

JULY: Month of The Most Precious Blood



If the month of June belongs to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, it follows perfectly that July should recall the Blood that coursed through the Body of Christ and spilled itself for our salvation. It is a stupendous mystery that God should permit the Precious Blood of His Beloved Son to be shed for sinful man! Yet, how unimpressed we are! We need the reminder St. Paul gave to the Hebrews, *“Not with the blood of goats and calves, but with His own Blood, He achieved eternal redemption.”* When Adam and Eve committed their first sin, we might say that we, their children, were kidnapped, snatched away by Satan. And for no amount of money, valuable jewels or property, would the devil free us from his trap. Only one ransom would overpower him, only one ransom could release us. St. Paul tells us what it is: *“What was the ransom that freed you? You know well enough that it was not paid in earthly currency, silver or gold. It was paid in the Precious Blood of Christ.”*

When Our Lord shed His Blood for us, He didn't hold back. There was no hesitation, no stinginess, no *“How much need I shed?”* It was everything He had! The Roman soldier pierced His tortured Body and out trickled blood and water. Christ's Blood was watered down, not because He wanted it that way, but because His Sacred Heart had scarcely any more blood to pump. And still we are scarcely moved by this divine generosity! Our hearts remain harder than stone when they should crumble out of sheer gratitude! Every sin we commit is a betrayal of the Precious Blood of Christ, a waste of valuable graces our Lord won for us so painfully. Now is time to rush back to Satan with the thirty pieces of silver, with all of our sins and bad habits and broken resolutions – hurl them onto the floor in his presence and be not ashamed to confess: *“We are guilty of betraying innocent blood!”* And then we must haste, not as Judas in despair to end our lives, but to the foot of the cross, to the side of our Sorrowful Mother. Let a few drops of Christ's Precious Blood fall upon our heads – and we will be on time to hear our gentle savior whisper: *“Father, forgive them, for they knew not what they did!”* The whole world has been redeemed and washed clean by the Precious Blood of Jesus, our God and Savior. The flowing of our Redeemer's Blood is the crowning event of all time! Without it, all is barren and hopeless, lost in darkness as black as pitch. Christ, Himself, referred to it as the *“Blood of the new covenant shed for many unto the forgiveness of sins”* (Matthew 26:28). He *“purchased the Church with His own blood”* (Acts 20:28). It is precious. *“You are redeemed...not with perishable things, not with silver or gold, but with the Precious Blood of Christ”* (1 Peter 1:19). By the Precious Blood, we are:

- ◆ *“justified”*
- ◆ *“cleansed”*
- ◆ *“washed”*

“These are they who have come out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes and made them white in the Blood of the Lamb” (Ap. 7:14). Jesus called it *“My Blood”* (Mark 14:24) and invited His followers to *“drink It”* that they might *“have everlasting life”* (Matthew 26:28).

In Holy Mass, 20 centuries later, we partake of Our Lord's body and blood. He is actually present for us here and now. "Then, taking bread and giving thanks, He broke it and gave it to them saying, "This is My body to be given up for you. Do this in remembrance of me." He did the same with the cup after eating, saying as He did so, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood, which will be shed for you" (Luke 22:20). The Apostles, now heading Christ's Church, followed our Lord's command and example: "This cup is the new covenant in my blood. Do this, whenever you drink It, in remembrance of me" (Corinthians 11:25). Devotion to the Precious Blood of Jesus received a most explicit and official approval from Blessed Pope John XXIII in 1960. He not only approved the Litany of the Precious Blood for private and public recitation throughout the world, he also ordered the ejaculation "Blessed be his Most Precious Blood" inserted in the Divine praises. He even wrote an apostolic letter (Inde a Primis) to the bishops of the world (June 30, 1960) urging them to foster and promote the devotion. The following two paragraphs are from this document:

We judge it most timely to call our beloved children's attention to the unbreakable bond that must exist between the devotions to the Most Holy Name and the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus...and the devotion to the Incarnate Lord and the Most Precious Blood, which owes its marvelous diffusion to the 19th Century Roman priest, St. Gaspar Del Bufalo, has rightly merited the approval and backing of the apostolic see.

Such surpassing love (which Jesus manifested in pouring out His blood for us) suggests, nay demands, that everyone reborn in the torrents of that Blood adore it with grateful love. The Blood of the new and eternal covenant, especially deserves the worship of "latría" when it is elevated during the sacrifice of the Mass. But such worship achieves its normal fulfillment in sacramental communion with the same blood indissolubly united with Christ's Eucharistic Body (Blessed Pope John XXIII).

Let us close our meditation on the Precious Blood of Jesus with this final beautiful thought of Blessed Pope John: "The Infinite Love of the Savior is announced in His name, is symbolized in His Heart and is made eloquent in His Precious Blood!"





Friendly Reminders



ETIQUETTE AT MASS

Reverence – When you enter a church, you should bless (cross) yourself with Holy Water to remind yourself of your baptism and the fact that you are entering a sanctified place. We are fortunate enough to worship in a church in which the **Body of Christ is reserved**. The red light (sanctuary light) placed above the main altar indicates that **Jesus is present in the tabernacle**. It is right to acknowledge the **Lord's Real Presence** with a brief act of worship on *entering or leaving* the church and *every* time passing by the Sanctuary. Normally, a genuflection on one knee in the direction of the place of Reservation is enough. One who is physically unable to genuflect may substitute a simple bow at the waist. When the Blessed Sacrament is exposed as in Benediction or Adoration, a genuflection on both knees is required. Do not try to bend both knees at once: go down on one knee, then the other, and then back up the same way. During Mass, a simple bow from the waist is required in the reciting of the Creed during the words *"by the power of the Holy Spirit, he was born of the Virgin Mary, and became man"* (this is to honor the chief mystery of our faith, the Incarnation). It is also traditional to bow the head slightly at the name of Jesus during prayer, especially at Mass. Also, right before the Gospel reading is proclaimed, we make a small cross on our foreheads, lips, and breast so the Gospel may be in our minds, words, and hearts.



Taking a Seat – Please, consider moving toward the center of the pew. This helps everyone to find a seat with the least amount of disruption to others.

Cell Phone – Please, TURN OFF or SILENCE your cell phones and/or pagers before entering the church.

Parking – Be considerate to others. DO NOT park in such a way that you are blocking someone else. In addition, if you do not want to have your car towed, please DO NOT PARK in the areas around our church where there's a "NO PARKING" sign. These zones are CLEARLY marked and violators will – without exception – be towed.

Dressing For Mass – When we are invited to a wedding, many of us wonder, "What am I going to wear?" We wouldn't think of showing up at a wedding or another formal event in our gym clothes. How many of us search for just the right outfit to wear to our annual coffee party or on a date? Compare that to how much thought we put into what we wear to Mass on Sunday. How we dress for an occasion indicates the importance that we place upon that particular celebration. At Mass, we encounter God through the Liturgy of the Word and the Liturgy of the Eucharist. Dressing appropriately for Mass is one way that we show respect, both for God and for our faith family. This respect is important at all masses-no matter what time of day or night.



The celebration of Mass is always a holy occasion, and thus should be treated in the most holy manner – in body, mind, and spirit.

BAPTISMS

Baptisms are celebrated the last Saturday of the month at 11 AM. Please call the Parish office to make the necessary arrangements two months prior to the Baptism date. Parents are expected to attend a Pre-Jordan Baptism class which is to be held on the **last Friday** of every month at 7:00PM in the Parish church. Please call the Parish office to register for the class.

REQUIREMENTS FOR SPONSORING A CHILD FOR BAPTISM/CONFIRMATION (GODPARENTS)

- ◆ Baptized Catholic having received the Sacrament of Baptism and Confirmation
- ◆ 16 years of age or older
- ◆ If married: Canon laws requires that Catholics celebrate marriage according to canonical form (Catholic wedding)
- ◆ Attend Mass faithfully on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation
- ◆ If not registered in this Parish must present a Sponsorship Letter from the Parish that he/she belongs.

REQUESTS FOR ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATES

The role of a sponsor is primarily a Spiritual role to model a Christian life for the child. Therefore, anyone requesting a certificate **must** be a registered, **participating** member of St. Gianna Beretta Molla Parish, a **practicing** Catholic in good standing (not living in violation of the Church laws), at least 16 years of age and **have received the sacraments of initiation** (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist).

Sacrament of Marriage

Couples planning to marry at St. Gianna are expected to contact the Priest to arrange a date and time **FIRST**. Second, they must attend the Pre-Cana conferences as mandated by the Most Reverend Bishop. The period of preparation for marriage is a minimum of **six** months to ensure completion of all arrangements before the wedding day. Please contact the Parish office for more information.

PRECIOSA SANGRE DE CRISTO

IMPORTANTE INFORMACION PARA LAS PERSONAS QUE SON ELEGIDAS PARA SER PADRINOS DE BAUTISMO O CONFIMACION

El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica explica que el papel del padrino o de la madrina es ayudar a que la gracia bautismal pueda desarrollarse en el bautizado, actuando como colaboradores de sus padres o de quienes ocupan su lugar. Por eso los padrinos deben ser “creyentes sólidos, capaces y prestos a ayudar al nuevo bautizado, niño o adulto, en su camino de la vida cristiana” (CIC 1255). Este es un papel muy importante, ya que todos los miembros de la Iglesia de alguna manera tienen la responsabilidad de desarrollar y guardar la gracia recibida en el bautismo y ayudar a otros a hacer lo mismo.

¿Por qué la Iglesia pone tantas restricciones para poder ser padrino de bautizo?

Es entonces deber del padrino asistir a los padres en la iniciación cristiana del que será bautizado y “procurar que después lleve una vida cristiana congruente con el bautismo y cumpla fielmente las obligaciones inherentes al mismo”. Cabe resaltar que es posible tener un solo padrino o madrina. No es necesario tener dos, pero sí es posible, mientras sea un hombre y una mujer.

La Iglesia ha impuesto requisitos para que los padres puedan elegir a las personas correctas para esta misión tan importante. El padrino o la madrina:

1. Deberá haber sido elegido por quien va a bautizarse o por sus padres, o por quienes ocupan su lugar; o, si faltan estos, por el párroco o ministro.
2. Deberá tener la capacidad para esta misión e intención de desempeñarla.
3. Deberá tener al menos 16 años. (El obispo puede establecer otra edad en su diócesis o el mismo párroco o ministro -por justa causa- puede considerar una excepción.)
4. Deberá ser católico, estar confirmado, haber recibido la Primera Comunión, y llevar una vida congruente con la fe y con la misión que va a asumir.
5. No puede estar afectado por una pena canónica declarada o impuesta legítimamente.
6. No puede ser el padre o la madre de quien se ha de bautizar.
7. De no estar registrado en Sta. Gianna, los candidatos a ser padrinos deberán presentar una carta de la parroquia donde practican su fe (letter of sponsorship).
