From the Pastor's Desk

FORTY HOURS DEVOTION October 22, 23 & 24, 2023

The “Forty Hours” or Solemn Annual Exposition of the Most Blessed Sacrament is a devotion aimed at increasing our appreciation...our love...our knowledge of the Most Blessed Sacrament. The devotion itself covers a period of approximately 40 hours. *Why 40 hours?*

Perhaps because 40 is a very Biblical number. Think of the instances in Sacred Scripture where the number 40 is used. Remember the 40 years the Israelites sojourned in the desert, but at the conclusion of those 40 years they entered into joy and thanksgiving into the promised land. Remember the 40 days and 40 nights Noah and his family spent in the ark, but at the conclusion of those 40 days, they left the ark and the flood and found dry land. Remember the 40 days and nights Our Lord spent in prayer in the desert and at the conclusion of those 40 hours Jesus began His public ministry of teaching and salvation. Remember the 40 hours Our Lord spent in the tomb after His Passion and Death, but at the conclusion of the 40 hours Jesus rises from the tomb in glory conquering sin and death once and for all. Remember the 40 days after Easter Our Lord spent with His Apostles, but after those 40 days Jesus ascended to the Father to prepare a place for us in Heaven.

And, so, during the Forty Hours Devotion we should try to become one with the Scriptural events just mentioned and walk and be with Our Lord in prayer and meditation.

Notice that after every cycle of 40, something beautiful and meaningful happens. It is our prayer that as our Parish makes the Forty Hours, we, too, will experience something beautiful – that whatever intentions you bring to Our Eucharistic Lord will be answered, and that you, too, will experience the “good things of the Lord.”

FORTY HOURS DEVOTION *A Time of Opportunity*

Some member of every family...your family...should participate in the Forty Hours. Whatever sacrifices are involved, make them. You can be sure God will bless you for making them.

Remember – the heart of the Forty Hours Devotion is the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass.

Participate at Mass during Forty Hours. Receive the Holy Eucharist. Take advantage of every opportunity the Forty Hours offers you to become a better person...a better Christian...a better Catholic.

You will also have the opportunity to make a good Confession. Extra times will be added to our regular schedule so that you can be reconciled to God.

Make the Forty Hours a little mini-retreat for yourself!

Make up your mind to make the Forty Hours mean something to you.



FORTY HOURS DEVOTION October 22, 23 & 24, 2023



ADORATION

Throughout the three days of our Solemn Annual Exposition, you will have the opportunity to spend some quiet time with Jesus exposed on the Altar.

Here is Jesus for you – He, Who not only humbled Himself to come among us as a man, but in the Eucharist further humiliates Himself by coming to us under the frail appearance of a piece of bread! Here is truly a God who loves us!

What should you do during your hour of adoration? You may bring your Bible and read significant passages from sacred scripture, especially Chapter 6 of St. John's Gospel. There will be adoration booklets available in the Church for you to use to help you in your prayer. You may wish to say the Holy Rosary.

Perhaps you just might want to sit and just "be" in the presence of your Lord God and Brother Jesus. When you begin your hour of adoration, make it for a special intention—perhaps you want to offer your hour for a son or daughter who is having problems or who has been away from the Church; for peace; for good health; for a job, etc....

Whatever it may be, the Lord is there to listen to you!

The Anointing of the Sick and the Forty Hours

Sunday, October 22, 2023

On Sunday, October 22nd, we will open our Parish celebration of Forty Hours Devotion i.e., Solemn Exposition of the Most Blessed Sacrament. We, the Priests of St. Gianna Beretta Molla Parish, invite you to be *a part* of these three very special days. They are days filled with Spiritual growth for you and your loved ones.



We will begin with our celebration on Sunday, October 22nd at 4:00 PM with the Sacrament of the Sick. The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is, as the words of St. James make clear, for the sick! It is no longer considered Last Rites. This Sacrament is for anyone who is sick, i.e., chronic sickness and also for anyone over the age of 65. In the Sacrament of the Sick, the Church extends the healing Hand of Christ to the sick. It is an encounter with Christ the Healer, Christ the Divine Physician. The woman in the Gospel was eager to touch only the Lord's cloak. "If I touch even His garment," she thought, "I shall be made well." The sick person today "touches" Him and experiences His power through the Sacramental Anointing. This Sacrament is NOT for people who are dead. It is for anyone who is ill. Won't you join us and welcome Christ into your life in this unique way? What more beautiful way to begin our "Forty Hours" than by recognizing Jesus, the Bread of Life, reserved in the Most Blessed Sacrament for our adoration and for the sick. **The Anointing of the Sick will be administered during a special Mass on Sunday, October 22nd at 4:00 PM.**

Calling All Boys and Girls - 4th to 8th Grade & High School

Parents and Grandparents: encourage your children & grandchildren to become an Altar Server.

One of the most important things a young man and a young lady can do is to SERVE GOD at the ALTAR!! Why is this so?

1. Because you will be so close to our Lord as He comes down upon the Altar at Mass
2. Because you will *help* the Priest to say Mass reverently since he relies on you to help him
3. You hold the *Mass book*
4. You bring over the *cruets* of wine and water Father needs to offer Mass
5. You ring the *bells* so the people are alerted to the most important part of the Mass, the Consecration when the bread and wine become the Sacred Body and Blood of Christ
6. You carry the *cross* or *candles*
7. And so many other tasks you will be doing to make the Mass special and beautiful



To be an Altar server will allow you to feel a closeness to God and at the same time it will help you to become a responsible person, since you will have to be present at the Masses assigned for you to serve.

I will be training all the boys and girls who sign up to serve Mass so that they will know exactly what to do and be comfortable at the Altar.

Girls and boys **will be installed** as Altar servers at a special Mass during the celebration of the Parish 40 Hours Devotion, on **Monday, October 23rd at 7 p.m.**

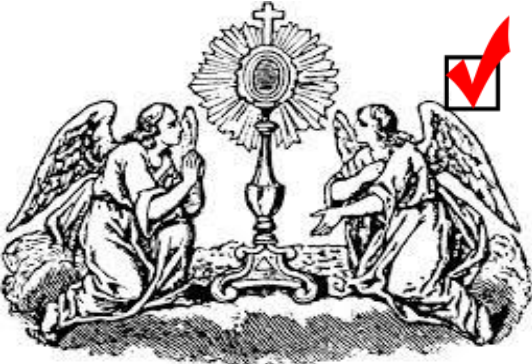

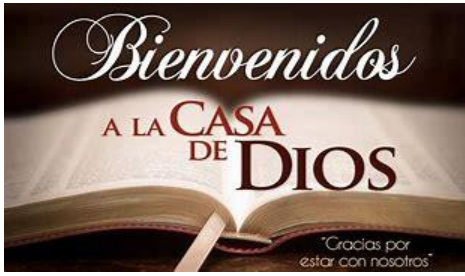

A READING FROM THE HOLY GOSPEL ACCORDING TO MATTHEW

Peter approached Jesus and asked him, "Lord, if my brother sins against me, how often must I forgive? As many as seven times?" Jesus answered, "I say to you, not seven times but seventy-seven times.
