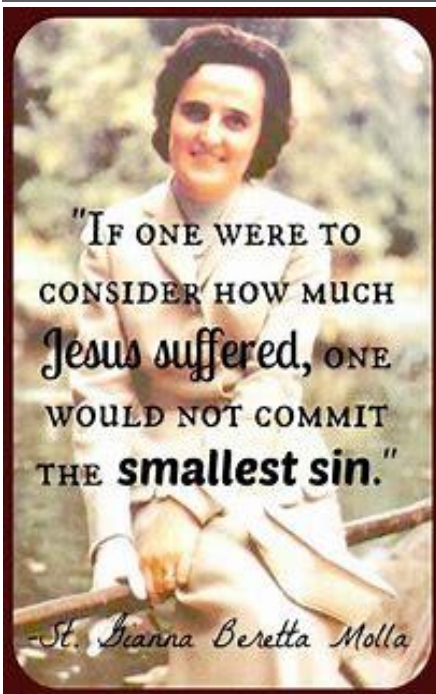

FROM THE PASTOR

Jesus Is Calling You!

Yes, that's exactly what I said. He is calling you to be His disciple to reach out and ask just one person whom you know who is not Catholic and to invite him/her to become Catholic. The last words Our Divine Lord spoke on this earth underline their importance:

"Go out and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit."

In other words, He spoke those words to you as an obligation to help bring souls to Him. Could you imagine the reward you will reap if you are responsible for another person getting to heaven? There are so many people in your workplace, neighbors and even relatives who are living in the dark about Christ. They will never know how it feels on this earth to receive the Body and Blood of Christ—a foretaste of heaven. They will never know the peace of having Jesus forgive their sins in the confessional. They will walk this earth trapped with tremendous guilt overwhelming their souls, minds and hearts.

Fr. Benedict Groeschel says that the problem today is not that people don't believe in God. The problem is that their faith is very shallow and small and little. You and I need to be apostles to everyone and ask them—invite them—to our faith by joining the RCIA Program where we will help them augment their faith. You see, we as Catholics possess the entire pie—so to speak—not just a slice. We have the whole truth. Vatican II in its document "Lumen Gentium" said **"The Church of Jesus Christ subsists in the Catholic Church."**

In other words, it's the Church Christ founded and He expects us all to do our share in bringing souls to Him, to the Catholic Church. I am convinced that the reason we have had so many converts (hundreds) to the Catholic Church is because you have taken this message seriously. Invite your friends and neighbors, remembering when the soon-to-be apostle inquired from Peter, what was Jesus like? He said to him, "Come and See." That's what RCIA is about. I would never force anyone to become a Catholic, for it is a gift from God. But, at least all who come can find out about what we are all about. RCIA classes begin on the last week of October. They will take place every Thursday night from October until Easter of next year (2025) when the candidates will be received into the Church at the Easter Vigil.

Pass the word around. On the next page there is a short form for all of you who would like to take the course. Return the completed form to the parish office or give it to one of the priests after the Mass. **Remember...Most people are just waiting to be ASKED!!**

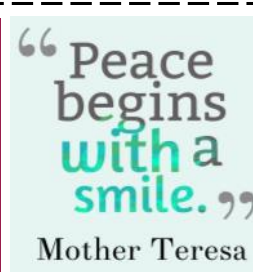
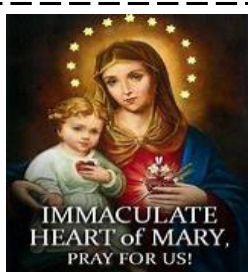

We are collecting sewing machines. If you would like to donate one for the use of the parish please call the parish office or the Religion Education office. Thank you!



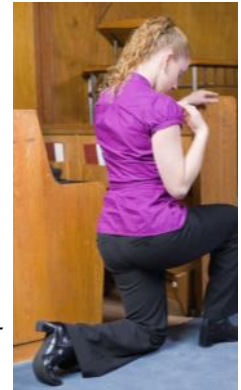
Friendly Reminders



ETIQUETTE AT MASS

Reverence – When you enter a church, you should bless (cross) yourself with Holy Water to remind yourself of your baptism and the fact that you are entering a sanctified place. We are fortunate enough to worship in a church in which the **Body of Christ is reserved**. The red light (sanctuary light) placed above the main altar indicates that **Jesus is present in the tabernacle**.

It is right to acknowledge the **Lord's Real Presence** with a brief act of worship on *entering or leaving* the church and *every* time passing by the Sanctuary. Normally, a genuflection on one knee in the direction of the place of Reservation is enough. One who is physically unable to genuflect may substitute a simple bow at the waist. When the Blessed Sacrament is exposed as in Benediction or Adoration, a genuflection on both knees is required. Do not try to bend both knees at once: go down on one knee, then the other, and then back up the same way. During Mass, a simple bow from the waist is required in the reciting of the Creed during the words "*by the power of the Holy Spirit, he was born of the Virgin Mary, and became man*" (this is to honor the chief mystery of our faith, the Incarnation). It is also traditional to bow the head slightly at the name of Jesus during prayer, especially at Mass. Also, right before the Gospel reading is proclaimed, we make a small cross on our foreheads, lips, and breast so the Gospel may be in our minds, words, and hearts.



Taking a Seat – Please, consider moving toward the center of the pew. This helps everyone to find a seat with the least amount of disruption to others.

Cell Phone – Please, TURN OFF or SILENCE your cell phones and/or pagers before entering the church.

Parking – Be considerate to others. DO NOT park in such a way that you are blocking someone else. In addition, if you do not want to have your car towed, please DO NOT PARK in the areas around our church where there's a "NO PARKING" sign. These zones are CLEARLY marked and violators will – without exception – be towed.

Dressing For Mass – When we are invited to a wedding, many of us wonder, "What am I going to wear?" We wouldn't think of showing up at a wedding or another formal event in our gym clothes. How many of us search for just the right outfit to wear to our annual coffee party or on a date? Compare that to how much thought we put into what we wear to Mass on Sunday. How we dress for an occasion indicates the importance that we place upon that particular celebration. At Mass, we encounter God through the Liturgy of the Word and the Liturgy of the Eucharist. Dressing appropriately for Mass is one way that we show respect, both for God and for our faith family. This respect is important at all masses-no matter what time of day or night.



The celebration of Mass is always a holy occasion, and thus should be treated in the most holy manner – in body, mind, and spirit.

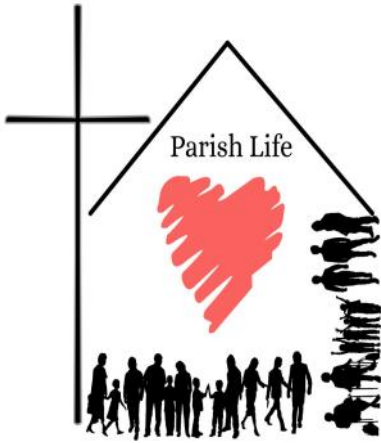

BAPTISMS

Baptisms are celebrated the last Saturday of the month at 11 AM. Please call the Parish office to make the necessary arrangements two months prior to the Baptism date. Parents are expected to attend a Pre-Jordan Baptism class which is to be held on the **last Friday** of every month at 7:00PM in the Parish church. Please call the Parish office to register for the class.

REQUIREMENTS FOR SPONSORING A CHILD FOR BAPTISM/CONFIRMATION (GODPARENTS)

- ◆ Baptized Catholic having received the Sacrament of Baptism and Confirmation
- ◆ 16 years of age or older
- ◆ If married: Canon laws requires that Catholics celebrate marriage according to canonical form (Catholic wedding)
- ◆ Attend Mass faithfully on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation
- ◆ If not registered in this Parish must present a Sponsorship Letter from the Parish that he/she belongs.

REQUESTS FOR ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATES

The role of a sponsor is primarily a Spiritual role to model a Christian life for the child. Therefore, anyone requesting a certificate **must** be a registered, **participating** member of St. Gianna Beretta Molla Parish, a **practicing** Catholic in good standing (not living in violation of the Church laws), at least 16 years of age and **have received the sacraments of initiation** (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist).

Sacrament of Marriage

Couples planning to marry at St. Gianna are expected to contact the Priest to arrange a date and time **FIRST**. Second, they must attend the Pre-Cana conferences as mandated by the Most Reverend Bishop. The period of preparation for marriage is a minimum of **six** months to ensure completion of all arrangements before the wedding day. Please contact the Parish office for more information.

IMPORTANTE INFORMACION PARA LAS PERSONAS QUE SON ELEGIDAS PARA SER PADRINOS DE BAUTISMO O CONFIMACION

El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica explica que el papel del padrino o de la madrina es ayudar a que la gracia bautismal pueda desarrollarse en el bautizado, actuando como colaboradores de sus padres o de quienes ocupan su lugar. Por eso los padrinos deben ser “creyentes sólidos, capaces y prestos a ayudar al nuevo bautizado, niño o adulto, en su camino de la vida cristiana” (CIC 1255). Este es un papel muy importante, ya que todos los miembros de la Iglesia de alguna manera tienen la responsabilidad de desarrollar y guardar la gracia recibida en el bautismo y ayudar a otros a hacer lo mismo.

¿Por qué la Iglesia pone tantas restricciones para poder ser padrino de bautizo?

Es entonces deber del padrino asistir a los padres en la iniciación cristiana del que será bautizado y “procurar que después lleve una vida cristiana congruente con el bautismo y cumpla fielmente las obligaciones inherentes al mismo”. Cabe resaltar que es posible tener un solo padrino o madrina. No es necesario tener dos, pero sí es posible, mientras sea un hombre y una mujer.

La Iglesia ha impuesto requisitos para que los padres puedan elegir a las personas correctas para esta misión tan importante. El padrino o la madrina:

1. Deberá haber sido elegido por quien va a bautizarse o por sus padres, o por quienes ocupan su lugar; o, si faltan estos, por el párroco o ministro.
2. Deberá tener la capacidad para esta misión e intención de desempeñarla.
3. Deberá tener al menos 16 años. (El obispo puede establecer otra edad en su diócesis o el mismo párroco o ministro -por justa causa- puede considerar una excepción.)
4. Deberá ser católico, estar confirmado, haber recibido la Primera Comunión, y llevar una vida congruente con la fe y con la misión que va a asumir.
5. No puede estar afectado por una pena canónica declarada o impuesta legítimamente.
6. No puede ser el padre o la madre de quien se ha de bautizar.
7. De no estar registrado en Sta. Gianna, los candidatos a ser padrinos deberán presentar una carta de la parroquia donde practican su fe (letter of sponsorship).
