From the Pastor's Desk

FEAST OF ST. BLAISE FEBRUARY 3, 2024

"Through the intercession of St. Blaise, Bishop and Martyr, may God deliver you from ailments of the throat and from every other evil. In the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." Amen.

These are the words of a special Blessing imparted in our Churches on the Feast of St. Blaise. Legend tells us that an anxious mother scurried to St. Blaise with her little boy. A fish bone had lodged in his throat. The Saint called for two candles, lit them and placed them in the form of a Cross under the boy's chin, recited some prayers and gave his blessing. Almost immediately, the fish bone loosened and was easily removed.

Many such cures obtained through prayer to this Saint gave foundation to the hope that the Blessing of St. Blaise will prevent troubles of the throat. From such physical troubles we all want and need protection –from hoarseness, choking, colds and cancer.

There are also spiritual diseases of the throat, much more harmful than the physical. "Evils of the throat and every other evil" from which St. Blaise's Blessing begs protection, include particularly these Spiritual troubles, which are beyond the cure of the greatest throat specialists. These include: the hoarseness of unkind speech, choking curses, gagging lies, sexual mouth canker, etc.

The Apostle Paul had on his mind such diseases in one of his letters. Quoting Psalm 5, Verse 10, he wrote to the Romans, "Their throat is an open sepulcher. With their tongues they have dealt deceitfully. The venom of asps is under their lips. Their mouth is full of cursing and bitterness." (Romans 3:13). Such spiritual diseases for the throat indeed are the most harmful and these we want cured through the intercession of St. Blaise.

Keep these thoughts in mind when the Priest touches with the crossed candles your throat and asks God, through the intercession of St. Blaise, to deliver you from every evil, especially from physical and spiritual evils of the throat.

From the
Pastor's Desk

The purpose of our Parish Mission, or for that matter, any Parish Mission is a part of the Church's Apostolate designed to bring about conversion of hearts and the renewal of the spiritual energies of the parish. As such, the parish mission has its roots in the mission of the prophets and acquires its mandate from the Divine commission given to the Apostles and to their successors. The parish mission in its present form is a product of the 17th Century. In substance, however, missions for the faithful have long been a feature of the General Apostolate of the Church. Popular preaching received great impetus with the founding of the mendicant orders in the 13th Century. Both Franciscans and Dominicans dedicated themselves as popular missionaries whose primary tasks were to implant the Faith in the people, refute error and renew Christian fervor in the faithful. Then came the Catholic Counter Reformation with a needed emphasis on catechetical instruction. Preachers were urged to concentrate on the fundamental doctrines of the Church for it was realized that many had fallen away from the faith through ignorance of their religion.

Once again today, there is a tremendous need for us to be rooted in our Catholic faith. We are living in an age where our society has almost become pagan with an ignorance of the faith and a shallow level of Christian morality. The symptoms of the disease or spiritual virus that has plagued us are very obvious – the temptations are all around us and just like a deadly virus it is eating away at our Church and society. Abortion, contraception, immortality, pornography, lack of faith, poor attendance at Mass, disrespect for the teachings of Christ and His Church, irreverence for Our Lord in the Most Blessed Sacrament, sacrileges and general diminution of the faith – all are symptoms of the virus that has infected all of us to a lesser or greater degree. And so, once again there is a great need for solid Catholic parish missions to call us all to a greater conversion – to call us to renew and regenerate our spiritual lives! The answer for all of us is our parish mission – it's just "what the doctor ordered."

We will be blessed to have once again a priest who is a member of the Fathers of Mercy. The Fathers of Mercy, in fact, were founded in Lyons, France in 1808 by a very zealous and holy Priest, Father Jean Baptiste Rauzan. Fr. Rauzan brought together a small group of priests to form a missionary band with the idea of counteracting the disastrous effects of the French Revolution on the faith of the people. The society came to the United States in 1939 and it continues the mission work of Fr. Rauzan. Just as it counteracted the effects of the French Revolution on the faith of the people then so today once again the Fathers of Mercy are helping to counteract the ill effects of modernism on the Faith of the people. They continue to preach the truth of the Gospel and will help us all to get to Heaven and save our souls – the whole purpose of our life here on earth. Next Saturday and Sunday, Fr. Anthony Stephens will speak at all our Masses to inspire us to make the parish mission! Let us welcome him with our customary hospitality!

Fr. Anthony Stephens, C.P.M.

Biographical information

Fr. Tony was born in 1976 and is a native of Angelus, Kansas. He graduated from a public high school in 1995, and afterwards he attended Christendom College in Front Royal Virginia. Discerning a call to religious life and the priesthood, he joined the Fathers of Mercy in 2000. In 2001, Fr. Tony professed the three vows of poverty, chastity, and obedience, and then he studied for the priesthood at the Pontifical College Josephinum in Columbus, Ohio. He was ordained a priest in 2005, and he served for two years as the assistant pastor of St. Luke’s Catholic Church in Nicholasville, KY. In 2007, Fr. Tony was assigned to begin traveling and preaching parish retreats, also known as “parish missions”. His travels have taken him all over the United States, into Canada, and also to different parts of the Australian Continent. From 2009-2015, he served as the Vocations Director and Student Master for the community. During this time, he also helped out part time in the preaching apostolate of the Congregation. Beginning in August of 2015, he joined the formation faculty at the Mt. St. Mary’s of the West in Cincinnati, OH, where he worked as the Vice Rector and Director of Formation until the Spring of 2021. After completing a six year term at the seminary, he rejoined the Fathers of Mercy mission band as a traveling mission preacher in the fall of 2021.

The Congregation of the Fathers of Mercy was founded in 1808, originally under the title of “the Missionaries of France.” The community was founded for the purpose of re-evangelizing the French people after the Catholic Faith had been subjected to years of attacks and persecution during the French Revolution. It is now an exclusively American community, headquartered in South Union, Kentucky. The primary apostolate of the Fathers of Mercy is to conduct parish missions and retreats in effort to re-evangelize and revitalize the faith of those who seek God’s Truth and Mercy.

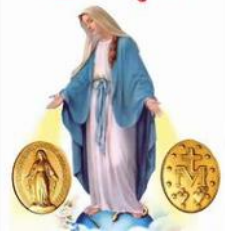
Millions of Monicas

El Santo tomó dos velas, las encendió y las colocó en forma de Cruz bajo la barbilla del niño, recitó algunas oraciones y le dió su bendición. Casi inmediatamente, el hueso de pescado se aflojó y se le quitó de la garganta fácilmente. Muchas de estas curas obtenidas a través de la oración a este Santo dieron fundamento a la esperanza de que la bendición de Santo Blaise prevenga los problemas de la garganta. A partir de estos problemas físicos todos queremos y necesitamos su protección: la ronquera, la asfixia, los resfriados y el cáncer.

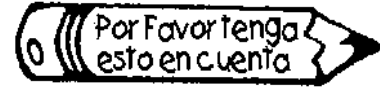

Con sus lenguas se han ocupado engañosamente. El veneno de las aspas está bajo sus labios. Su boca está llena de maldición y amargura" Romanos 3:13. Tengan estos pensamientos presentes cuando el próximo fin de semana el sacerdote les de la Bendición de Santo Blaise para protegerlos de las enfermedades físicas y espirituales de la garganta.
