



~As we pondered the question, "What do we hear about in the Bible?" a five-year old blurted out, "Jesus is the Light of the World...and He is the biggest light of all."

These are actual quotes from our Catechesis of the Good Shepherd children and parents alike here at St. Gianna Beretta Molla Parish. Someone observing would say "It's magic!" but we know it is the work of the Holy Spirit. Catechesis of the Good Shepherd has not only benefited the children and their families but our entire church community. It has become a project that people of all ages, from teens to seniors, have participated in, as all materials in "the Atrium" are handmade. Our entire space and all materials have been made and donated by our St. Gianna's community.

The Atrium is an environment prepared to nurture the child's spirituality, with beautiful hands-on materials that focus the child's attention and assist their personal work on key scripture passages or liturgical moments. Children grow in their relationship with the Good Shepherd through prayer, singing, silence, and by exploring Biblical parables, historical narratives, and liturgical events.

Time given for the child to work allows Christ, the Inner Teacher, to teach. This program is based on the belief that God and the child have a unique relationship with one another, particularly before the age of six, and that growth of this relationship should be assisted by the adult, but is directed by the Spirit of God within the child. Children need their own place to foster the growth of that relationship, allowing the child to "fall in love with God," and increasing their desire to know Him better.

Three cheers to our teachers who joyfully have volunteered to teach this form of religious education under the direction of Vici Butler!!! Registration for the upcoming school year is underway. Please visit the Religious Education office or call Vici at 609-646-0806 for more information.

BAPTISMS

Baptisms are celebrated on the LAST Saturday of the month at 11 AM. Please call the Parish office to make the necessary arrangements two months prior to the Baptism date. Parents are expected to attend a Pre-Jordan Baptism class which is to be held on the **LAST Friday** of every month at 7 PM. in the Parish Hall. **Both Parents** are expected to attend the brief class (approximately 45 minutes).

PARENTS, PLEASE NOTE:

Be aware of the following qualifications before you ask someone to be the Godparent of your child. According to Canon Law the Godparent...

- ◆ Must be at least 16 years of age
- ◆ If the sponsor is married must be married in accord with the laws of the Catholic Church
- ◆ Must have received all the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Communion).
- ◆ Be a practicing Catholic; i.e., attend Mass regularly on Sunday and Holy Days of obligation and receive the Sacraments of the Church regularly

If you have any additional questions, please do not hesitate to call the Parish office (646-5611).

REQUESTS FOR ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATES

The role of a sponsor is primarily a Spiritual role to model a Christian life for the child. Therefore, anyone requesting a certificate **must** be a registered, **participating** member of St. Gianna Beretta Molla Parish, a **practicing** Catholic in good standing (not living in violation of the Church laws), at least 16 years of age and **have received the sacraments of initiation** (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist). Please call the Parish office for an appointment.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Couples planning to marry at St. Gianna are expected to contact the Priest to arrange a date and time **FIRST**. Second, they must attend the Pre-Cana conferences as mandated by the Most Reverend Bishop. The period of preparation for marriage is a minimum of **six** months to ensure completion of all arrangements before the wedding day. Please contact the Parish office for more information.

What are the Five First Saturdays?

Our Lady explained those Five First Saturdays to Sr. Lucia dos Santos, one of the Fatima visionaries, on Dec. 10, 1925, in the following way:

"See, my daughter, my Heart encircled by thorns with which ungrateful men pierce it at every moment by their blasphemies and ingratitude. Do you, at least, strive to console me. Tell them that I promise to assist at the hour of death with the graces necessary for salvation all those who, in order to make reparation to me, on the First Saturday of five successive months, go to Confession, receive Holy Communion, say five decades of the Rosary, and keep me company for a quarter of an hour, meditating on the ... mysteries of the Rosary."

Why five First Saturdays in particular? Jesus explained this to Sr. Lucia on May 29-30, 1930, saying:

Daughter, the motive is simple: There are five kinds of offenses and blasphemies spoken against the Immaculate Heart of Mary. **First**: blasphemies against the Immaculate Conception. **Second**: against her Virginity. **Third**: against the Divine Maternity, refusing, at the same time, to receive her as the Mother of mankind. **Fourth**: those who seek publicly to implant, in the hearts of children, indifference, disrespect, and even hate for this Immaculate Mother. **Fifth**: those who revile her directly in her sacred images. Here, dear daughter, is the motive that led the Immaculate Heart of Mary to petition Me to ask for this small act of reparation. And, out of regard for her, to move My mercy to pardon those souls who have had the misfortune to offend her. As for you, seek endlessly, with your prayers and sacrifices, to move Me to mercy in regard to these poor souls.

Do they still matter?

Now, a lot of people have forgotten about the Five First Saturdays devotion, but it's still relevant today - wars are still going on! We still haven't seen the fulfillment of Our Lady's promise that "In the end, my Immaculate Heart will triumph. The Holy Father will consecrate Russia to me, and she will be converted, and a period of peace will be granted to the world." According to Sr. Lucia, St. John Paul II consecrated Russia to Mary's Immaculate Heart on March 25, 1984. The USSR fell shortly afterwards. And yet there's still not peace in the world. Why? Ask yourself: Have most of us been faithful to her requests, especially the First Saturdays of Reparation?

So I call on everyone to start making the Five First Saturdays a regular part of their prayer life! In order to encourage devotion to the "missing ingredient" of Our Lady of Fatima's request, St. Gianna's will be offering the necessary elements:

8:00 a.m. ~Recitation of the Rosary

8:30 a.m.~Mass

9:05 – 9:20 a.m.~Meditations on the Mysteries of the Rosary

3:00 p.m.~ Confessions

Each month we will dedicate our prayers to reparation of a particular blasphemy against the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

La Catequesis del Buen Pastor no solo ha beneficiado a los niños y sus familias, sino a toda nuestra comunidad parroquial. Se ha convertido en un proyecto en el que han participado personas de todas las edades, desde adolescentes hasta personas mayores, ya que todos los materiales en "el Atrio" están hechos a mano.

Todo nuestro espacio y todos los materiales han sido hechos y donados por la comunidad de St. Gianna.

El atrio es un ambiente preparado para nutrir la espiritualidad del niño, con hermosos materiales prácticos que enfocan la atención del niño y ayudan a su trabajo personal en pasajes bíblicos clave o momentos litúrgicos. Los niños crecen en su relación con el Buen Pastor a través de la oración, el canto, el silencio y la exploración de paráboles bíblicas, narraciones históricas y eventos litúrgicos.

El tiempo que se le da al niño para trabajar le permite a Cristo, el Maestro Interno, enseñar. Este programa se basa en la creencia de que Dios y el niño tienen una relación única entre sí, particularmente antes de los seis años, y que el crecimiento de esta relación debe ser asistido por el adulto, pero está dirigido por el Espíritu de Dios dentro del niño.
