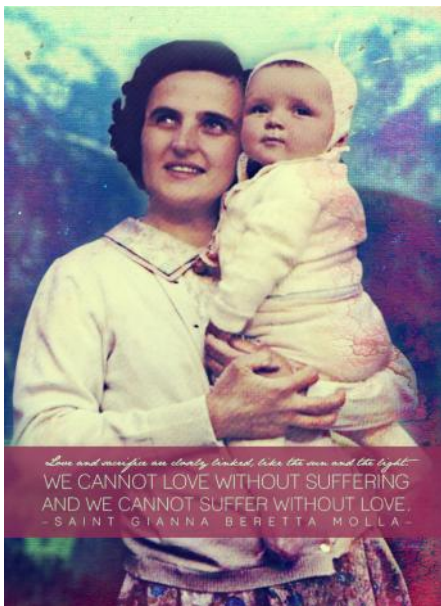

## July- Month of the Most Precious Blood

### *Divine Blood Transfusion*

**I**magine, if you will; a man lying on a hospital bed motionless, eyes closed, breathing so shallow that the faint movement is hard to detect. He is dying. The natural color of life has left his face. His heart has all but stopped beating. With closed eyes he sees not his friends standing about his bed; anxiously concerned about his condition. Nor does he hear their sobs; asking, "Can't something be done to help him?" "Yes, something more can be done, which we shall try shortly, says the doctor, a blood transfusion may help. We are locating a matching donor, and through the assistance of medical instruments the blood of the well man will flow into the body of the sick one."

A change comes over the sick man. Why, it is almost a miracle! He moves! Color returns to his features! His eyes open! He speaks! He is now on the way to recovery. And it doesn't take long before he is completely well. The dying man is alive! Not because of his own blood, but because of someone else's blood. **The dying man living on the blood of his friend.** A blood transfusion is a marvelous thing. Still more marvelous are its effects. A miracle in the very truth.

**You and I are dying.** It is our immortal nature that is in such bad shape. Our soul is dying. A blood transfusion is the **ONLY** thing that will save us. Because our soul is immortal and its destiny is eternal, no human help, no human blood can save us. The only one who can save us is one that is "large" enough; one who is at least equal to our immortality and eternity. More than such a helper is our Savior.

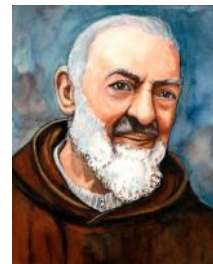
Jesus offers His Blood to us. We receive it, live by it in the Sacraments, especially in Holy Communion. In Holy Communion, a blood transfusion takes place. Our Soul receive life and strength, for our heart pumps and in our veins flow the Blood of God within us. We who before were weak and anemic, yes, destined for certain doom, now gather strength and vigor. As the "death" of the soul would have lasted forever, so now its life, nourished on the **Blood of the Lamb, is Eternal. Holy Communion - Divine Blood.**

Transfusion! Never fear! No one, nothing can hurt you. Jesus is with you. Not even death, bodily or spiritually. Jesus conquered them both. Now He imparts His own strength, His own life, to you, for **HIS OWN BLOOD** flows in you! Fear nothing! There is help - unfailing help - for **EVERYONE!** It has to, for **HE** bled for each one. His Sacred Body was tapped for all of us on Calvary. The Host delivers that Blood to our body and soul the moment it touches our tongue in Holy Communion. And --- **WE LIVE!** If a physical blood transfusion is a miracle, what are we to say of the wonders of the Divine Blood Transfusion - Holy Communion. We who before were dying-dead-live! We live on the Blood of our friend! We live in Godly royalty! Eternally! **"And I live, now not I: but Christ lives in me."** (Gal. 2:20)

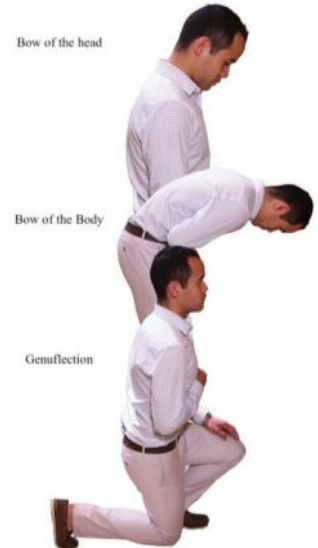

# Friendly Reminders



## ETIQUETTE AT MASS

**Reverence** – When you enter a church, you should bless (cross) yourself with Holy Water to remind yourself of your baptism and the fact that you are entering a sanctified place. We are fortunate enough to worship in a church in which the **Body of Christ is reserved**. The red light (sanctuary light) placed above the main altar indicates that **Jesus is present in the tabernacle**. It is right to acknowledge the **Lord's Real Presence** with a brief act of worship on *entering or leaving* the church and *every* time passing by the Sanctuary. Normally, a genuflection on one knee in the direction of the place of reservation is enough. One who is physically unable to genuflect may substitute a simple bow at the waist. When the Blessed Sacrament is exposed as in Benediction or Adoration, a genuflection on both knees is required. Do not try to bend both knees at once: go down on one knee, then the other, and then back up the same way. During Mass, a simple bow from the waist is required in the reciting of the Creed during the words *“by the power of the Holy Spirit, he was born of the Virgin Mary, and became man”* (this is to honor the chief Mystery of our Faith, the Incarnation). It is also traditional to bow the head slightly at the name of Jesus during prayer, especially at Mass. Also, right before the Gospel reading is proclaimed, we make a small cross on our foreheads, lips, and breast so the Gospel may be in our minds, words, and hearts.



**Taking a Seat** – Please, consider moving toward the center of the pew. This helps everyone to find a seat with the least amount of disruption to others.

**Cell Phone** – Please, TURN OFF or SILENCE your cell phones before entering the church.



**Parking** – Be considerate to others. DO NOT park in such a way that you are blocking someone else. In addition, if you do not want to have your car towed, please DO NOT PARK in the areas around our church where there's a “NO PARKING” sign. These zones are CLEARLY marked and violators will – without exception – be towed.

**Dressing For Mass** – When we are invited to a wedding, many of us wonder, “What am I going to wear?” We wouldn't think of showing up at a wedding or another formal event in our gym clothes. How many of us search for just the right outfit to wear to our annual coffee party or on a date? Compare that to how much thought we put into what we wear to Mass on Sunday. How we dress for an occasion indicates the importance that we place upon that particular celebration. At Mass, we encounter God through the Liturgy of the Word and the Liturgy of the Eucharist. Dressing appropriately for Mass is one way that we show respect, both for God and for our faith family. This respect is important at all Masses-no matter what time of day or night.



**The celebration of Mass is always a holy occasion, and thus should be treated in the most holy manner – in body, mind, and spirit.**



Almighty and eternal God, you have appointed your only-begotten Son the Redeemer of the world, and willed to be appeased by his Blood. Grant we beg of you, that we may worthily adore this price of our salvation, and through its power be safeguarded from the evils of the present life, so that we may rejoice in its fruits forever in heaven. Please make every effort to arrive on time for the start of Holy Mass, which **begins** with the **Sign of the Cross** and **ends** with the dismissal, **"Go in Peace."** It is the Lord we insult when we do not give Him our time. He is never too busy to be with us!

## Sacrament of Marriage

Couples planning to marry at St. Gianna are expected to contact the priest to arrange a date and time **FIRST**. Second, they must attend the Pre-Cana conferences as mandated by the Most Reverend Bishop. ## REQUESTS FOR ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATES

The role of a sponsor is primarily a Spiritual role to model a Christian life for the child. Therefore, anyone requesting a certificate **must** be a registered, **participating** member of St. Gianna Beretta Molla Parish, a **practicing** Catholic in good standing (not living in violation of the Church laws), at least 16 years of age and **have received the sacraments of initiation** (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist). Please call the Parish office to make an appointment.

## Requirements for Godparents in the Catholic Church

- ◆ They must be chosen by the parents or those acting in their place, and have the capacity and intention to serve as godparents.
- ◆ They must be at least 16 years old.
- ◆ They must be baptized, confirmed, and have received the Eucharist.
- ◆ They must be Catholics who lead a life of faith in keeping with their role.
- ◆ If married, they must be in a valid Catholic marriage.
- ◆ A letter of "sponsorship" is required for those godparents who are not members of this parish.

**E**l Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica explica que el papel del padrino o de la madrina es ayudar a que la gracia bautismal pueda desarrollarse en el bautizado, actuando como colaboradores de sus padres o de quienes ocupan su lugar. Por eso los padrinos deben ser “creyentes sólidos, capaces y prestos a ayudar al nuevo bautizado, niño o adulto, en su camino de la vida cristiana” (CIC 1255). Este es un papel muy importante, ya que todos los miembros de la Iglesia de alguna manera tienen la responsabilidad de desarrollar y guardar la gracia recibida en el bautismo y ayudar a otros a hacer lo mismo.

### **¿Por qué la Iglesia pone tantas restricciones para poder ser padrino de bautizo?**

Es entonces deber del padrino asistir a los padres en la iniciación cristiana del que será bautizado y “procurar que después lleve una vida cristiana congruente con el bautismo y cumpla fielmente las obligaciones inherentes al mismo”. Cabe resaltar que es posible tener un solo padrino o madrina. No es necesario tener dos, pero sí es posible, mientras sea un hombre y una mujer.

**La Iglesia ha impuesto requisitos para que los padres puedan elegir a las personas correctas para esta misión tan importante.** El padrino o la madrina:

1. Deberá haber sido elegido por quien va a bautizarse o por sus padres, o por quienes ocupan su lugar; o, si faltan estos, por el párroco o ministro.
2. Deberá tener la capacidad para esta misión e intención de desempeñarla.
3. Deberá tener al menos 16 años. (El obispo puede establecer otra edad en su diócesis o el mismo párroco o ministro -por justa causa- puede considerar una excepción.)
4. Deberá ser católico, estar confirmado, haber recibido la Primera Comunión, y llevar una vida congruente con la fe y con la misión que va a asumir.
5. No puede estar afectado por una pena canónica declarada o impuesta legítimamente.
6. No puede ser el padre o la madre de quien se ha de bautizar.
7. De no estar registrado en Sta. Gianna, los candidatos a ser padrinos deberán presentar una carta de la parroquia donde practican su fe (letter of sponsorship).
