MASS 4:30PM

Next weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ. This is an extraordinary Feast because unlike Holy Thursday, the day our Lord instituted the Holy Eucharist, with its somberness looking toward our Lord's crucifixion, the Feast of Corpus Christi is celebrated with the fullest possible pomp as we rejoice and give thanks to Our Blessed Savior for the gift of Himself in the Most Blessed Sacrament.

This glorious Feast – which we will publicly celebrate as it was destined to be celebrated by a Solemn Outdoor Procession – will be a day in which we, as a Parish, will make Acts of Reparation for all the sacrileges and indifference to our Eucharistic Lord that are committed every day against Him. We will make reparation for the times we have received Him unworthily in Holy Communion. We will make reparation for the times we have not been properly prepared to receive Him in Holy Communion. We will make reparation for the times we have found the Sacred Host on the floor of our Church, on the parking lot, and in the streets. We will make reparation for the times “Black Masses” have desecrated the Eucharistic Species! We will gather in procession to console our Divine Lord's Eucharistic Heart by our love and sacrifices. We offer to Him reparation especially by the sacrifice of being present for Mass next Saturday at 4:30 PM and the outdoor Eucharistic Procession immediately following.



Can I appeal to your hearts? Can I appeal to your love for Jesus? Can I appeal to your Souls to make the time to repair the lack of love people have shown our Lord in the Most Blessed Sacrament? Won't you put back some of the love that has been taken out of our world by people's apathy, indifference – yes – and even hatred for Our Eucharistic Lord?

REQUESTS FOR ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATES

The role of a sponsor is primarily a Spiritual role to model a Christian life for the child. Therefore, anyone requesting a certificate **must** be a registered, **participating** member of St. Gianna Beretta Molla Parish, a **practicing** Catholic in good standing (not living in violation of the Church laws), at least 16 years of age and **have received the sacraments of initiation** (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist). Please call the Parish office to make an appointment.

Sacrament of Marriage

Couples planning to marry at St. Gianna are expected to contact the Priest to arrange a date and time **FIRST**. Second, they must attend the Pre-Cana conferences as mandated by the Most Reverend Bishop. From the Pastor's Desk

Novena to Saint Anthony

Saint to the Whole World

What is a Saint? To speak in a dictionary manner, a Saint with a capital "S" is one of those persons recognized by the Church as having by holiness of life and heroic virtue attained a high place in heaven and as being, therefore, entitled to the veneration of the faithful, fit to serve them as a spiritual model and able to intercede for them in the Courts of Heaven. The men and women thus recognized as Saints do not, of course, include all the holy or exhaust all the possibilities of holiness. But, of them we are certain!

The Saint's place in heaven is fixed in the mind of God. His place between heaven and earth at God's Altar, in the liturgy – is also fixed on the mind of the Church. But, his place in the world is in the mind and hearts of men, always shifting ground. A saint can go out of fashion in one century – come in again in another, as the world's understanding of his life wanes or waxes. His "popularity" depends on the seemingly "timeliness" of his personal mode of holiness or his particular spiritual message. All but for St. Anthony of Padua! His popularity has never waned in the minds and hearts of Catholics throughout the world! For over 800 years, Catholics and even non-Catholics have turned to St. Anthony for help. *Why is this so?* Why is St. Anthony of Padua always so popular – always so admired – always so prayed to? It seems to me it is because his message is universal and timeless: love God above all things, practice charity to the poor, live the Gospel message and love our Blessed Mother and the Holy Eucharist!! It seems to me he has always been such a popular saint because his prayers are very, very powerful to Jesus! After all, he is one of only two saints that holds the Infant Jesus in his arms. So much did God love him, He gave him that great grace, a great privilege to hold the Christ Child in his arms. WOW! He is so popular because you can ask myriad peoples and they will all tell you, "St. Anthony heard my Prayer and helped me in a desperate time."

Our parish will start the Novena to St. Anthony on **Wednesday, June 5 at 7:00 PM**. Please consider making this powerful Novena if *you looking for a job; if you sick or someone you know is ill with a terminal illness; if you're experiencing spiritual, emotional or mental problems; if you're depressed and do not know where to turn for help; if your children or spouse are away from the Church or have distanced themselves from the Sacraments; if you're experiencing financial difficulties or you're worried about a difficult situation.*

Mark your calendar and join us! The novena to St. Anthony will guide you to find a powerful and true friend who will listen to you and will be ready help you.

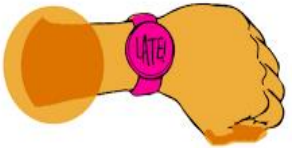
THE LORD'S REAL PRESENCE

We are fortunate enough to worship in a Church in which the **Body of Christ** is **reserved**. It is right to acknowledge the **Lord's Real Presence** with a brief act of worship on *entering or leaving* the Church and *every time* passing by the Sanctuary. Normally, a *genuflection* in the direction of the place of Reservation is enough. One who is physically unable to genuflect may substitute a *profound bow* at the waist.

Please make every effort to arrive on time for the start of Holy Mass, which **begins** with the **Sign of the Cross** and **ends** with the dismissal, "**Go in Peace.**" It is the Lord we **insult** when we do not give Him our time. He is never too busy to be with us!

BAPTISMS

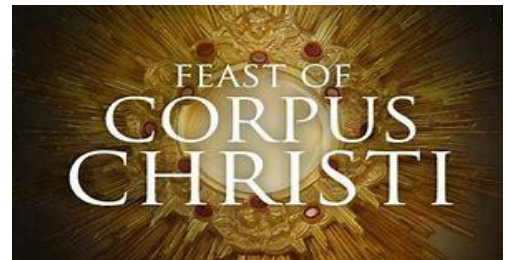

PARENTS, PLEASE NOTE:

Be aware of the following qualifications before you ask someone to be the Godparent of your child. According to Canon Law the Godparent...

- ◆ Must be at least 16 years of age
- ◆ If the sponsor is married must be married in accord with the laws of the Catholic Church
- ◆ Must have received all the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Communion).
- ◆ Be a practicing Catholic; i.e., attend Mass regularly on Sunday and Holy Days of obligation and receive the Sacraments of the Church regularly

IMPORTANTE INFORMACION PARA LAS PERSONAS QUE SON ELEGIDAS PARA SER PADRINOS DE BAUTISMO O CONFIMACION

El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica explica que el papel del padrino o de la madrina es ayudar a que la gracia bautismal pueda desarrollarse en el bautizado, actuando como colaboradores de sus padres o de quienes ocupan su lugar. Por eso los padrinos deben ser “creyentes sólidos, capaces y prestos a ayudar al nuevo bautizado, niño o adulto, en su camino de la vida cristiana” (CIC 1255). Este es un papel muy importante, ya que todos los miembros de la Iglesia de alguna manera tienen la responsabilidad de desarrollar y guardar la gracia recibida en el bautismo y ayudar a otros a hacer lo mismo.

¿Por qué la Iglesia pone tantas restricciones para poder ser padrino de bautizo?

Es entonces deber del padrino asistir a los padres en la iniciación cristiana del que será bautizado y “procurar que después lleve una vida cristiana congruente con el bautismo y cumpla fielmente las obligaciones inherentes al mismo”. Cabe resaltar que es posible tener un solo padrino o madrina. No es necesario tener dos, pero sí es posible, mientras sea un hombre y una mujer.

La Iglesia ha impuesto *requisitos* para que los padres puedan elegir a las personas correctas para esta misión tan importante. El padrino o la madrina:

1. Deberá haber sido elegido por quien va a bautizarse o por sus padres, o por quienes ocupan su lugar; o, si faltan estos, por el párroco o ministro.
2. Deberá tener la capacidad para esta misión e intención de desempeñarla.
3. Deberá tener al menos 16 años. (El obispo puede establecer otra edad en su diócesis o el mismo párroco o ministro -por justa causa- puede considerar una excepción.)
4. Deberá ser católico, estar confirmado, haber recibido la Primera Comunión, y llevar una vida congruente con la fe y con la misión que va a asumir.
5. No puede estar afectado por una pena canónica declarada o impuesta legítimamente.
6. No puede ser el padre o la madre de quien se ha de bautizar.
7. De no estar registrado en Sta. Gianna, los candidatos a ser padrinos deberán presentar una carta de la parroquia donde practican su fe (letter of sponsorship).
