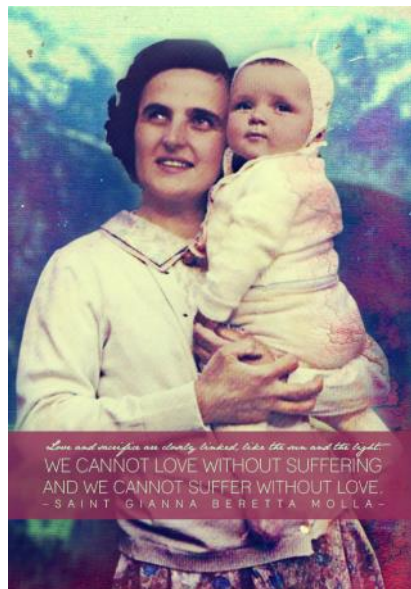

Importance of Parental Blessing



As your children return to school in a couple of weeks, I am suggesting to parents that they return to the age-old custom of *blessing* their children. Start a new chapter in your family's history. A half century ago – and far beyond – the *parental blessing* used to be a common custom. In recent years, as conveniences, we gradually abandoned many of our precious spiritual values. Does this mean that we don't need spiritual blessings anymore? Indeed, the opposite is true. We need them more than ever before! Because along with our increasing worldliness we have suffered a corresponding loss of spiritual values! Let's not just talk about our loss and bewail it, but, get moving and rebuild our Catholic faith, our Catholic customs. Fathers and mothers are the *priests* and *sisters* of their own "little churches" – their homes! They are placed there to teach and to bless. It is a solemn scene, a touching sight for a mother or a father passing from one kneeling child to another, imparting their blessing. Open hands are laid momentarily on the child's head. You may wish to add a few words, admirations, petitions, etc. Parental blessing is as old as the human race! It began with the oldest patriarchs. Throughout the Old Testament it was the usual method of transmitting divine favors. The blessings conferred on their children by Abraham, Isaac and Jacob are known to all who read the Bible. The Bible gives us an authoritative statement on parental blessing:

"In word and deed, honor your father that his blessing may come upon you, for a father's blessing gives a family firm roots, but a mother's curse uproots the growing plant." Ecclesiastes 3:8-9

Our Lord used to gather the little children around Him and bless them. He said, "Suffer the little children to come unto Me! Then, embracing them and laying His hands upon them, He blessed them. Parents love their children. They embrace them. Why do they not lay their hands upon them in a blessing? Parents so rarely bless their children that one is inclined to think that the privilege no longer exists. JESUS WANTS CHILDREN TO BE BLESSED! Certainly, the blessing bestowed by Jesus is more efficacious than that bestowed by parents. So also is the blessing of the Priest. Even so, parental blessing is something so Holy, so powerful, that it deserves to be called the Sacrament of the Domestic Hearth. The picture of a young mother placing hands of benediction on an innocent child is beautiful to behold. No less inspiring is the sight of an aged parent giving with trembling hands a blessing to a full-grown son or daughter! This is a privilege that belongs to fathers and mothers. Often you are urged to do your duty. Here you are urged to use a privilege. This is yours by divine grant – a privilege that goes with the dignity of parenthood. *SO, WHY NOT BLESS YOUR CHILDREN?* If this "Sacrament of the Domestic Hearth" were more frequently administered, there would be many more happy, contented families. The two indispensable factors for happiness in the home are amiable authority on the part of the parents and loving obedience on the part of the children. If your home is not all that you would like it to be, try blessing your children regularly. It will encourage oneness, love, reverence and obedience. Some years ago, the newspapers attracted the attention of readers with the headline: "Bishop kneels for Mother's blessing." The bishop was Bishop Roach of India. He met his mother at the railway station, then in the presence of a crowd of people, he knelt before his mother to receive her blessing and the grand old lady, placing her wrinkled hands on the head of her illustrious son, moved many spectators to tears. Fathers and mothers, open up to your children this effective means of grace. Make a diligent and frequent use of this great privilege. Pray over them, "May you live a long life in holiness and happiness in Christ."

When ought parents bless their children?

- ◆ At night is a very good time to give a daily blessing
- ◆ Before going on a trip, undertaking an important or dangerous task, during sickness, children ought to receive their parent's Blessing
- ◆ At the more important turning points in life, e.g.: entering school; First Holy Communion, entering Marriage or upon entering the convent, monastery or seminary

Send a blessing to your absent children. Before you go to bed at night, think of your absent sons or daughters. They may be in real need of your help. Your blessing is the most powerful help you can give them. Protect them with the Sacred Sign of the Cross that you make over them or in their direction.

- *Acknowledge the pain grief brings.

- *Take care of yourself and be kind to yourself, grief can be consuming.
- *Seek out help for yourself or someone who you feel may be suffering from depression.

BAPTISMS

Baptisms are celebrated on the LAST Saturday of the month at 11 AM. Please call the Parish office to make the necessary arrangements two months prior to the Baptism date. Parents are expected to attend a Pre-Jordan Baptism class which is to be held on the **LAST Friday** of every month at 7:30 PM. in the Parish Hall. **Both Parents** are expected to attend the brief class (approximately 45 minutes).

PARENTS, PLEASE NOTE:

Be aware of the following qualifications before you ask someone to be the Godparent of your child. According to Canon Law the Godparent...

- ◆ Must be at least 16 years of age
- ◆ If the sponsor is married must be married in accord with the laws of the Catholic Church
- ◆ Must have received all the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Communion).
- ◆ Be a practicing Catholic; i.e., attend Mass regularly on Sunday and Holy Days of obligation and receive the Sacraments of the Church regularly

REQUESTS FOR ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATES

The role of a sponsor is primarily a Spiritual role to model a Christian life for the child. Therefore, anyone requesting a certificate **must** be a registered, **participating** member of St. Gianna Beretta Molla Parish, a **practicing** Catholic in good standing (not living in violation of the Church laws), at least 16 years of age and **have received the sacraments of initiation** (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist). Please call the Parish office for an appointment.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Couples planning to marry at St. Gianna are expected to contact the Priest to arrange a date and time **FIRST**. Second, they must attend the Pre-Cana conferences as mandated by the Most Reverend Bishop. The period of preparation for marriage is a minimum of **six** months to ensure completion of all arrangements before the wedding day. Please contact the Parish office for more information.

It is right to acknowledge the **Lord's Real Presence** with a brief act of worship on entering or leaving the Church and every time passing by the Sanctuary. Normally, a *genuflection* in the direction of the place of Reservation is enough. One who is physically unable to genuflect may substitute a *profound bow* at the waist.

Liturgical Year

The liturgical year is made up of six seasons:

Advent - four weeks of preparation before the celebration of Jesus' birth

Christmas - recalling the Nativity of Jesus Christ and his manifestation to the peoples of the world

Lent - a six-week period of penance before Easter

Sacred Paschal Triduum - the holiest "Three Days" of the Church's year, where the Christian people recall the suffering, death, and resurrection of Jesus

Easter - 50 days of joyful celebration of the Lord's resurrection from the dead and his sending forth of the Holy Spirit

Ordinary Time - divided into two sections (one span of 4-8 weeks after Christmas Time and another lasting about six months after Easter Time), wherein the faithful consider the fullness of Jesus' teachings and works among his people. The mystery of Christ, unfolded through the cycle of the year, calls us to live his mystery in our own lives. This call is best illustrated in the lives of Mary and the saints, celebrated by the Church throughout the year. There is no tension between the mystery of Christ and the celebration of the saints, but rather a marvelous harmony. The Blessed Virgin Mary is joined by an inseparable bond to the saving work of her Son, and the feasts of all the saints proclaim the wonderful works of Christ in his servants and offer the faithful fitting examples for their imitation. Each liturgical year begins on the First Sunday of Advent during the preceding calendar year (i.e., the First Sunday of Advent in 2022 began the 2023 liturgical year).



BINGO WEDNESDAYS & SATURDAYS

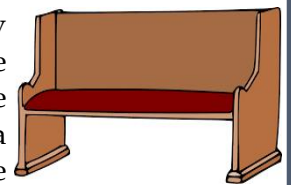

Este es un privilegio que pertenece a padres y madres, casi podríamos decir que es un deber. El uso de este hermoso privilegio es altamente recomendado puesto que es una concesión divina, un privilegio que va con la dignidad de la paternidad.

Si este "Sacramento del Hogar Doméstico" fuera administrado con mayor frecuencia, habría muchas más familias felices y contentas. Los dos factores indispensables para la felicidad en el hogar son la autoridad amable por parte de los padres y la obediencia amorosa por parte de los niños.
