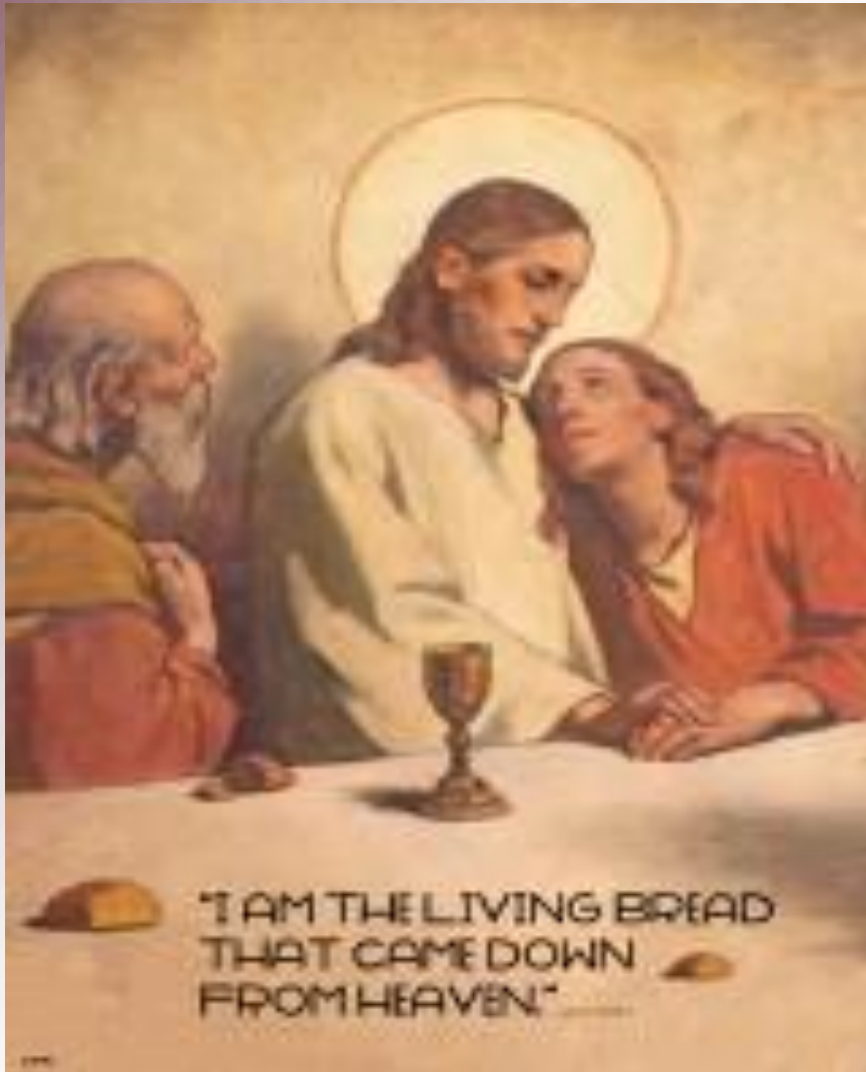

FROM THE
PASTOR'S DESK

FEAST OF THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST

"At that time Jesus said to the multitude of the Jews: 'My Flesh is food indeed and my Blood is drink indeed. He who eats my Flesh and drinks my Blood abides in Me and I in him. As the living Father has sent me, and I live because of the Father, so the one who feeds on me will live because of me. This is the bread that came down from heaven; your ancestors ate manna and died, but whoever feeds on this bread will live forever.'" John 6: 56-59

The heart and soul of Catholicism is the Blessed Eucharist. It is the center of all Catholic love, the divine focus of all Catholic thinking. From the Most Blessed Sacrament there flows into the bloodstream of Catholicism all the riches, all the treasures, all the Graces which God has allowed to men on earth. There could hardly be Catholicism where there is no sanctuary, no tabernacle, no Sacramental Presence. For the Roman Catholic, preaching alone does not constitute this religion, nor Bible alone, nor the singing of hymns: The Blessed Sacrament is more important than all these. It is His life, it is His all, it is His everything. This is not just a sentimental excursion into the region of the Divine, the Sacrament of Love. It is a fact, branded deeply upon the soul of the Catholic, and is the most certain portion of his heritage, the finest part of one's religious life! One knows that Jesus is present in his church! One can leave the bland world outside and enter one's church not just for rest, not for ease, not for consolation necessarily – but to VISIT and ADORE the living CHRIST one knows is there! *Why does one genuflect? Why does one bow? Why does one kneel?* Because one knows Jesus Christ is there! Because one knows that Jesus is God, and that when Jesus said, "This is My Body...this is My Blood," Jesus meant it as only God could mean such a thing! The Catholic knows, more than he knows anything on earth, that Jesus SACRAMENTALLY is there. He is the REAL PRESENCE! "He who eats this Bread shall live forever!" The world is in a frightful condition of disorder today. We are more accustomed to war than peace. We are used to reports of no bread and horrible starvation. We are used to, on the other hand, obesity, sinful drunkenness, debauchery. And all the time, with the tens of thousands of sanctuary lights of peace and plenty burning steadily in every Catholic Church throughout the world for the tremendous reason that Jesus is present sacramentally, the world goes on its way, ignoring Him Who lives in our midst as surely as He ever did over 2,000 years ago! THIS IS THE TREMENDOUS ENDOWMENT OF CATHOLICISM, THAT WE HAVE JESUS LITERALLY AT OUR BECK AND CALL! That which looks like bread at Mass and has the sweet smell of wine, is after consecration, no longer bread and wine, but the Body and Blood of Jesus. From our earliest hours of reason, we have been receiving Jesus in the Blessed Eucharist. Our entire life has revolved around it ever since. As Catholics, there would be no reason for us ever to come to church but for the Blessed Sacrament. As a matter of fact, all of us, when we seriously think things over, measure our present spirituality in comparison with our First Communion day! This weekend we celebrate the feast of the Body of Christ – Corpus Christi! Act as Honor Guards to the Sacred Body of Christ! It is yours whenever you desire! You can not enjoy a more rare privilege! My Lord and my God, my food and my life – at the communion rail and tab-

- ◆ Must be at least 16 years of age
- ◆ If the sponsor is married must be married in accord with the laws of the Catholic Church
- ◆ Must have received all the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Communion).
- ◆ Be a practicing Catholic; i.e., attend Mass regularly on Sunday and Holy Days of obligation and receive the Sacraments of the Church regularly

REQUESTS FOR ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATES

The role of a sponsor is primarily a Spiritual role to model a Christian life for the child. Therefore, anyone requesting a certificate **must** be a registered, **participating** member of St. Gianna Beretta Molla Parish, a **practicing** Catholic in good standing (not living in violation of the Church laws), at least 16 years of age and **have received the sacraments of initiation** (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist). SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Second, they must attend the Pre-Cana conferences as mandated by the Most Reverend Bishop. The sacristy is used by Priests, Deacons and Altar Servers preparing to celebrate the Liturgies and distractions of this nature can easily disturb the holiness and the tranquility they need.

Pulpit Announcements: Due to time, Diocese and Parish priorities, pulpit announcements are limited and subject to the Pastor's discretion. However, the announcements **MUST be submitted to the Parish office FIRST, NOT to any of the priests in the sacristy of the church.**

Flyers, cards and/or propaganda in the church (*bulletin boards at the entrances of the church*). Our Parish welcomes Parishioners, Visitors and Friends to God's house every day. We are proud of the appearance of our Church and our heartfelt thanks to those people working to keep God's dwelling in order, devoid of disturbing distractions, and preserving the décor and respect our Lord deserves. We ask you to please remember that::

- ◆ NO announcements/articles and/or propaganda of any kind are permitted on the *Main Bulletin Boards* placed in the gathering area of the church
- ◆ Flyers of events that are not taking place in our Parish are welcome to be placed at any of the four bulletin boards (side entrances of the church). However, they need to be submitted to the Parish for Pastoral approval **NOT to the priests in the sacristy of the church.**

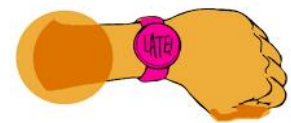

It is right to acknowledge the **Lord's Real Presence** with a brief act of worship on **entering or leaving** the Church and **every time** passing by the Sanctuary. Normally, a *genuflection* in the direction of the place of Reservation is enough. One who is physically unable to genuflect may substitute a *profound bow* at the waist.

A READING FROM THE FIRST LETTER OF SAINT PAUL TO THE CORINTHIANS

Brothers and sisters: The cup of blessing that we bless, is it not a participation in the blood of Christ? The bread that we break, is it not a participation in the body of Christ? Because the loaf of bread is one, we, though many, are one body, for we all partake of the one loaf. The Word of the Lord. **Thanks be to God.**

SEQUENCE: LAUDA SION

Laud, O Zion, your salvation, Laud with hymns of exultation, Christ, your king and shepherd true: Bring him all the praise you know, He is more than you bestow. Never can you reach his due. Special theme for glad thanksgiving Is the quick'ning and the living Bread today before you set: From his hands of old partaken, as we know, by faith unshaken, where the Twelve at supper met. Full and clear ring out your chanting, joy nor sweetest grace be wanting, from your heart let praises burst: for today the feast is holden, when the institution olden of that supper was rehearsed. Here the new law's new oblation, by the new king's revelation, ends the form of ancient rite: now the new the old effaces, truth away the shadow chases, light dispels the gloom of night. What he did at supper seated, Christ ordained to be repeated, His memorial ne'er to cease: And his rule for guidance taking, bread and wine we hallow, making thus our sacrifice of peace. This the truth each Christian learns, bread into his flesh he turns, to his precious blood the wine: Sight has fail'd, nor thought conceives, but a dauntless faith believes, resting on a pow'r divine.



Here beneath these signs are hidden priceless things to sense forbidden; signs, not things are all we see: Blood is poured and flesh is broken, yet in either wondrous token Christ entire we know to be.
