PENTECOST SUNDAY



What Does Pentecost Teach Us?

The Paschal feast ends at Pentecost, which is “Red Easter,” the color of blood, fire and charity.

It is the feast of springtime – of life bursting forth everywhere.

For the Jews, this was the feast of the first fruits, in which the first loaves made with the wheat from the new harvest were offered to God. This feast likewise recalled the promulgation of the law of God by Moses on Mount Sinai. It was the “feast of the law.”

For the Church, Pentecost is the feast of the first fruits of the Resurrection. It is the birthday of the Church. It is also the feast of the *new* law; not the law of fear, but the law of love, brought by the Holy Spirit. With Pentecost, the reign of the Spirit of Jesus is inaugurated. The redemption passes from the head to the members.

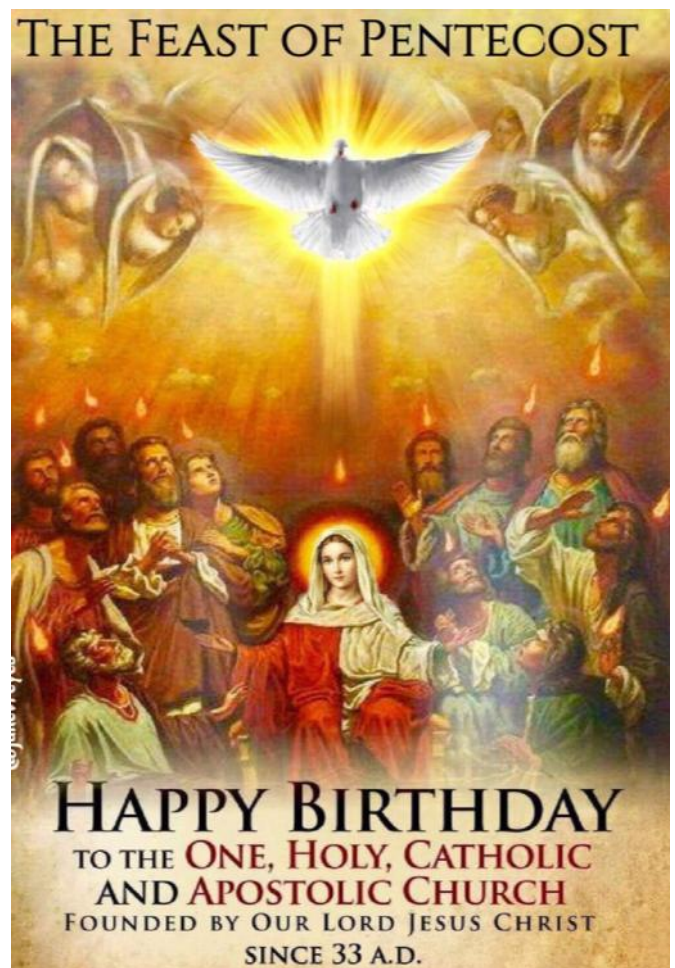
Under the inspiration of God’s spirit, this life comes forth. A flash of light – *tongues of fire* – and the fire that Jesus came to bring on the earth is kindled. The doors shake like an egg-shell under the pressure of new life. And those who a few moments before trembled like little children, now set out to take the dreadful world by storm.

At Peter’s first sermon, we witness 3,000 conversions in a single day! Three thousand new “Christs” conceived by the Holy Spirit! The next day 5,000! From pusillanimous, fearful, timid men, the apostles, filled with the Holy Spirit, become heroes, going on to martyrdom!

Every Christian is called on to reproduce Christ in his life. This is the grace of Pentecost, the one for which we shall pray today above all other graces.

Yes, let the Spirit enter with His seven gifts, and make us understand, will, and live a Christianity that is dynamic and apostolically fruitful.

Let us always remember that Pentecost is the feast of the indwelling of the Holy Spirit in our souls, therefore, the Holy Spirit lives in our souls when we are free from mortal sin.





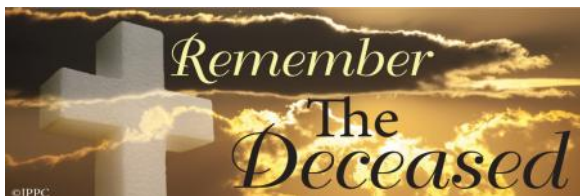

In order to serve the priests and the people of the parish in an orderly manner, we need **everyone's help**. Please note regarding:

Bulletin Announcements/Articles

While the parish is happy to place all articles/announcements you wish to appear in the parish bulletin we kindly ask you to please **submit those articles/announcements to the parish office on Mondays so we can reach the bulletin deadline.**

Please refrain from handling administrative affairs in the sacristy of the church, most especially before or after of any of the Liturgies. The sacristy is used by Priests, Deacons and Altar Servers preparing to celebrate the Liturgies, and distractions of this nature can easily disturb the holiness and the tranquility they need.

Pulpit Announcements: Due to time, Diocese and parish priorities, pulpit announcements are limited and subject to the Pastor's discretion. However, the announcements **MUST be submitted to the parish office FIRST, NOT to any of the priests in the sacristy of the church.**

Flyers, cards and/or propaganda in the church (*bulletin boards at the entrances of the church*). Our parish welcomes parishioners, visitors and friends to God's house every day. We are proud of the appearance of our church and our heartfelt thanks to those people working to keep God's dwelling in order, devoid of disturbing distractions, and preserving the décor and respect our Lord deserves. We ask you to please remember that:

- ◆ NO announcements/articles and/or propaganda of any kind are permitted on the *Main Bulletin Boards* placed in the gathering area of the church
- ◆ Flyers of events that are not taking place in our parish are welcome to be placed at any of the four bulletin boards (side entrances of the church). However, they need to be submitted to the parish for pastoral approval **NOT to the priests in the sacristy of the church.**

Private meetings & invitations to the parish priests: If you would like to make an appointment to meet with one of the priests or invite them to a special celebration, please call the parish office so the event/celebration can be placed on the priests' calendars. Remember that the priests' schedule (appointments/meetings/invitations) is handled by the administrative staff of the parish.

THE LORD'S REAL PRESENCE

We are fortunate enough to worship in a Church in which the **Body of Christ** is **reserved**. It is right to acknowledge the **Lord's Real Presence** with a brief act of worship on **entering or leaving** the Church and **every time** passing by the Sanctuary. Normally, a **genuflection** in the direction of the place of Reservation is enough. One who is physically unable to genuflect may substitute a **profound bow** at the waist.

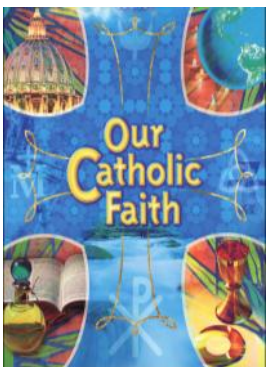

The entire liturgy of the solemn celebration of the Mass draws upon the natural, visible signs and symbols of human life to intensify and enrich the spirit of worship. The various colors of the vestments worn by the celebrant at Mass indicate vividly the triumph and mourning, hope and penitence, sorrow and sacrifice, of the Church.

GREEN. Symbol of hope, used on Sundays after Epiphany and Pentecost.

OLD ROSE. Symbol of subdued joy in a period of penitence, may be used on Gaudete Sunday (third Sunday of Advent) and Laetare Sunday (fourth Sunday of Lent).

BLACK. Symbol of death and mourning, used in Masses for the Dead

Sacrament of Marriage

Couples planning to marry at St. Gianna are expected to contact the priest to arrange a date and time **FIRST**. Second, they must attend the Pre-Cana conferences as mandated by the Most Reverend Bishop. The period of preparation for marriage is a minimum of **six** months to ensure completion of all arrangements before the wedding day. Please contact the parish office for more information.

Baptisms are celebrated on the last Saturday of the month at 11:00 AM in the parish church. Please call the parish office to make the necessary arrangements two months prior to the Baptism date. Parents are expected to attend a Pre-Jordan Baptism class which is to be held on the **last Friday** of every month at 7:30PM in the Parish Hall.

REQUESTS FOR ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATES

The role of a sponsor is primarily a Spiritual role to model a Christian life for the child. Therefore, anyone requesting a certificate **must** be a registered, **participating** member of St. Gianna Beretta Molla Parish, a **practicing** Catholic in good standing (not living in violation of the Church laws), at least 16 years of age and **have received the sacraments of initiation** (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist). Please call the Parish office to make an appointment.

Requirements for Godparents in the Catholic Church

- ◆ They must be chosen by the parents or those acting in their place, and have the capacity and intention to serve as godparents.
- ◆ They must be at least 16 years old.
- ◆ They must be baptized, confirmed, and have received the Eucharist.
- ◆ They must be Catholics who lead a life of faith in keeping with their role.
- ◆ If married, they must be in a valid Catholic marriage.
- ◆ A letter of "sponsorship" is required for those godparents who are not members of this parish.

In order to keep our records up to date and also stop the mailing of contribution envelopes during the summer/winter months, please note that we would appreciate hearing from parishioners who are summer residents in our parish before they move away. Thank you for your cooperation.

Easter Duty Obligation

After they have received their First Holy Communion, Catholics are bound by the obligation of receiving Holy Communion at least once a year. This precept should be fulfilled during the Easter Season. Catholics are also bound to confess serious (mortal) sins at least once a year, but this is not limited to the Lenten/Easter Season. The time for fulfilling the Paschal Precept (Easter Duty) extends from the First Sunday of Lent, March 9, 2025 to the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, **June 15, 2025.**
