REASONS TO MAKE THE FORTY HOURS DEVOTION

From the Pastor's Desk

The first reason is that the Catholic faith teaches us that we grow and thrive and worship in a community. Our Faith, unlike the fundamental Christians sects, is not solely between me and God. Sometimes I hear Catholics say, "Well, I don't have to go to Mass on Sundays because I worship God in my own way. It's between me and God." The emphasis in fundamental Protestantism is that "Jesus is my personal savior and that is all I need to profess for my salvation." We, as Catholics, reject the concept that my faith is simply between me and God. The idea that faith is something private, hidden, something for me, my family or my friends, is wrong. From the very beginning of our roots in Judaism, the Jewish people always worshiped God as a *Community of Faith*. The Israelites came to the temple to worship and to offer sacrifice to Yahweh. They went to the local synagogue and sang the psalms together, read the Jewish Old Testament Scripture together and they prayed as a *community*. Later, with the coming of Christ as our Messiah, the early Christian liturgy just kept building on the Scripture services that were held in the synagogue and temple. Even today, we can see that the first part of our Mass—the Liturgy of the Word—mirrors what the Jews did in the synagogue—hymns, prayers, psalms and reading from Sacred Scripture. It is for this reason that we then worship our God in the midst of the community of St. Gianna Parish. So, *Why should I make the effort to make the Forty Hours Devotion?*

First of all, I should make the Forty Hours Devotion to come together as a family of faith, united by our common Baptism to pray the Mass and spend time with our Lord in the Most Blessed Sacrament. Gathered together as the Mystical Body of Christ, we'll gather around the very Body of Christ present in the Holy Eucharist. This Sunday (October 22) at 4:00 PM we'll gather with all the sick of the Parish in the opening Mass of the Forty Hours. We'll pray together, as a *Community of Faith*, for our dear sick and ask our Lord to be a healing balm; a healing presence for them as Christ, the Divine Physician, heals, comforts, and strengthens. We cannot do these things alone in our house, or in the woods, or on the shore or at the beach. We need to **come together** to be supported, affirmed, encouraged around our Lord in the Eucharist!

Secondly, I should make the Forty Hours so that I can thank our Lord for the many gifts He has given to us, especially the gift of His Real Presence in the Most Blessed Sacrament. *Where would we be without Christ?* Our church would just be an empty building. Our lives would be empty without Jesus in the Eucharist. *To whom could we go?* So, during our Forty Hours, we *come together* as family to say thank You, my Jesus, for Your gift to us and for humbling yourself becoming so lowly, so fragile, so small under the appearance of bread and wine. Remember the words of our Lord, *"Were not ten lepers cleansed and cured. Where are the other nine? Has only one person come back to say thank you?"*

Thirdly, I should make the Forty Hours because I recognize that I need our Lord to survive in this, sometimes, depressing world I live in. We will come to Mass on Monday and Tuesday nights at 7:00 PM to praise and adore our Lord and to beg Him to help us in our many needs. *Who is out of work? Who is sick with cancer? Who is mentally impaired? Who is suffering from depression? Who has lost a loved one recently? Who has broken up with someone they really loved? Who is experiencing problems in their marriage? Who is experiencing problems with their children? Who is having difficulties at work? Who know a person who has chemical or behavioral addiction? Who can't make ends meet? Who is suffering from grave temptations? Who is involved in an affair and can't seem to break it?* Come to the Forty Hours and spend time at the Masses with your brothers and sister at the Eucharist. **Jesus is here for you!**

Fourthly, I should come to the Forty Hours to spend time with Jesus— after I have worshipped with my *Parish Community of Faith* at Mass— to sit or kneel before our Creator and Redeemer, our Lord Himself. After we have been nourished with the Body and Blood of Christ in Holy Communion at Mass, we can extend the graces of Mass by being present with our Lord Solemnly Exposed on the altar during our Forty Hours adoration times.

Fifthly, I should make the Forty Hours Devotion because I've never done it before! I have consistently, year after year, ignored the invitation of Jesus to come and be with Him. I've made so many excuses I can't count them all, or even worse, I've been indifferent to the call. I really don't care!

Remember what our Lord said, "If you are indifferent to me or lukewarm, I will vomit you from My mouth." God forbid, I've been in that category. Here's my chance to make it up to our Lord. *Will I respond to His call this time?*



**The Anointing of the Sick This Sunday
October 22, 2023 at 4:00 PM**

This Sunday Saint Gianna Beretta Molla Parish will begin the celebration of Forty Hours Devotion. We, the priests of your Parish, invite you to be *a part* of these three very special days filled with spiritual growth for you, your loved ones, and our entire parish community.

We will start the Forty Hours Devotion with the Mass of the Anointing of the Sick this Sunday, October 22 at 4:00 PM (fulfilling the Sunday obligation) and will conclude with a Eucharistic procession and benediction at the end of the closing Mass on Tuesday, October 24, 2023 at 7:00 PM.

The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is, as the words of St. James make clear, for the sick. It is no longer considered *Last Rites*. This sacrament is for anyone who is sick and also for anyone over the age of 65.

In the Sacrament of the Sick, the Church extends the healing Hand of Christ to the sick person. It is an encounter with Christ the Healer, Christ the Divine Physician. Remember the woman in the Gospel. She was eager to touch the Lord's cloak. "If I touch even His garment," she thought, "I shall be made well."

The sick person today "touches" Him and experiences Christ's power through the sacramental anointing. This Sacrament is NOT for people who are dead. It is administered during periods of illness to bring the person receiving it spiritual and physical strengths.

Won't you join us and welcome Christ into your life in this unique way? What better way to begin our Forty Hours Devotion than by recognizing Jesus, the Bread of Life, reserved in the Most Blessed Sacrament for our adoration and for the sick.

Please mark your calendar and plan on being part of this special celebration.

40 HOURS DEVOTION

Preacher: Monsignor Paul L. Bochicchio

Monsignor Bochicchio is a priest of the Archdiocese of Newark. He has been ordained a priest 52 years. Monsignor was born in Greenwich Village in New York and grew up in Summit, New Jersey. Monsignor wrote in his book *Along the Way: A Priest's Journey of Joys and Challenges*, "Since I was in the 2nd grade, I wanted to be a priest; when I started serving Mass, the desire deepened." After Monsignor graduated 8th grade in 1959, he was accepted to Seton Hall Prep School and embarked on "The Divinity School" track. In the fall of 1963, Monsignor Paul began his college career at Seton Hall University. On May 29, 1971, Monsignor was ordained a priest at Sacred Heart Cathedral in Newark. Monsignor served as Parochial Vicar of Our Lady of Mercy in Jersey City from 1971-1983; Vocations Director of the Archdiocese of Newark; Campus Minister and Teacher at Roselle Catholic in Roselle from 1983-1985; Pastor of Holy Rosary in Jersey City from 1985-1992; Campus Minister at Seton Hall University in South Orange from 1992-1994; Pastor of Our Lady of Mount Virgin in Garfield from 1994-2004; Pastor of Holy Family in Nutley from 2004-2014; Parochial Vicar and High School Religion Teacher at Immaculate Conception in Montclair from 2014-2016. Monsignor Paul was also assigned to Our Lady of Grace in Hoboken from 2016-2017 and from 2017-Present serves at St. Francis in Hoboken. He is a Spiritual Director, has conducted many retreats and served in several administrative and formation positions in the Archdiocese of Newark. He was a chaplain for a group of people with disabilities and done extensive Youth Ministry work. Monsignor Paul writes, "There are four official Gospels, but as I often remark at funerals, every one of us is a 'living Gospel.' Each one of us has a *unique* story, a *unique* message to proclaim, and a *unique* way of touching one another. God has invested so much in each of us – we all bear *unique* fingerprints and *unique* DNA, so it appears that God went to a great deal of trouble to 'stamp' each one of us as a *unique* reflection of himself, a *unique* Gospel to be proclaimed."

May we never tire of proclaiming the dignity and worth of every human life. May we never tire of serving the vulnerable and their caregivers with generous hearts. And may we never cease to pray for the day when all societies will defend the life of every human from conception to natural death.

ORACIONES APROPIADAS

La Iglesia imparte Indulgencia plenaria a aquellos que rezan el Santo Rosario en presencia del santísimo Sacramento. Personas alrededor del mundo encuentran la Oración a la Divina Misericordia de mucho beneficio espiritual porque combina todos los valores del Evangelio. El Santísimo Sacramento es el trono de Misericordia, y rezar la Oración de la Divina Misericordia es un camino seguro para pedirle a Dios que cubra con su misericordioso amor a todos los hombres de la tierra.

LA CORONILLA DE LA DIVINA MISERICORDIA

Para rezar esta oración, que se reza utilizando el rosario, se necesitan de siete a diez minutos aproximadamente, y es muy sencilla de aprender. Jesús dijo a Sor Faustina, "Rezarás este rosario de la siguiente forma":

*Primero, dirás un PADRENUESTRO, un AVE MARÍA y un CREDO.

*Después, en las cuentas del rosario correspondientes al PADRENUESTRO, dirás las siguientes palabras: *Padre Eterno, te ofrezco el Cuerpo, Sangre, Alma y Divinidad de tu amadísimo Hijo, Nuestro Señor Jesucristo, como propiciación de nuestros pecados y de los del mundo entero.*

*En las cuentas del AVE MARÍA, dirás las siguientes palabras:

Por su dolorosa Pasión, ten misericordia de nosotros y del mundo entero. Seguido por el GLORIA

*Para terminar, se debe de decir tres veces estas palabras: *Santo Dios, Santo Fuerte, Santo Inmortal, ten piedad de nosotros y del mundo entero.*

OTRAS ORACIONES QUE TAMBIEN PUEDEN SER REZADAS CON EL ROSARIO

1. *Corazón Eucarístico de Jesús, te adoramos y glorificamos en unión con los nueve coros celestiales*
2. *Corazón Eucarístico de Jesús, lleno de amor por nosotros, llena nuestros corazones con amor para ti*
3. *Corazón Eucarístico de Jesús, Ven a Nosotros Tu Reino!*
