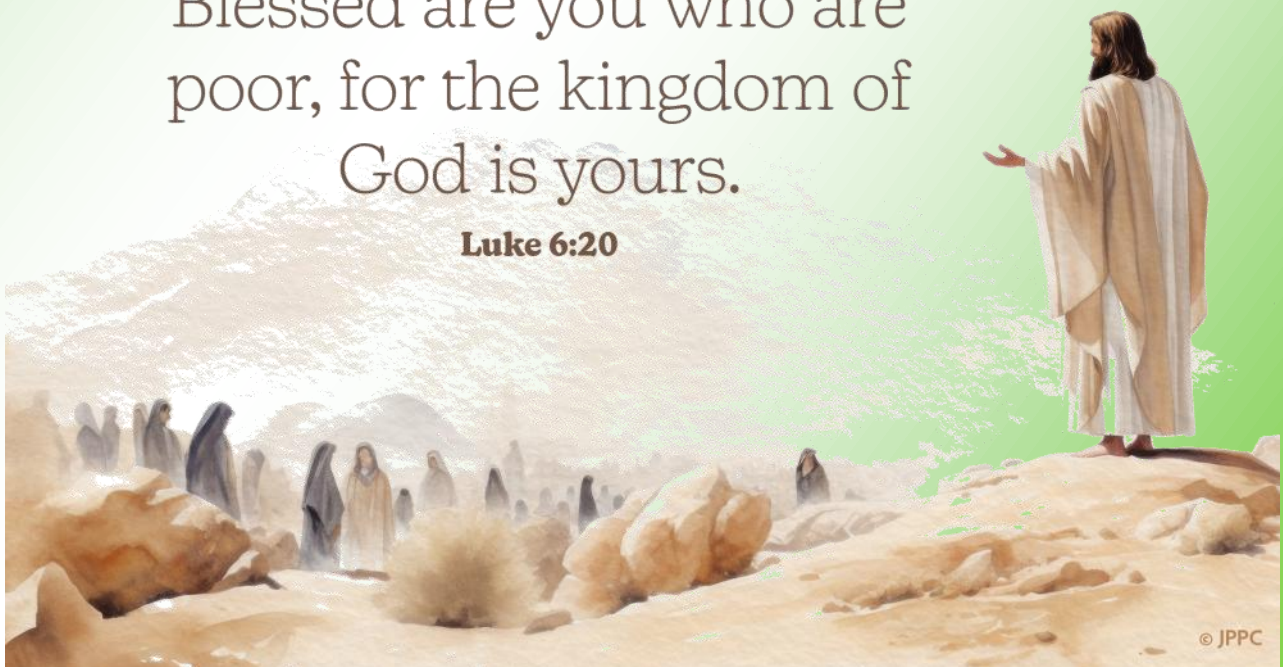

May God Bless and reward you,

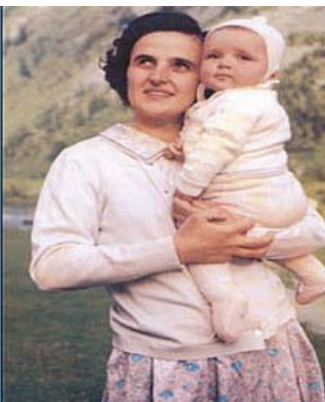

Therefore, anyone requesting a certificate **must** be a registered, **participating** member of St. Gianna Beretta Molla Parish, a **practicing** Catholic in good standing (not living in violation of the Church laws), at least 16 years of age and **have received the sacraments of initiation** (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist). 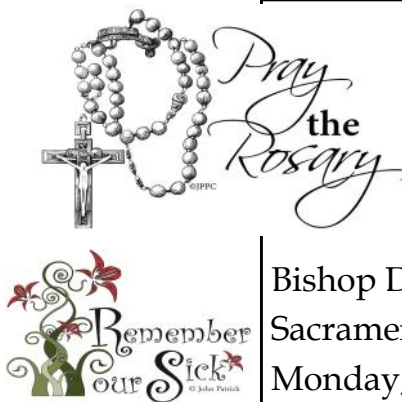
Sacrament of Marriage

El tiempo ordinario comienza el lunes siguiente al domingo del bautismo del Señor y se extiende hasta el miércoles de ceniza, para reanudarse de nuevo el lunes después del domingo de Pentecostés y terminar antes de las primeras vísperas del domingo I de Adviento.

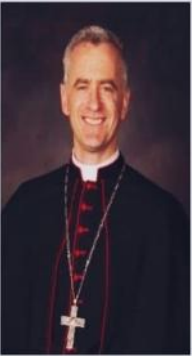
