

Pope John Paul II in his Encyclical letter "Ecclesia de Eucharistia" highly stressed the inestimable value of Adoration of Jesus in the Most Blessed Sacrament. He says,

"It is pleasant to spend time with Him, to lie close to His breast like the beloved disciple and to feel the infinite love present in His heart. If in our time, Christians must be distinguished above all by the 'art of prayer,' how can we not feel a renewed need to spend time in spiritual converse, in silent adoration, in heartfelt love before Christ in the Most Blessed Sacrament? Such adoration is a sign of gratitude, an expression of love and an acknowledgement of the Lord's presence."

Our commitment to our Lord present in the Blessed Sacrament during the 40 Hours Devotion can be further refined by paying attention to the three details of the Magi coming to adore Jesus, namely the route traveled by the Magi, the gifts they offered and the star they followed. The toil of their lengthy trip teaches us that in this hectic world of ours wherein we very often think we are too busy to pray, we need to summon up all our strength and come to adore our Lord during the 40 Hours Devotion. The fact that the Magi offered Jesus the best of their gifts – gold, frankincense and myrrh – helps us to realize that we should give Jesus the best we have during the upcoming 40 Hours Devotion. And, finally, the shining star which guided the Magi to their desired destination tells us we should bend our knees in adoration before the Most Blessed Sacrament, not by some duty or obligation, but by our love which prompts us to come to Him and adore!

ADORATION

Throughout the three days of our Solemn Annual Exposition, you will have the opportunity to spend some quiet time with Jesus exposed on the Altar.

Here is Jesus for you—He, Who not only humbled Himself to come among us as a man, but in the Eucharist, further humiliates Himself by coming to us under the frail appearance of a piece of bread! Here is truly a God who loves us!

What should you do during your hour of adoration? You may bring your Bible and read significant passages from sacred scripture, especially Chapter 6 of St. John's Gospel. There will be adoration booklets available in the Church for you to use to help you in your prayer. You may wish to say the Holy Rosary. Perhaps you just might want to sit and just "be" in the presence of your Lord God and Brother Jesus. When you begin your hour of adoration, make it for a special intention—perhaps you want to offer your hour for a son or daughter who is having problems or who has been away from the Church; for peace; for good health; for a job, etc....

Whatever it may be, the Lord is there to listen to you!

The Anointing of the Sick

and the Forty Hours

Sunday, October 22, 2023

On Sunday, October 22nd, we will open our Parish celebration of Forty Hours Devotion i.e., Solemn Exposition of the Most Blessed Sacrament. We, the Priests of St. Gianna Beretta Molla Parish, invite you to be *a part* of these three very special days. They are days filled with Spiritual growth for you and your loved ones.



We will begin with our celebration on Sunday, October 22nd at 4:00 PM with the Sacrament of the Sick. The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is, as the words of St. James make clear, for the sick! It is no longer considered Last Rites. This Sacrament is for anyone who is sick, i.e., chronic sickness and also for anyone over the age of 65. In the Sacrament of the Sick, the Church extends the healing Hand of Christ to the sick. It is an encounter with Christ the Healer, Christ the Divine Physician. The woman in the Gospel was eager to touch only the Lord's cloak. "If I touch even His garment," she thought, "I shall be made well." The sick person today "touches" Him and experiences His power through the Sacramental Anointing. This Sacrament is NOT for people who are dead. It is for anyone who is ill. Won't you join us and welcome Christ into your life in this unique way? What more beautiful way to begin our "Forty Hours" than by recognizing Jesus, the Bread of Life, reserved in the Most Blessed Sacrament for our adoration and for the sick. **The Anointing of the Sick will be administered during a special Mass on Sunday, October 22nd at 4:00 PM.**

Calling All Boys and Girls - 4th to 8th Grade & High School

Parents and Grandparents: encourage your children & grandchildren to become an Altar Server.

One of the most important things a young man and a young lady can do is to SERVE GOD at the ALTAR!! Why is this so?

1. Because you will be so close to our Lord as He comes down upon the Altar at Mass
2. Because you will *help* the Priest to say Mass reverently since he relies on you to help him
3. You hold the *Mass book*
4. You bring over the *cruets* of wine and water Father needs to offer Mass
5. You ring the *bells* so the people are alerted to the most important part of the Mass, the Consecration when the bread and wine become the Sacred Body and Blood of Christ
6. You carry the *cross* or *candles*
7. And so many other tasks you will be doing to make the Mass special and beautiful



To be an Altar server will allow you to feel a closeness to God and at the same time it will help you to become a responsible person, since you will have to be present at the Masses assigned for you to serve.

I will be training all the boys and girls who sign up to serve Mass so that they will know exactly what to do and be comfortable at the Altar.



Girls and boys **will be installed** as Altar servers at a special Mass during the celebration of the Parish 40 Hours Devotion, on **Monday, October 23rd at 7 p.m.**





A READING FROM THE HOLY GOSPEL ACCORDING TO MATTHEW

Jesus told his disciples this parable: "The kingdom of heaven is like a landowner who went out at dawn to hire laborers for his vineyard. After agreeing with them for the usual daily wage, he sent them into his vineyard. Going out about nine o'clock, the landowner saw others standing idle in the marketplace, and he said to them, 'You too go into my vineyard, and I will give you what is just.' So they went off. And he went out again around noon, and around three o'clock, and did likewise. Going out about five o'clock, the landowner found others standing around, and said to them, 'Why do you stand here idle all day?' They answered, 'Because no one has hired us.' He said to them, 'You too go into my vineyard.' When it was evening the owner of the vineyard said to his foreman, 'Summon the laborers and give them their pay, beginning with the last and ending with the first.' When those who had started about five o'clock came, each received the usual daily wage. So when the first came, they thought that they would receive more, but each of them also got the usual wage. And on receiving it they grumbled against the landowner, saying, 'These last ones worked only one hour, and you have made them equal to us, who bore the day's burden and the heat.' He said to one of them in reply, 'My friend, I am not cheating you. Did you not agree with me for the usual daily wage? Take what is yours and go. What if I wish to give this last one the same as you? Or am I not free to do as I wish with my own money? Are you envious because I am generous?' Thus, the last will be first, and the first will be last." The Gospel of the Lord. **Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ.**
