To the Jewish people who lined the streets to welcome Jesus into Jerusalem, this was a day of indescribable happiness. What a day for rejoicing! Here, coming into their city and into their lives was the Messiah, the King of Glory, who was, at last, going to bring their enslavement, their migrations, their persecutions to an end. Once and for all, the power and prestige of the Jewish nation was to be restored. No wonder their happiness knew no bounds as they strewed palm branches along a bumpy road to make His journey – His entrance into their lives – smoother and memorable.

The palms we bless at our Mass next Sunday are carried in a procession, a parade of our own, then taken with us into our homes where they will remind us today, next week, and throughout the year of the victory of Jesus over sin and death. Let us look on our palm as an expression of our appreciation, of our gratitude and affection for Jesus, our Savior, who came to give His life so that we might have life everlasting.

I thank each of you from the bottom of my heart for all that you have done and continue to do for our Parish and the many Ministries in the Diocese of Camden.

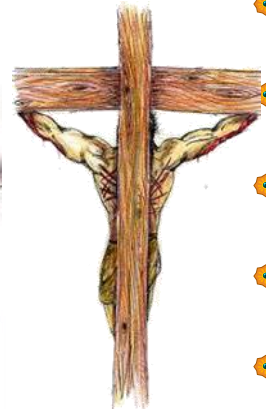
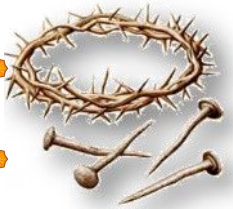

Lenten Prayer

Dear Lord, as I make my Lenten journey with You, send me Your Spirit, help me to give of myself, help me to turn away from sin, and help me to fast and pray, so that I may know You and serve You better. Let me be renewed through my journey to share Your grace with the world. Amen.



Good Friday is an **obligatory day of fast and abstinence**. Fasting is obligatory for all who have completed their 18th year and have not yet reached their 60th year. Fasting allows a person to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may be taken, not to equal one full meal.



Easter Duty Obligation:

After they have received their First Holy Communion, Catholics are bound by the obligation of receiving Holy Communion at least once a year. This precept should be fulfilled during the Easter Season. Catholics are also bound to confess serious (mortal) sins at least once a year, but this is not limited to the Lenten/Easter Season.

The time for fulfilling the Paschal Precept (Easter Duty) extends from the First Sunday of Lent, February 14, 2024 to the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, May 26, 2024.

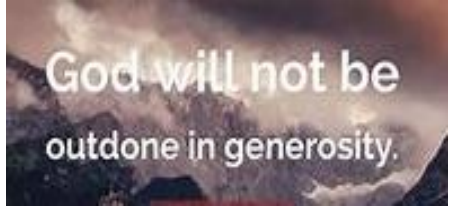
Sodality of St. Gianna

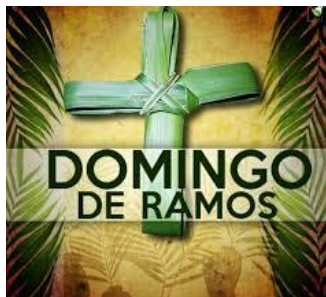


**If You CANNOT Be on Time, Then Be EARLY.

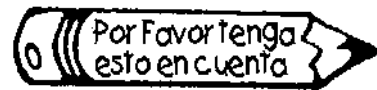
