Fr. Allain B. Caparas, KHS, is a priest of Diocese of Camden and currently the Pastor of *Mary Mother of Mercy Parish* in Glassboro, NJ. Prior to entering the seminary, Father Caparas was a high school religion teacher. He was ordained in 2006 after completing his theological and priestly studies at *St. Charles Borromeo Seminary* in Philadelphia, where he also received his Master's in Theology. His past assignments include serving as a Parochial Vicar at *Queen of Angels Parish* (Buena Borough) and *St. Peter's Roman Catholic Church* (Merchantville). He served as the founding Pastor of *Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament Parish* (Newfield) prior to being appointed in the education apostolate as the Director of Catholic Identity at *Gloucester Catholic High School* (Gloucester City, NJ) and as the Principal and President of *St. Joseph High School* (Hammonton). He currently serves as member of the advisory board at *Gloucester Catholic High School*. During his time in education, Father Caparas has successfully organized over 2 dozen tours and pilgrimages to Europe and throughout the United States for adults, college, and high school students. He recently started preaching at parish missions and various retreats. Father Caparas immigrated with his family from the Philippines in 1986, and has lived in various states throughout his life. He enjoys traveling, hiking, reading post-apocalyptic novels, spending time with his family and friends, working out in the gym, playing video games, watching movies, and cooking. He loves Filipino, Japanese, and Italian food, and has a great devotion to Our Lady and St. Maximillian Kolbe.

If you or someone that you know is a shut-in and would like to receive the sacraments, please let us know by contacting the parish office.



Weekdays of Lent:

There is no obligation to fast. However, voluntary acts of self-denial are recommended.

Ash Wednesday & Good Friday:

These are days of fast & abstinence from meat. There is a limit of one full meal on these days for all between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive.

Days of Abstinence: (All Fridays in Lent)

All who have reached their 14th year are bound to abstain totally from meat.

Easter Duty Obligation:

After they have received their First Holy Communion, Catholics are bound by the obligation of receiving Holy Communion at least once a year. This precept should be fulfilled during the Easter Season. Catholics are also bound to confess serious (mortal) sins at least once a year, but this is not limited to the Lenten/Easter Season.

The time for fulfilling the Paschal Precept (Easter Duty) extends from the First Sunday of Lent, March 9, 2025 to the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, June 15, 2025.

A READING FROM THE FIRST BOOK OF EXODUS

Parish Notes

REQUESTS FOR ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATES

The role of a sponsor is primarily a spiritual role to model a Christian life for the child. Therefore, anyone requesting a certificate **must** be a registered, **participating** member of St. Gianna Beretta Molla Parish, a **practicing** Catholic in good standing (not living in violation of the Church laws), at least 16 years of age and **have received the sacraments of initiation** (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist). Please call the Parish office to make an appointment.

Sacrament of Marriage

Couples planning to marry at St. Gianna are expected to contact the Priest to arrange a date and time **FIRST**. Second, they must attend the Pre-Cana conferences as mandated by the Most Reverend Bishop. The period of preparation for marriage is a minimum of **six** months to ensure completion of all arrangements before the wedding day. Please contact the Parish office for more information.

month at 11:00 AM in the parish church. Please call the Parish office to make the necessary arrangements two months prior to the Baptism date. Parents are expected to attend a Pre-Jordan Baptism class which is to be held on the **last Friday** of every month at 7:30PM in the Parish Hall.



Requirements for Godparents in the Catholic Church

- ♦ They must be chosen by the parents or those acting in their place, and have the capacity and intention to serve as godparents.
- ♦ They must be at least 16 years old.
- ♦ They must be baptized, confirmed, and have received the Eucharist.
- ♦ They must be Catholics who lead a life of faith in keeping with their role.
- ♦ If married, they must be in a valid Catholic marriage.
- ♦ A letter of "sponsorship" is required for those godparents who are not members of this parish.



Regulaciones para la Cuaresma

El Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo (18 de abril) son días de ayuno y abstinencia, y todos los viernes de Cuaresma son días de abstinencia.

Abstinencia — requiere que todos los católicos que hayan cumplido sus 14 años de edad se abstengan de comer carne el Miércoles de Ceniza, el Viernes Santo y todos los viernes de la Cuaresma (Código de Derecho Canónico §1252). Se considera carne aquella de los mamíferos y aves. Pescados de mar o de agua dulce al igual que otros mariscos están permitidos; también están permitidos productos derivados de animales como productos lácteos o huevos.

Ayuno — requiere que todos los católicos desde la edad de 18 años hasta el comienzo de la edad de 60 reduzcan la cantidad de comida consumida normalmente. La Iglesia define esto como una comida sin carne al día, y dos comidas sin carne más pequeñas que juntas no excedan la comida principal en cantidad. Comer entre comidas no está permitido, pero líquidos, incluyendo leche y jugos naturales, están permitidos.

Dispensas — Además de los límites de edad, aquellos de facultades mentales perturbadas, los enfermos, los frágiles, mujeres embarazadas o madres lactantes según la necesidad de carne o nutrición, trabajadores manuales según la necesidad, huéspedes a una comida en la cual no podrían excusarse sin causar gran ofensa o causando enemistad y otras situaciones de imposibilidades morales o físicas a observar la disciplina penitencial.

PRIMERA LECTURA DEL LIBRO DEL EXODO

En aquellos días, Moisés pastoreaba el rebaño de su suegro, Jetró, sacerdote de Madián. En cierta ocasión llevó el rebaño más allá del desierto, hasta el Horeb, el monte de Dios, y el Señor se le apareció en una llama que salía de un zarzal. Moisés observó con gran asombro que la zarza ardía sin consumirse y se dijo: “Voy a ver de cerca esa cosa tan extraña, por qué la zarza no se quema.” Viendo el Señor que Moisés se había desviado para mirar, lo llamó desde la zarza: “¡Moisés, Moisés!” Él respondió: “Aquí estoy”.
