Celebrating Pentecost Sunday

Today, Pentecost Sunday, we recall our Confirmation Day and are reminded of the great gifts the Holy Spirit has given to us. It's easy for us to forget these gifts that are so necessary in the spiritual life because they flower into the fruits of the Holy Spirit. The effects of the seven gifts are seen in the 12 fruits of the Holy Spirit. To refresh oneself, the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit you received are:

1. **Wisdom** – to help us make wise decisions about important matters.
2. **Understanding** – for us to know and understand the real purpose and meaning of life.
3. **Counsel** – to advise and help others make morally right decisions.
4. **Courage** – for us to be strong and uphold and do what is right and to condemn and avoid what is wrong.
5. **Knowledge** – to know the truths of our Faith.
6. **Piety** – to give true worship and adoration to God alone and to honor our Blessed Virgin Mother and the Saints.
7. **Fear of the Lord** – to fear ever offending God by mortal sin and to take our Holy Religion seriously.



If we incorporate these seven gifts into our lives, if we unwrap these Pentecostal gifts, we then go even deeper into our spiritual lives because they produce 12 fruits of the Holy Spirit. In other words, the seven gifts are fertilized by our prayers, meditations and Sacraments – especially Penance and Holy Communion – and should produce beautiful fruits – 12 of them to be exact.

These fruits are the virtues produced in our lives when we exercise the gifts of the Holy Spirit. Meditate on these 12 fruits and see if you have them, and if you don't – why not? **Charity, Generosity, Joy, Gentleness, Peace, Faithfulness, Patience, Modesty, Kindness, Self-Control, Goodness, Chastity.**



HELP for THOSE IN NEED



REQUESTS FOR ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATES

The role of a sponsor is primarily a Spiritual role to model a Christian life for the child. Therefore, anyone requesting a certificate **must** be a registered, **participating** member of St. Gianna Beretta Molla Parish, a **practicing** Catholic in good standing (not living in violation of the Church laws), at least 16 years of age and **have received the sacraments of initiation** (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist). Please call the Parish office to make an appointment.

Sacrament of Marriage

Couples planning to marry at St. Gianna are expected to contact the Priest to arrange a date and time **FIRST**. Second, they must attend the Pre-Cana conferences as mandated by the Most Reverend Bishop. The period of preparation for marriage is a minimum of **six** months to ensure completion of all arrangements before the wedding day. Please contact the Parish office for more information. Be aware of the following qualifications before you ask someone to be the Godparent of your child. According to Canon Law the Godparent...

- ◆ Must be at least 16 years of age
- ◆ If the sponsor is married must be married in accord with the laws of the Catholic Church
- ◆ Must have received all the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Communion).
- ◆ Be a practicing Catholic; i.e., attend Mass regularly on Sunday and Holy Days of obligation and receive the Sacraments of the Church regularly

SEGUNDA LECTURA DE LA CARTA DEL APOSTOL SAN PABLO A LOS GALATAS

Este desorden está en contra del Espíritu de Dios, y el Espíritu está en contra de ese desorden. Y esta oposición es tan radical, que les impide a ustedes hacer lo que querrían hacer. Son manifiestas las obras que proceden del desorden egoísta del hombre: la lujuria, la impureza, el libertinaje, la idolatría, la brujería, las enemistades, los pleitos, las rivalidades, la ira, las rencillas, las divisiones, las discordias, las envidias, las borracheras, las orgías y otras cosas semejantes. Respecto a ellas les advierto, como ya lo hice antes, que quienes hacen estas cosas no conseguirán el Reino de Dios. MUY IMPORTANTE INFORMACION PARA LOS PADRINOS

El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica explica que el papel del padrino o de la madrina es ayudar a que la gracia bautismal pueda desarrollarse en el bautizado, actuando como colaboradores de sus padres o de quienes ocupan su lugar. Por eso los padrinos deben ser "creyentes sólidos, capaces y prestos a ayudar al nuevo bautizado, niño o adulto, en su camino de la vida cristiana" (CIC 1255). Este es un papel muy importante, ya que todos los miembros de la Iglesia de alguna manera tienen la responsabilidad de desarrollar y guardar la gracia recibida en el bautismo y ayudar a otros a hacer lo mismo.

¿Por qué la Iglesia pone tantas restricciones para poder ser padrino de bautizo?

Es entonces deber del padrino asistir a los padres en la iniciación cristiana del que será bautizado y "procurar que después lleve una vida cristiana congruente con el bautismo y cumpla fielmente las obligaciones inherentes al mismo". Cabe resaltar que es posible tener un solo padrino o madrina. No es necesario tener dos, pero sí es posible, mientras sea un hombre y una mujer.

La Iglesia ha impuesto requisitos para que los padres puedan elegir a las personas correctas para esta misión tan importante. El padrino o la madrina:

1. Deberá haber sido elegido por quien va a bautizarse o por sus padres, o por quienes ocupan su lugar; o, si faltan estos, por el párroco o ministro.
2. Deberá tener la capacidad para esta misión e intención de desempeñarla.
3. Deberá tener al menos 16 años. (El obispo puede establecer otra edad en su diócesis o el mismo párroco o ministro -por justa causa- puede considerar una excepción.)
4. Deberá ser católico, estar confirmado, haber recibido la Primera Comunión, y llevar una vida congruente con la fe y con la misión que va a asumir.
5. No puede estar afectado por una pena canónica declarada o impuesta legítimamente.
6. No puede ser el padre o la madre de quien se ha de bautizar.
7. De no estar registrado en Sta. Gianna, los candidatos a ser padrinos deberán presentar una carta de la parroquia donde practican su fe (letter of sponsorship).
