflect? Why does one bow? Why does one kneel?* Because one knows Jesus Christ is there! Because one knows that Jesus is God, and that when Jesus said, "This is My Body...this is My Blood," Jesus meant it as only God could mean such a thing! The Catholic knows, more than he knows anything on earth, that Jesus SACRAMENTALLY is there. He is the REAL PRESENCE! "He who eats this Bread shall live forever!" The world is in a frightful condition of disorder today. We are more accustomed to war than peace. We are used to reports of no bread and horrible starvation. We are used to, on the other hand, obesity, sinful drunkenness, debauchery. And all the time, with the tens of thousands of sanctuary lights of peace and plenty burning steadily in every Catholic Church throughout the world for the tremendous reason that Jesus is present sacramentally, the world goes on its way, ignoring Him Who lives in our midst as surely as He ever did over 2,000 years ago! THIS IS THE TREMENDOUS ENDOWMENT OF CATHOLICISM, THAT WE HAVE JESUS LITERALLY AT OUR BECK AND CALL! That which looks like bread at Mass and has the sweet smell of wine, is after consecration, no longer bread and wine, but the Body and Blood of Jesus. From our earliest hours of reason, we have been receiving Jesus in the Blessed Eucharist. Our entire life has revolved around it ever since. As Catholics, there would be no reason for us ever to come to church but for the Blessed Sacrament. As a matter of fact, all of us, when we seriously think things over, measure our present spirituality in comparison with our First Communion day!

This weekend we celebrate the feast of the Body of Christ – Corpus Christi! Act as Honor Guards to the Sacred Body of Christ! It is yours whenever you desire! You can not enjoy a more rare privilege! My Lord and my God, my food and my life – at the communion rail and tabernacle of my Church.



BAPTISMS

Baptisms are celebrated on the **LAST** Saturday of the month at 11 AM. Please call the Parish office to make the necessary arrangements two months prior to the Baptism date. Parents are expected to attend a Pre-Jordan Baptism class which is to be held on the **LAST Friday** of every month at 7 PM. in the Parish Hall. **Both Parents** are expected to attend the brief class (approximately 45 minutes).

PARENTS, PLEASE NOTE:

Be aware of the following qualifications before you ask someone to be the Godparent of your child. According to Canon Law the Godparent...

- ◆ Must be at least 16 years of age
- ◆ If the sponsor is married must be married in accord with the laws of the Catholic Church
- ◆ Must have received all the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Communion).
- ◆ Be a practicing Catholic; i.e., attend Mass regularly on Sunday and Holy Days of obligation and receive the Sacraments of the Church regularly

If you have any additional questions, please do not hesitate to call the Parish office (646-5611).

REQUESTS FOR ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATES

The role of a sponsor is primarily a Spiritual role to model a Christian life for the child. Therefore, anyone requesting a certificate **must** be a registered, **participating** member of St. Gianna Beretta Molla Parish, a **practicing** Catholic in good standing (not living in violation of the Church laws), at least 16 years of age and **have received the sacraments of initiation** (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist). Please call the Parish office for an appointment.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Couples planning to marry at St. Gianna are expected to contact the Priest to arrange a date and time **FIRST**. Second, they must attend the Pre-Cana conferences as mandated by the Most Reverend Bishop. The period of preparation for marriage is a minimum of **six** months to ensure completion of all arrangements before the wedding day. Bulletin Announcements/Articles

Please refrain from handling administrative affairs in the sacristy of the church, most especially before or after of any of the Liturgies. The sacristy is used by Priests, Deacons and Altar Servers preparing to celebrate the Liturgies and distractions of this nature can easily disturb the holiness and the tranquility they need.

Pulpit Announcements: Due to time, Diocese and Parish priorities, pulpit announcements are limited and subject to the Pastor's discretion. However, the announcements **MUST be submitted to the Parish office FIRST, NOT to any of the priests in the sacristy of the church.**

Flyers, cards and/or propaganda in the church (*bulletin boards at the entrances of the church*). Our Parish welcomes Parishioners, Visitors and Friends to God's house every day. We are proud of the appearance of our Church and our heartfelt thanks to those people working to keep God's dwelling in order, devoid of disturbing distractions, and preserving the décor and respect our Lord deserves. We ask you to please remember that::

- ◆ NO announcements/articles and/or propaganda of any kind are permitted on the *Main Bulletin Boards* placed in the gathering area of the church
- ◆ Flyers of events that are not taking place in our Parish are welcome to be placed at any of the four bulletin boards (side entrances of the church). However, they need to be submitted to the Parish for Pastoral approval **NOT to the priests in the sacristy of the church.**

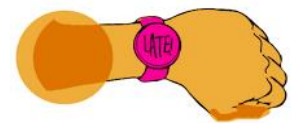

It is right to acknowledge the **Lord's Real Presence** with a brief act of worship on **entering or leaving** the Church and **every time** passing by the Sanctuary. Normally, a *genuflection* in the direction of the place of Reservation is enough. One who is physically unable to genuflect may substitute a *profound bow* at the waist.

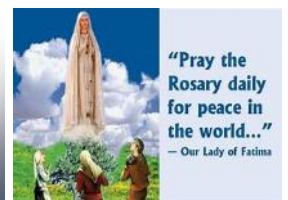

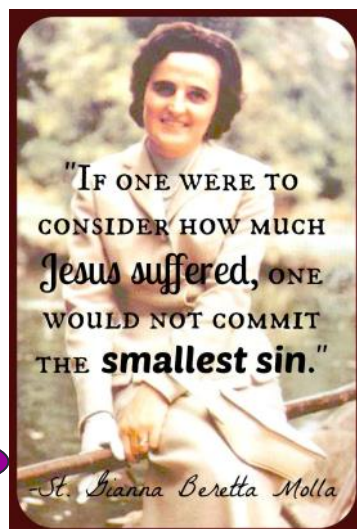

DEL ESCRITORIO DE PADRE ANTHONY

¿Qué es un santo?
