## From the Pastor's Desk

ALL SOULS DAY  
SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 2, 2024  
4:30 PM MASS

November 2<sup>nd</sup> is not the *feast of the Crib nor of the Cross*, but rather of the *coffin*. It's the feast of All Souls, and this is the feast that gently tugs at the string around our finger, quietly nudges our memory, pleadingly asks, have you, too, forgotten? As we approach the month of November, we need to ask ourselves, "What can I do for mom or dad who has died? What can I do for my husband or wife, son, daughter, friend, priest who has died?" We look into our consciences and perhaps, just perhaps, we realize we were not as good to our dear deceased loved ones as we should have been, and we can feel guilty. "If only I would have been more loving, showed my love more, but alas, I did not." There is nothing we can do now or is there something? Yes, there is! The Mass offered for our deceased loved ones is the greatest act of love we can do for them, for the fruits and effects of every Mass can be applied to that dear soul in purgatory, pleading and begging us to help them escape the punishments of purgatory. The famous English Catholic brilliant essayist, Hillaire Belloc, a lucid historian, an exemplary Catholic, a beautiful poet, the very pattern of the highly educated English Catholic – when his wife died, he turned the key in the door of her room and never entered it again. Each night as he went to bed he would pause and make the sign of the cross upon the door pane. For 30 years he survived her, he wore only somber black. Even his stationery was edged in black. Call it what you want – eccentric, excessive, extravagant. Most of us are in the other direction, insofar as we so seldom think of our dear departed or the possibility of their being in purgatory. *Purgatory?* a word in the Catechism of the Catholic Church. Something sad and far off. Because it is sad, we sigh and shake our heads. Because it is far off, we shrug our shoulders and murmur, "what can we do?" If the hands that reach pleadingly out of purgatory to us are hands that we once clasped, purgatory cannot be so far away. And, yes, we can help not by sending *care packages*, but by sending *prayer packages*. The very month of November is the Church's airlift, bound for purgatory and loaded with Masses. So, why not reach out in love to your dearly departed? Enroll them in the Novena of Masses on Saturday, November 2<sup>nd</sup>. Come to the special solemn **Requiem Latin Mass on Saturday, November 2, 2024 at 4:30 p.m.**, and you will have touched him/her with love.

This year All Souls Day falls on a Saturday. Our 4:30 p.m. Mass on All Souls Day will be the Mass we remember all the holy souls who died this past year and were buried from our parish. We will also remember in a special way all the holy souls that are enrolled in which you have given us the names on the All Souls envelopes provided. Please make sure you get those envelopes returned before All Souls Day. This year that Mass, will be in Latin and accompanied with the music of Gabriel Faure. This Mass is very moving and a masterpiece of music. I hope you will attend this special Mass for your dearly departed loved ones. I mention that it will be in Latin so if you do not want to attend you can go to any of our English Masses on Sunday.

## THE LORD'S REAL PRESENCE

We are fortunate enough to worship in a Church in which the **Body of Christ** is **reserved**. It is right to acknowledge the **Lord's Real Presence** with a brief act of worship on entering or leaving the Church and every time passing by the Sanctuary. Normally, a *genuflection* in the direction of the place of Reservation is enough. One who is physically unable to genuflect may substitute a *profound bow* at the waist.



**Baptisms** are celebrated the last Saturday of the month at 11 AM. Please call the parish office to make the necessary arrangements two months prior to the Baptism date. Parents are expected to attend a Pre-Jordan Baptism class which is to be held on the **last Friday** of every month at 7:00PM in the Parish hall. Please call the Parish office to register for the class.

## REQUIREMENTS FOR SPONSORING A CHILD FOR BAPTISM/CONFIRMATION (GODPARENTS)

- ◆ Baptized Catholic having received the Sacrament of Confirmation
- ◆ 16 years of age or older
- ◆ If single, they are living a chaste life, that is, not "living together" with someone
- ◆ Attend Mass faithfully on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation
- ◆ If not registered in this Parish must present a Sponsorship Letter from the Parish that he/she belongs.

## Sacrament of Marriage

Couples planning to marry at St. Gianna are expected to contact the Priest to arrange a date and time **FIRST**. Second, they must attend the Pre-Cana conferences as mandated by the Most Reverend Bishop. The period of preparation for marriage is a minimum of **six** months to ensure completion of all arrangements before the wedding day. Please contact the Parish office for more information.



### A READING FROM THE LETTER OF SAINT PAUL TO THE HEBREWS

**B**rothers and sisters: Every high priest is taken from among men and made their representative before God, to offer gifts and sacrifices for sins. He is able to deal patiently with the ignorant and erring, for he himself is beset by weakness and so, for this reason, must make sin offerings for himself as well as for the people. No one takes this honor upon himself but only when called by God, just as Aaron was. Examinamos nuestra conciencia y tal vez, sólo tal vez, nos damos cuenta de que no fuimos tan buenos con nuestros seres queridos fallecidos como deberíamos haber sido y podemos sentirnos culpables. "Si tan solo hubiera sido más cariñoso, hubiera mostrado más mi amor, pero, por desgracia, no lo hice." No hay nada que podamos hacer ahora o ¿hay algo? ¡Sí, lo hay!

La misa ofrecida por nuestros seres queridos fallecidos es el mayor acto de amor que podemos hacer por ellos, porque los frutos y efectos de cada misa pueden aplicarse a esa querida alma del purgatorio, que nos ruega y nos ruega que la ayudemos a escapar de los castigos del purgatorio. El famoso y brillante ensayista católico inglés, Hillaire Belloc, un historiador lúcido, un católico ejemplar, un hermoso poeta, el modelo mismo del católico inglés altamente educado, cuando murió su esposa, hizo girar la llave en la puerta de su habitación y nunca más volvió a entrar. ¿Purgatorio? Una palabra del catecismo de la Iglesia Católica. Algo triste y lejano. Como es triste, suspiramos y sacudimos la cabeza. Como está lejos, nos encogemos de hombros y murmuramos: "¿Qué podemos hacer?". Si las manos que se extienden suplicantes desde el purgatorio hacia nosotros son manos que una vez estrechamos, el purgatorio no puede estar tan lejos. Y, sí, podemos ayudar no enviando paquetes de ayuda, sino enviando paquetes de oración. El mismo mes de noviembre es el puente aéreo de la Iglesia, con destino al purgatorio y cargado de misas. Entonces, ¿por qué no acercarse con amor a su ser querido difunto?
