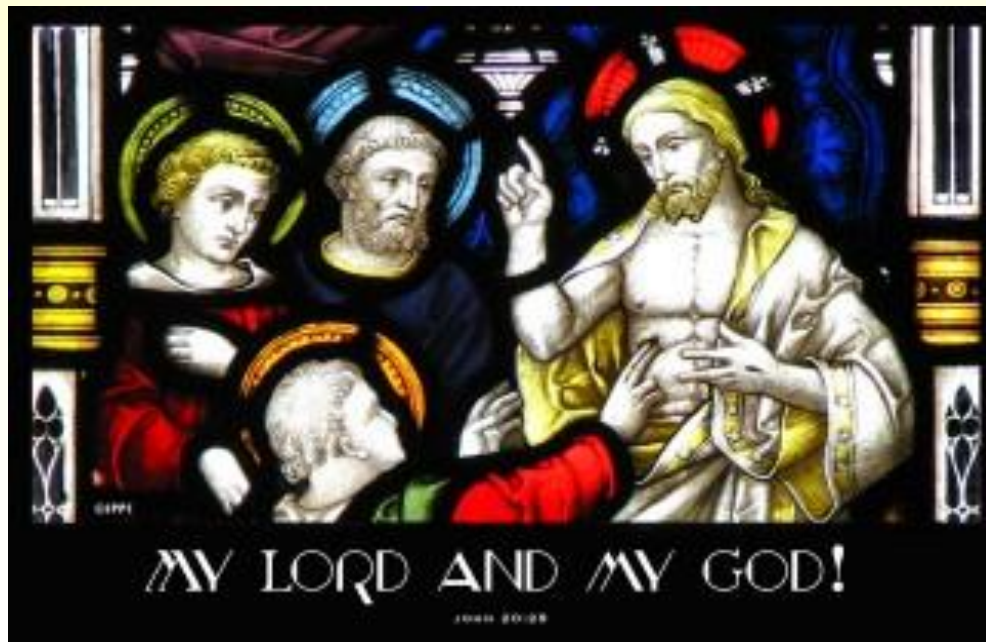

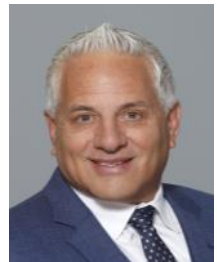

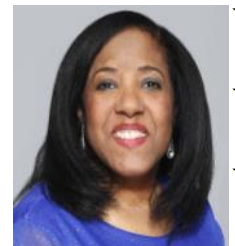

Spot light on...

Easter Duty Obligation: After they have received their First Holy Communion, Catholics are bound by the Obligation of receiving Holy Communion at least once a year. This Precept should be fulfilled during the Easter Season. Catholics are also bound to confess serious (mortal) sins at least once a year, but this is not limited to the Lenten/Easter Season.

The time for fulfilling the Paschal Precept (Easter Duty*) extends from the First Sunday of Lent, February 14, 2024 to the Solemnity of the Holy Trinity, May 26, 2024.

DID YOU KNOW THAT ...

The month of April is dedicated both to devotion to the Eucharist and devotion to the Holy Spirit. This tradition has developed because Easter Sunday often falls in April, and when it does fall in March, the Easter Season continues on through all of April. In essence, April is a month of Easter, and during the Easter celebration we remember the Eucharistic Sacrifice Christ gave us and the baptism in the Holy Spirit, which would come after Jesus’s Resurrection.

South Jersey Catholic Cemeteries Garden Permit Program Spring is Just Around the Corner

Spring is almost here, and we are delighted to share great news about our Garden Permit Program! Our annual fee will not increase. Although inflation has affected most areas of our everyday living, we are happy to tell you that the permit fee will not increase this year and has not increased since the program was introduced in 2018! If you chose the Garden Permit Prime Program, the annual fee remains at \$50 and includes an upgraded landscape edging. The standard Garden Permit Program includes a black standard plastic landscape edging for a fee of \$35. This program, available for most raised headstones, offers you the ability to grow a garden in front of your loved one's memorial, giving it a more personal touch. Plus, the year-long program gives you a cemetery-compliant border and flexibility to individualize your love one's grave. To submit an application for either of these options, please contact your cemetery by March 15th. A READING FROM THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO JOHN

DIVINA MISERICORDIA

El Domingo después del Domingo de Pascua

El mundo estaba en medio de la Gran Depresión en 1931 y los recuerdos de la Primera Guerra Mundial todavía estaban muy vivos en las mentes de los europeos cuando en Polonia una hermana de la Congregación de las Hermanas de Nuestra Señora de la Misericordia, Faustina Kowalska (1905- 1938), se dice que fue visitada personalmente por Jesús. Según su diario, que estuvo inscrito en el Índice de Libros Prohibidos durante más de 20 años, se le reveló una imagen del Señor Resucitado, de cuyo corazón brillaban dos rayos, uno rojo (que representa la sangre) y otro “pálido”. (que simboliza el agua), con las palabras “Jesús, en ti confío” en la parte inferior.

Faustina escribió en su diario que Jesús le dijo: *“Prometo que el alma que venere esta imagen no perecerá”*. Cuando fue canonizada en 2000 bajo la dirección de su compatriota el Papa Juan Pablo II, él proclamó que el Segundo Domingo de Pascua se conocería en adelante como Domingo de la Divina Misericordia, promoviendo así ampliamente las prácticas devocionales asociadas con las visiones de Faustina, ya populares en muchas comunidades. Santa Faustina, una hija con poca educación de una humilde familia polaca, llevó un diario de 600 páginas de las apariciones que, según ella, continuaron durante años. Sus escritos se centran en la misericordia de Dios, el llamado a aceptar la misericordia de Dios y a ser misericordiosos, la necesidad de conversión y el llamado a confiar en Jesús. Había sido el propio deseo de Jesús, escribió, establecer un día de fiesta: *“Yo [Jesús] deseo que la Fiesta de la Misericordia sea refugio y amparo para todas las almas. . . . Les estoy dando la última esperanza de salvación; es decir, la Fiesta de Mi Misericordia”*.



Entre las prácticas asociadas con la devoción se encuentran su novena, la Coronilla de la Divina Misericordia (una serie de oraciones organizadas de manera similar a un rosario), la Hora de la Gran Misericordia (un tiempo de oración que tradicionalmente se celebra a las 3 p. m.) y la Indulgencia Plenaria, concedido a quienes se confiesan y reciben la Eucaristía diez días antes o diez días después del Domingo de la Divina Misericordia. LECTURA DEL SANTO EVANGELIO SEGUN SAN JUAN

MUY IMPORTANTE INFORMACION PARA LOS PADRINOS

El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica explica que el papel del padrino o de la madrina es ayudar a que la gracia bautismal pueda desarrollarse en el bautizado, actuando como colaboradores de sus padres o de quienes ocupan su lugar. Por eso los padrinos deben ser “creyentes sólidos, capaces y prestos a ayudar al nuevo bautizado, niño o adulto, en su camino de la vida cristiana” (CIC 1255). Este es un papel muy importante, ya que todos los miembros de la Iglesia de alguna manera tienen la responsabilidad de desarrollar y guardar la gracia recibida en el bautismo y ayudar a otros a hacer lo mismo.

¿Por qué la Iglesia pone tantas restricciones para poder ser padrino de bautizo?

Es entonces deber del padrino asistir a los padres en la iniciación cristiana del que será bautizado y “procurar que después lleve una vida cristiana congruente con el bautismo y cumpla fielmente las obligaciones inherentes al mismo”. Cabe resaltar que es posible tener un solo padrino o madrina. No es necesario tener dos, pero sí es posible, mientras sea un hombre y una mujer.

La Iglesia ha impuesto requisitos para que los padres puedan elegir a las personas correctas para esta misión tan importante. El padrino o la madrina:

1. Deberá haber sido elegido por quien va a bautizarse o por sus padres, o por quienes ocupan su lugar; o, si faltan estos, por el párroco o ministro.
2. Deberá tener la capacidad para esta misión e intención de desempeñarla.
3. Deberá tener al menos 16 años. (El obispo puede establecer otra edad en su diócesis o el mismo párroco o ministro -por justa causa- puede considerar una excepción.)
4. Deberá ser católico, estar confirmado, haber recibido la Primera Comunión, y llevar una vida congruente con la fe y con la misión que va a asumir.
5. No puede estar afectado por una pena canónica declarada o impuesta legítimamente.
6. No puede ser el padre o la madre de quien se ha de bautizar.
7. De no estar registrado en Sta. Gianna, los candidatos a ser padrinos deberán presentar una carta de la parroquia donde practican su fe (letter of sponsorship).
