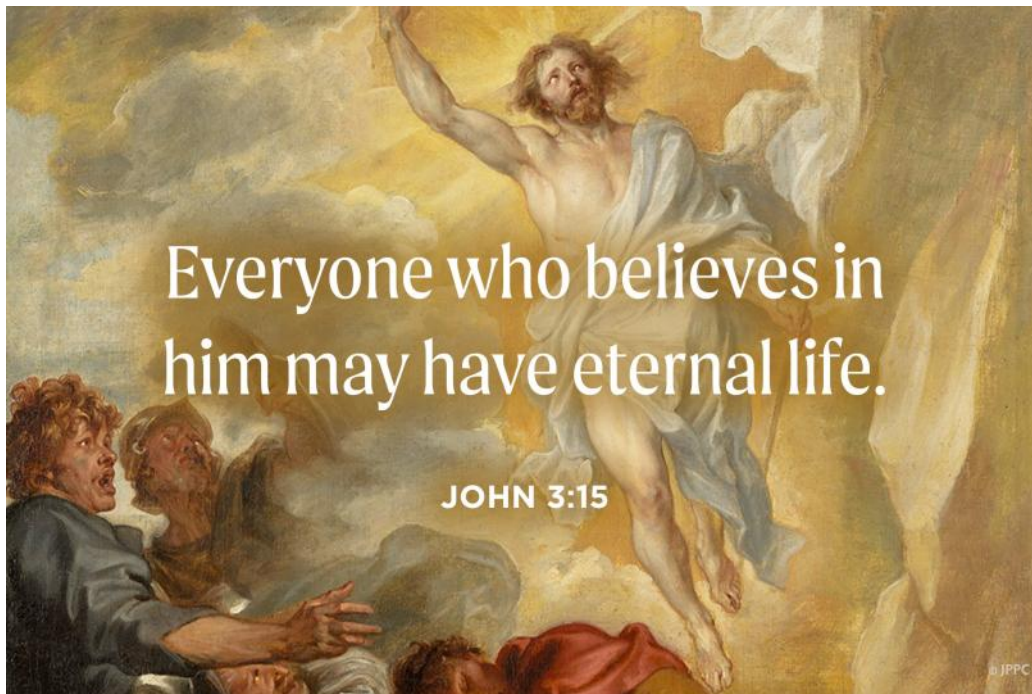

From the Pastor's Desk

FORTY HOURS DEVOTION

October 12, 13 & 14, 2025

PREACHER: *MOST REVEREND DENNIS J. SULLIVAN*

The "Forty Hours" or Solemn Annual Exposition of the Most Blessed Sacrament is a devotion aimed at increasing our appreciation...our love...our knowledge of the Most Blessed Sacrament. The devotion itself covers a period of approximately 40 hours. *Why 40 hours?*

Perhaps because 40 is a very Biblical number. Think of the instances in Sacred Scripture where the number 40 is used. Remember the 40 years the Israelites sojourned in the desert, but at the conclusion of those 40 years they entered into joy and thanksgiving into the Promised Land. Remember the 40 days and 40 nights Noah and his family spent in the ark, but at the conclusion of those 40 days, they left the ark and the flood and found dry land. Remember the 40 days and nights Our Lord spent in prayer in the desert, at the conclusion of those 40 hours Jesus began His public ministry of teaching and salvation. Remember the 40 hours Our Lord spent in the tomb after His Passion and death, but at the conclusion of the 40 hours Jesus rises from the tomb in Glory conquering sin and death once and for all. Remember the 40 days after Easter Our Lord spent with His apostles, but after those 40 days Jesus ascended to the Father to prepare a place for us in Heaven. And, so, during the "Forty Hours Devotion" we should try to become one with the Scriptural events just mentioned and walk and be with Our Lord in prayer and meditation. Notice that after every cycle of "40" something beautiful and meaningful happens. It is our prayer that as our Parish makes the "Forty Hours" we, too, will experience something beautiful – that whatever intentions you bring to Our Eucharistic Lord will be answered and that you, too, will experience the "good things of the Lord."

FORTY HOURS DEVOTION: *A Time of Opportunity*

Some member of every family...your family...should participate in the "40 Hours." Whatever sacrifices are involved, make them. You can be sure God will bless you for making them. Remember – the heart of the 40 Hours Devotion is the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. **Participate. Make a good confession. Receive the Holy Eucharist. Take advantage of every opportunity the Forty Hours offers you to become a better person...a better Christian...a better Catholic.** Make the 40 Hours a little Mini-Retreat for yourself, something meaningful to you. Give your heart and soul the treasure of the Blessed Sacrament!!

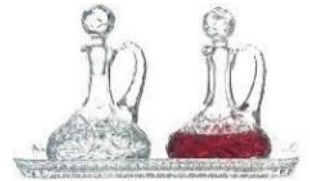


Calling All Boys and Girls - 4th to 8th Grade & High School

1. Because you will be so close to our Lord as He comes down upon the altar at Mass
2. Because you will *help* the priest to say Mass reverently since he relies on you to help him
3. Because you will have the honor of holding the *Mass book*
4. Because you will have the honor of assisting Father with the cruets that he needs to offer Mass
5. You will ring the *Bells* so the people are alerted to the most important part of the Mass, the Consecration when the bread and wine become the Sacred Body and Blood of Christ
6. You will carry the *cross* or *candles*
7. And so many other tasks you will be assisting with to make the Mass special and beautiful



To be an altar server will also be very rewarding because you will feel a closeness to God who will reward you with many graces and blessings!

To be an altar server will also help you to become a responsible person since you will have to be present at the Masses assigned for you to serve.

Father will be training all the boys and girls who sign up to serve Mass so that they will know exactly what to do and be comfortable at the Altar.

Girls and boys will be installed as altar servers at a special Mass on Monday, October 13th at 7 p.m. and will be outfitted in a "new uniform." You'll find out about it at our 1st meeting. 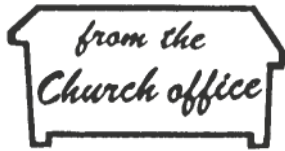

From the Pastor's Desk

The Anointing of the Sick and the Forty Hours Sunday, October 12, 2025

On Sunday, October 12th, we will open our Parish celebration of Forty Hours Devotion i.e., Solemn Exposition of the Most Blessed Sacrament. We, the Priests of St. Gianna Beretta Molla Parish, invite you to be *a part* of these three very special days. They are days filled with Spiritual growth for you and your loved ones.

We will begin with our celebration on Sunday, October 12th at 4:00 PM with the Sacrament of the Sick. The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is, as the words of St. James make clear, for the sick! It is no longer considered Last Rites. This Sacrament is for anyone who is sick, i.e., chronic sickness and also for anyone over the age of 65. In the Sacrament of the Sick, the Church extends the healing Hand of Christ to the sick. It is an encounter with Christ the Healer, Christ the Divine Physician. The woman in the Gospel was eager to touch only the Lord's cloak. "If I touch even His garment," she thought, "I shall be made well." The sick person today "touches" Him and experiences His power through the Sacramental Anointing. This Sacrament is NOT for people who are dead. It is for anyone who is ill. Won't you join us and welcome Christ into your life in this unique way? What more beautiful way to begin our "Forty Hours" than by recognizing Jesus, the Bread of Life, reserved in the Most Blessed Sacrament for our adoration and for the sick. **The Anointing of the Sick will be administered during a special Mass on Sunday, October 12th at 4:00 PM.**

THE LORD'S REAL PRESENCE



We are fortunate enough to worship in a Church in which the **Body of Christ** is **reserved**. It is right to acknowledge the **Lord's Real Presence** with a brief act of worship on entering or leaving the Church and every time passing by the Sanctuary. Normally, a *genuflection* in the direction of the place of Reservation is enough. One who is physically unable to genuflect may substitute a *profound bow* at the waist.

If You CANNOT Be on Time, Then Be EARLY.

Making Time For Prayer Strengthens Our Connection with God.

Please make every effort to arrive on time for the start of Holy Mass, which **begins** with the **Sign of the Cross** and **ends** with the dismissal, "**Go in Peace.**" It is the Lord we insult when we do not give Him our time. He is never too busy to be with us!

Sacrament of Marriage

Couples planning to marry at St. Gianna are expected to contact the priest to arrange a date and time **FIRST**. Second, they must attend the Pre-Cana conferences as mandated by the Most Reverend Bishop. Baptisms are celebrated on the last Saturday of the month at 11:00 AM in the parish church. Please call the parish office to make the necessary arrangements two months prior to the Baptism date. Parents are expected to attend a Pre-Jordan Baptism class which is to be held on the **last Friday** of every month at 7:30PM in the parish hall.

Requirements for Godparents in the Catholic Church

- ◆ They must be chosen by the parents or those acting in their place, and have the capacity and intention to serve as godparents.
- ◆ They must be at least 16 years old.
- ◆ They must be baptized, confirmed, and have received the Eucharist.
- ◆ They must be Catholics who lead a life of faith in keeping with their role.
- ◆ If married, they must be in a valid Catholic marriage.
- ◆ A letter of "*sponsorship*" is required for those godparents who are not members of this parish.

REQUESTS FOR ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATES

The role of a sponsor is primarily a Spiritual role to model a Christian life for the child. Therefore, anyone requesting a certificate **must** be a registered, **participating** member of St. Gianna Beretta Molla Parish, a **practicing** Catholic in good standing (not living in violation of the Church laws), at least 16 years of age and **have received the sacraments of initiation** (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist). Please call the Parish office to make an appointment.

Denuncie el Abuso Sexual



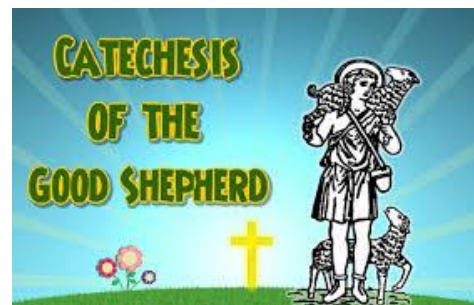
