June-Month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus

No matter how lonely or terrible the circumstances of our lives may be, this one truth can console and give us inner strength and peace that nothing can take away. The truth we must never forget is this: *Christ loves each one of us deeply and personally. No matter who we are, no matter what state of life we are in, Christ cares about us. He loves us. He loves us in a way we can't understand. He loves us with a human heart.*



He has told us this again and again. We read it in almost every page of the Gospel. We have proof of it in the way He gave up His life for us and rose again from the dead to make us one with Him and His Father.

He is readily available to each one of us in the Blessed Eucharist and in the Sacraments as truly as He was available to the woman who touched the hem of His garment or the dying thief who spoke to Him on the Cross. We put our faith, St. John tells us, "in God's love toward ourselves."

This great truth is kept uppermost in our minds by devotion to the Sacred Heart. The image of His Heart summarizes everything for us and evokes from us a response of love and service. St. Paul tells us that nothing can separate us from the love of Christ. This was the source of his inner confidence despite the evil and persecution about him. But, it was more than the source of his inner peace; it was the driving force of his work for the Church and his constant service to others. "The love of Christ spurs me on," he told friends.

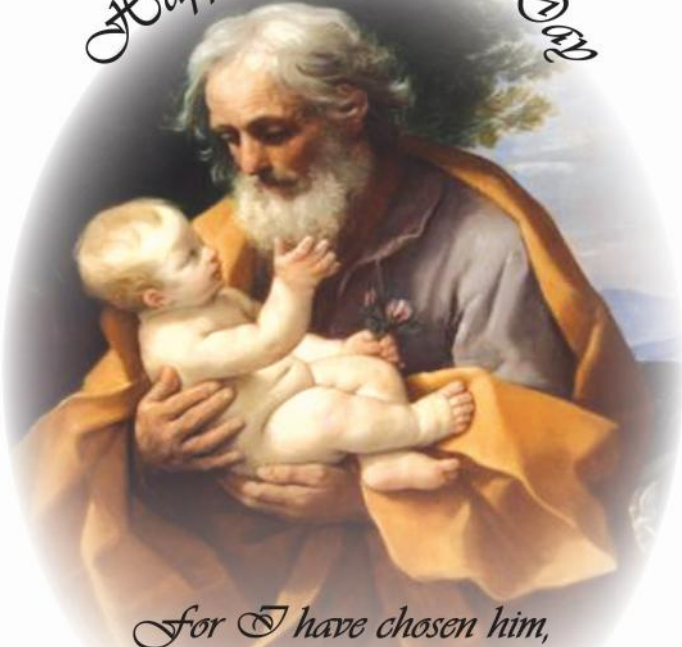

In order to serve the priests and the people of the parish in an orderly manner, we need **everyone's help**. Please note regarding:

Bulletin Announcements/Articles

While the parish is happy to place all articles/announcements you wish to appear in the parish bulletin we kindly ask you to please **submit those articles/announcements to the parish office on Mondays so we can reach the bulletin deadline.**

Please refrain from handling administrative affairs in the sacristy of the church, most especially before or after of any of the Liturgies. The sacristy is used by Priests, Deacons and Altar Servers preparing to celebrate the Liturgies, and distractions of this nature can easily disturb the holiness and the tranquility they need.

Pulpit Announcements: Due to time, Diocese and parish priorities, pulpit announcements are limited and subject to the Pastor's discretion. However, the announcements **MUST be submitted to the parish office FIRST, NOT to any of the priests in the sacristy of the church.**

Flyers, cards and/or propaganda in the church (*bulletin boards at the entrances of the church*). Our parish welcomes parishioners, visitors and friends to God's house every day. We are proud of the appearance of our church and our heartfelt thanks to those people working to keep God's dwelling in order, devoid of disturbing distractions, and preserving the décor and respect our Lord deserves. We ask you to please remember that:

- ◆ NO announcements/articles and/or propaganda of any kind are permitted on the *Main Bulletin Boards* placed in the gathering area of the church
- ◆ Flyers of events that are not taking place in our parish are welcome to be placed at any of the four bulletin boards (side entrances of the church). However, they need to be submitted to the parish for pastoral approval **NOT to the priests in the sacristy of the church.**

Private meetings & invitations to the parish priests: If you would like to make an appointment to meet with one of the priests or invite them to a special celebration, please call the parish office so the event/celebration can be placed on the priests' calendars. Remember that the priests' schedule (appointments/meetings/invitations) is handled by the administrative staff of the parish.

THE LORD'S REAL PRESENCE

We are fortunate enough to worship in a Church in which the **Body of Christ** is **reserved**. It is right to acknowledge the **Lord's Real Presence** with a brief act of worship on **entering or leaving** the Church and **every time** passing by the Sanctuary. Normally, a **genuflection** in the direction of the place of Reservation is enough. One who is physically unable to genuflect may substitute a **profound bow** at the waist.

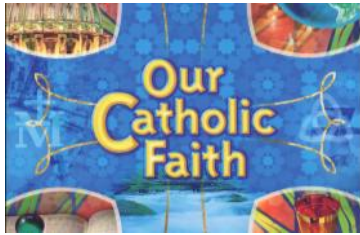

WHO IS THE HOLY SPIRIT?

The Holy Spirit is God and the third Person of the Blessed Trinity. The Holy Spirit is the Love between the Father and the Son.

Symbols for the Holy Spirit are:

- 1- The dove, a symbol of love
- 2- Tongues of fire, also symbols of love
- 3- the wind, the "breath of God," a symbol of the unseen power of love

The Holy Spirit sanctifies souls through the gift of grace which is Christ's life in us. There are two kinds of grace:

- 1- Sanctifying grace
- 2- Actual grace
 - Sanctifying grace: first makes us holy and pleasing to God; second, makes us adopted children of God; third, makes us temples of the Holy Spirit; fourth, gives us the right to heaven.
 - Actual grace is a supernatural help of God which enlightens our mind and strengthens our will to do good and to avoid evil.

All the special helps that God gives us are actual graces. He gives us these helps when we need them and as long as we need them. The principal ways of obtaining grace are prayer and the sacraments, especially the Holy Eucharist.

REQUESTS FOR ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATES

The role of a sponsor is primarily a Spiritual role to model a Christian life for the child. Therefore, anyone requesting a certificate **must** be a registered, **participating** member of St. Gianna Beretta Molla Parish, a **practicing** Catholic in good standing (not living in violation of the Church laws), at least 16 years of age and **have received the sacraments of initiation** (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist). Please call the Parish office to make an appointment.

Requirements for Godparents in the Catholic Church

- ◆ They must be chosen by the parents or those acting in their place, and have the capacity and intention to serve as godparents.
- ◆ They must be at least 16 years old.
- ◆ They must be baptized, confirmed, and have received the Eucharist.
- ◆ They must be Catholics who lead a life of faith in keeping with their role.
- ◆ If married, they must be in a valid Catholic marriage.
- ◆ A letter of "sponsorship" is required for those godparents who are not members of this parish.

In order to keep our records up to date and also stop the mailing of contribution envelopes during the summer/winter months, please note that we would appreciate hearing from parishioners who are summer residents in our parish before they move away. Thank you for your cooperation.

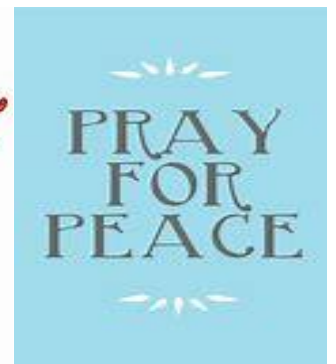

Junio-Mes del Sagrado Corazón de Jesús

No importa cuán solitarias o terribles puedan ser las circunstancias en nuestras vidas, esta única verdad puede consolarnos y darnos fuerza interior y paz que nada nos puede quitar. La verdad que nunca debemos olvidar es esta: Cristo ama a cada uno de nosotros profunda y personalmente. No importa quiénes seamos, no importa en qué estado de vida nos encontremos, Cristo se preocupa por nosotros. Él nos ama. Él nos ama de una manera que podemos entender. Él nos ama con un corazón humano. Nos lo ha dicho una y otra vez. Lo leemos en casi todas las páginas del Evangelio. Tenemos prueba de ello en la forma en que entregó Su vida por nosotros y resucitó de entre los muertos para hacernos uno con Él y Su Padre. Él está disponible para cada uno de nosotros en la Bendita Eucaristía y en los Sacramentos tan verdaderamente como estuvo disponible para la mujer que tocó el borde de Su manto o el ladrón moribundo que le habló en la Cruz. Ponemos nuestra fe, nos dice San Juan, “en el amor de Dios hacia nosotros mismos”. Esta gran Verdad se mantiene en primer plano en nuestra mente mediante la devoción al Sagrado Corazón.
