



THE FEAST OF THE ASSUMPTION

August 15, 2023

The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin presents to us a very special occasion for considering Mary's virtues, which are the worthiest objects of our imitation. Mary triumphs as the Immaculate Virgin and the Mother of Jesus because of her sublime purity. She is crowned the omnipotent Queen, because on earth she was a servant, the obedient handmaid of the Lord. She is of all creatures the most exalted in Heaven, because she was the humblest on earth. She, who observed the lowliest poverty and renounced all things in life, now possesses complete dominion over all things and is the Dispensatrix of all God's graces and riches. Mary triumphed by walking the Way of the Cross in the footsteps of her Divine Son. Now she sits at His right hand, the Queen of Angels and of men. All generations of the past have called her Blessed and all generations of the future will continue to do so, as she, the Queen of Prophets, foretold.

BAPTISMS

Parents are expected to attend a Pre-Jordan Baptism class which is to be held on the LAST Friday of every month at 7 PM. in the Parish Hall. **Both Parents** are expected to attend the brief class (approximately 45 minutes).

PARENTS, PLEASE NOTE:

Be aware of the following qualifications before you ask someone to be the Godparent of your child. According to Canon Law the Godparent...

- ◆ Must be at least 16 years of age
- ◆ If the sponsor is married must be married in accord with the laws of the Catholic Church
- ◆ Must have received all the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Communion).
- ◆ Be a practicing Catholic; i.e., attend Mass regularly on Sunday and Holy Days of obligation and receive the Sacraments of the Church regularly

If you have any additional questions, please do not hesitate to call the Parish office (646-5611).

REQUESTS FOR ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATES

The role of a sponsor is primarily a Spiritual role to model a Christian life for the child. Therefore, anyone requesting a certificate **must** be a registered, **participating** member of St. Gianna Beretta Molla Parish, a **practicing** Catholic in good standing (not living in violation of the Church laws), at least 16 years of age and **have received the sacraments of initiation** (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist). Please call the Parish office for an appointment.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Couples planning to marry at St. Gianna are expected to contact the Priest to arrange a date and time **FIRST**. Second, they must attend the Pre-Cana conferences as mandated by the Most Reverend Bishop. The period of preparation for marriage is a minimum of **six** months to ensure completion of all arrangements before the wedding day. Please contact the Parish office for more information.

Normally, a *genuflection* in the direction of the place of Reservation is enough. One who is physically unable to genuflect may substitute a *profound bow* at the waist.

Assigned Missionary: Sister Lisa Valentin, MSC







A READING FROM THE HOLY GOSPEL ACCORDING TO MATTHEW

La Asunción de la Santísima Virgen María

DOMINGO 15 DE AGOSTO

La Asunción de María tiene muchos significados. Para el trabajador estadounidense esta celebración llega en un momento en que hace demasiado calor para trabajar y es demasiado tarde para tomar unas vacaciones. Para el niño de la escuela, es una de esas palabras latinas imposibles de pronunciar que siempre se mezcla con la Ascensión y que no se pueden deletrear de ninguna manera.

La Asunción de María, sin embargo, significa mucho más que eso. La llamamos la Fiesta de su Coronación, ya sabes, porque es el resultado lógico de su dignidad como la Virgen Inmaculada Madre de Dios. Le dio todo el crédito a Dios al decir simplemente; "De aquí en adelante todas las generaciones me llamarán Bienaventurada, porque Aquel que es Poderoso hizo grandes cosas para mí y Santo es Su nombre."
