In taking care of the things of God, I ask that all of us examine ourselves as to how we are fulfilling this duty. Ask yourself the questions: *Do I consider the support of my church a priority or am I content to give of my leftovers? Do I make a regular financial contribution to my parish?* In answering these questions, hopefully many will be able to say yes. Others may ask: *What can I do?* As your pastor, I ask that ALL parishioners make a firm financial commitment based on your generosity and your ability to contribute regularly. Regular contributors who use envelopes or are choosing to give online are the bedrock of our stable financial support. Please consider joining this core group of generous parish members who make worship, learning, and community life possible for us all.



Presently, only about 40% of our families regularly use the collection envelopes. It would greatly benefit our church if everyone did because our parish depends on the financial support of its parishioners. Naturally, some can do better, some cannot. However, I pray that it will be a serious financial commitment on the part of all who call St. Gianna's their spiritual home. In determining how much you will contribute, I ask that you let your heart be your guide. Our hearts are always the best guides in expressing love and gratitude to God for His many blessings.

I thank you for your kindness, fidelity and generosity to our parish. A profound word of gratitude to each and every family that helps ease the burden of caring for the parish, as well as our diocesan assessments.

All responses will be confidential, and the parish will only receive information about the community as a whole. We will share the link with you a bit closer to the launch of the survey. Paper surveys will also be available for those who do not have the ability to complete the survey online.

I invite each member of our parish family here at St. Gianna to participate in this important survey. Together we must embrace Christ's vision for missionary discipleship so our parish can thrive and be a better place for others to grow together in faith.

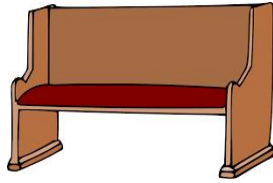

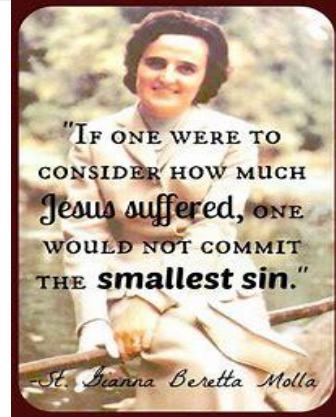

Every parish in the USA participates each summer in the Mission Cooperative. This is the program whereby a missionary from some congregation speaks about that congregation's missionary activity. We will welcome Brother Dennis Lee, FSC, of the De La Salle Christian Brothers to our parish on the weekend of August 17-18. Brother Dennis currently serves in Kenya and he will highlight the work of the Brothers both in Kenya and in the Holy Land. In our diocese, the Christian Brothers and Lasallians serve at Christian Brothers Academy in Lincroft NJ.

For over one hundred years the critical infrastructure of the BASILICA OF THE NATIONAL SHRINE OF THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION in Washington, DC has served it well. However, time has a way of taking its toll. Updating the Basilica can no longer be delayed; it must be done to preserve the integrity of that magnificent structure. The proposed renewal project includes the modernization of heating and cooling systems, which are essential for the 365 day-a-year ministry that the staff of the Basilica provides.

Catholics around the country are being asked for their support. The National Shrine relies on the generosity of donors as it is neither a Cathedral nor a parish church. For more than one hundred years this basilica, which was built through the generosity of previous generations of Catholics, has served millions of pilgrims and visitors. Now our generation of Catholics is called upon to protect the future of the Shrine.

Most Reverend Dennis J. Sullivan is asking that at all Masses on the weekend of August 10-11, all parishes of the Dioceses of Camden take a collection. Our financial support will provide a lasting legacy at Mary's Shrine for generations to come.

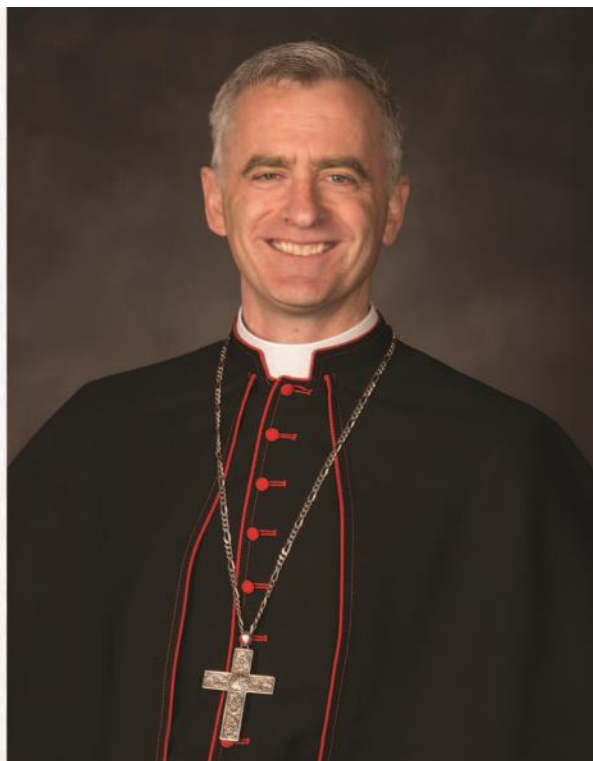

### A READING FROM THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO JOHN

Jesus went across the Sea of Galilee. A large crowd followed him, because they saw the signs he was performing on the sick. Jesus went up on the mountain, and there he sat down with his disciples. The Jewish feast of Passover was near. When Jesus raised his eyes and saw that a large crowd was coming to him, he said to Philip, "Where can we buy enough food for them to eat?" He said this to test him, because he himself knew what he was going to do. Philip answered him, "Two hundred days' wages worth of food would not be enough for each of them to have a little." One of his disciples, Andrew, the brother of Simon Peter, said to him, "There is a boy here who has five barley loaves and two fish; but what good are these for so many?" Jesus said, "Have the people recline." Now there was a great deal of grass in that place. So the men reclined, about five thousand in number. Then Jesus took the loaves, gave thanks, and distributed them to those who were reclining, and also as much of the fish as they wanted. 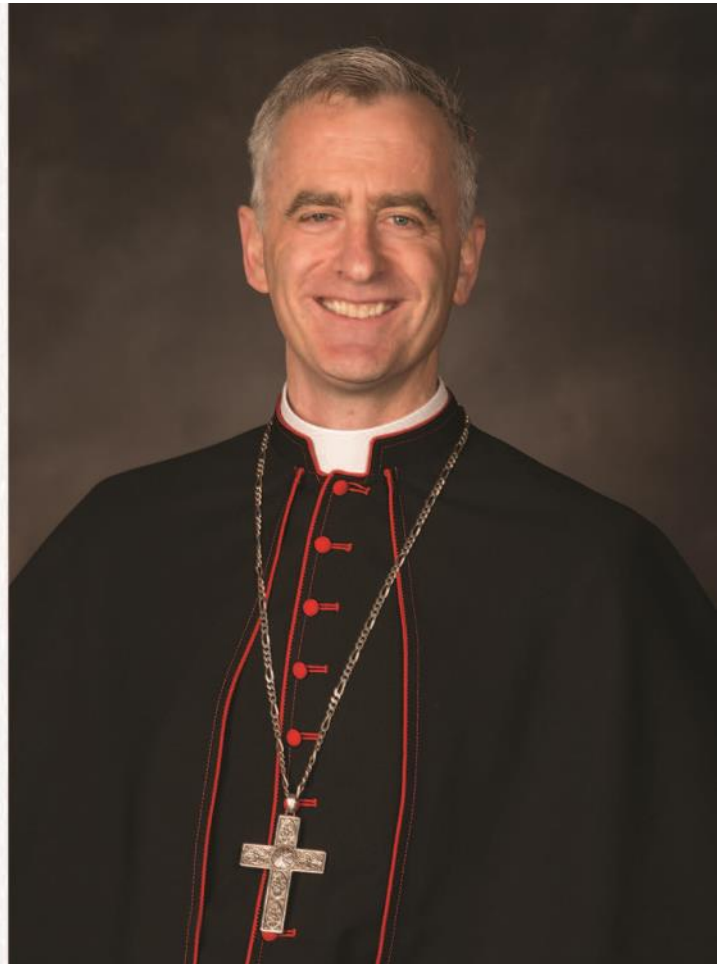
