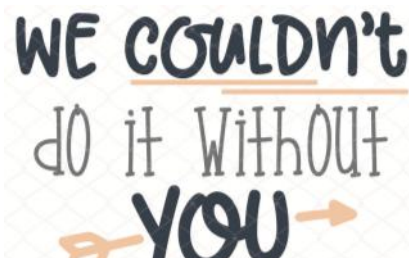

Fasting & Abstinence

Weekdays of Lent

There is no obligation to fast. However, voluntary acts of self-denial are recommended.

Ash Wednesday & Good Friday

These are days of Fast & Abstinence from meat. There is a limit of one full meal on these days for all between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive.

Days of Abstinence (All Fridays in Lent)

All who have reached their 14th year are bound to abstain totally from meat.

Easter Duty Obligation:

After they have received their First Holy Communion, Catholics are bound by the obligation of receiving Holy Communion at least once a year. This precept should be fulfilled during the Easter Season. Catholics are also bound to confess serious (mortal) sins at least once a year, but this is not limited to the Lenten/Easter Season.

The time for fulfilling the Paschal Precept (Easter Duty) extends from the First Sunday of Lent, March 9, 2025 to the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, June 15, 2025.

REQUESTS FOR ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATES

The role of a sponsor is primarily a Spiritual role to model a Christian life for the child. Therefore, anyone requesting a certificate **must** be a registered, **participating** member of St. Gianna Beretta Molla Parish, a **practicing** Catholic in good standing (not living in violation of the Church laws), at least 16 years of age and **have received the sacraments of initiation** (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist). Please call the Parish office to make an appointment.

Baptisms are celebrated on the First Saturday of the month at



11:00 AM in the parish church. Please call the Parish office to make the necessary arrangements two months prior to the Baptism date. Parents are expected to attend a Pre-Jordan Baptism class which is to be held on the **last Friday** of every month at 7:30PM in the Parish Hall.

Requirements for Godparents in the Catholic Church

- ♦ They must be chosen by the parents or those acting in their place, and have the capacity and intention to serve as godparents.
- ♦ They must be at least 16 years old.
- ♦ They must be baptized, confirmed, and have received the Eucharist.
- ♦ They must be Catholics who lead a life of faith in keeping with their role.
- ♦ If married, they must be in a valid Catholic marriage.
- ♦ A letter of "sponsorship" is required for those godparents who are not members of this parish.
