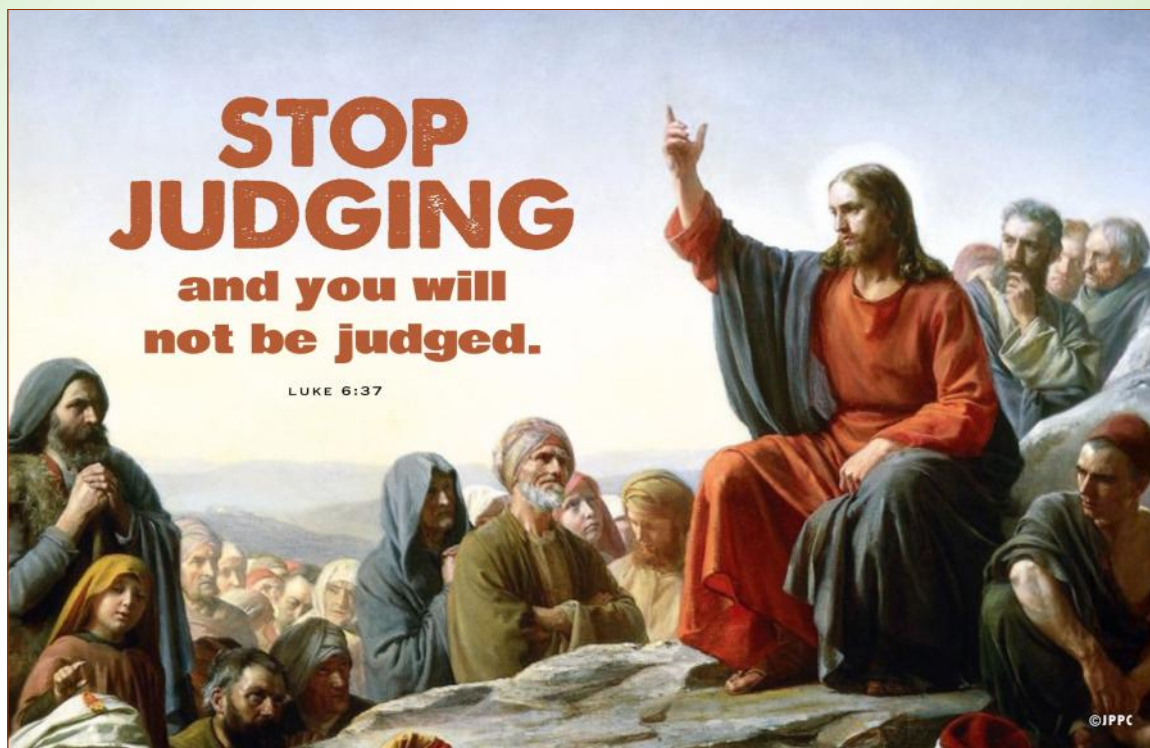

It is difficult to keep track of time. It seems we just finished the Christmas season, and now we begin Lent! On Wednesday, March 5th we will begin the journey of a 40-day season of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving in preparation to celebrate the Lord's Resurrection at Easter.

During Lent we remember that part in the life of Jesus when He dwelt, fasting in the desert for forty days. Lent is all about Jesus and the love of our Lord, who denied himself for our salvation. So, I want to help you and your family to prepare during this holy season of Lent offering in our parish many opportunities for your spiritual growth. Of course, we begin on Ash Wednesday (March 5th) receiving ashes and so we started our Lent on the right foot!


We will have Stations of the Cross every Wednesday night at 7 p.m. with Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament. Wednesday nights we will also have Soup for the Soul at 5:30 p.m. in the parish hall. I will be giving a conference at each of those meals. So, we will have a delicious penitential soup, bread for our bodies and a spiritual talk to enrich and warm our souls!

Also, our Parish Mission will take place from Monday, March 24th until Thursday, March 27th. Our speaker, Fr. Allain Capara, is an excellent speaker and he will certainly hold our attention and help us in our spiritual Lenten journey. I know you will enjoy him very much.

Every registered parishioner should have received by now our Lenten program here at St. Gianna.

REQUESTS FOR ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATES

The role of a sponsor is primarily a Spiritual role to model a Christian life for the child. Therefore, anyone requesting a certificate **must** be a registered, **participating** member of St. Gianna Beretta Molla Parish, a **practicing** Catholic in good standing (not living in violation of the Church laws), at least 16 years of age and **have received the sacraments of initiation** (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist). Please call the Parish office to make an appointment.

Sacrament of Marriage

Couples planning to marry at St. Gianna are expected to contact the Priest to arrange a date and time **FIRST**. Second, they must attend the Pre-Cana conferences as mandated by the Most Reverend Bishop. The period of preparation for marriage is a minimum of **six** months to ensure completion of all arrangements before the wedding day. Please contact the Parish office for more information.

PRIMERA LECTURA DEL LIBRO DEL PROFETA ISAIAS

En aquellos días, Saúl se puso en camino con tres mil soldados israelitas, bajó al desierto de Zif en persecución de David y acampó en Jakilá. David y Abisay fueron de noche al campamento enemigo y encontraron a Saúl durmiendo entre los carros; su lanza estaba clavada en tierra, junto a su cabecera, y en torno a él dormían Abner y su ejército. Abisay dijo entonces a David: “Dios te está poniendo al enemigo al alcance de tu mano. Deja que lo clave ahora en tierra con un solo golpe de su misma lanza. No hará falta repetirlo”. 
