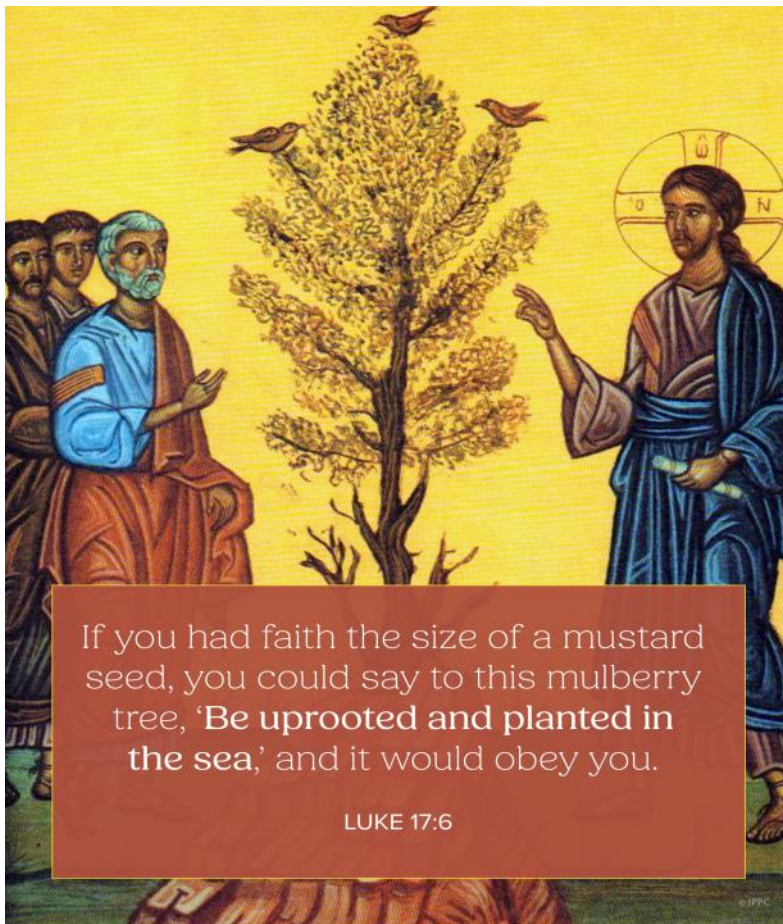

Forty Hours Devotion



Come and spend time with our Eucharistic King!

Pope John Paul II in his Encyclical letter "Ecclesia de Eucharistia" highly stressed the inestimable value of Adoration of Jesus in the Most Blessed Sacrament. He says,

"It is pleasant to spend time with Him, to lie close to His breast like the beloved disciple and to feel the infinite love present in His heart. If in our time, Christians must be distinguished above all by the 'art of prayer,' how can we not feel a renewed need to spend time in spiritual converse, in silent adoration, in heartfelt love before Christ in the Most Blessed Sacrament? Such adoration is a sign of gratitude, an expression of love and an acknowledgement of the Lord's presence."

Throughout the three days of our Solemn Annual Exposition you will have the opportunity to spend some quiet time with Jesus exposed on the Altar. Here is Jesus for you – He, Who not only humbled Himself to come among us as a man, but in the Eucharist, further humiliates Himself by coming to us under the frail appearance of a piece of bread! Here is truly a God who loves us! *What should you do during your hour of adoration?* You may bring your Bible and read significant passages from sacred scripture, especially Chapter 6 of St. John's Gospel. There will be adoration booklets available in the Church for you to use to help you in your prayer. You may wish to pray the Holy Rosary. Perhaps you just might want to sit and just "be" in the presence of your Lord God. When you begin your hour of adoration, make it for a special intention – perhaps you want to offer your hour for your family, a son or daughter who is having problems or who has been away from the Church; for peace; for good health; for a job, etc.... *Whatever it may be, the Lord is there to listen to you!*



The Anointing of the Sick Sunday, October 12, 2025

On Sunday, October 12, 2025 Saint Gianna Beretta Molla Parish will begin the celebration of Forty Hours Devotion. We, the priests of your parish, invite you to be *a part* of these three very special days filled with spiritual growth for you, your loved ones, and our entire parish community.

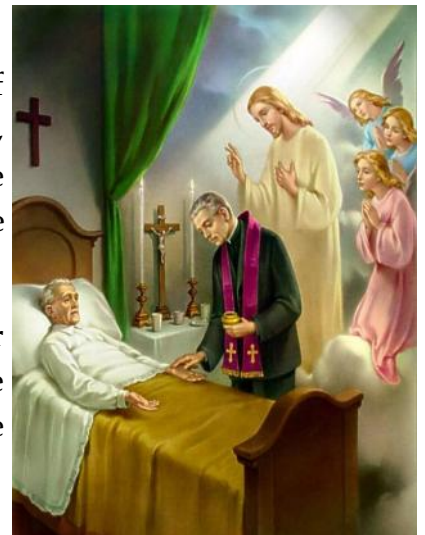
We will start the Forty Hours Devotion with the Mass of the Anointing of the Sick this Sunday, October 12, 2025 at 4:00 PM and will conclude with a Eucharistic procession and benediction at the end of the closing Mass on Tuesday, October 14, 2025 at 7:00 PM.



The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is, as the words of St. James make clear, for the sick. It is no longer considered *Last Rites*. This sacrament is for anyone who is sick and also for anyone over the age of 65.

In the Sacrament of the Sick, the Church extends the healing Hand of Christ to the sick person. It is an encounter with Christ the Healer, Christ the Divine Physician. Remember the woman in the Gospel. She was eager to touch the Lord's cloak. *"If I touch even His garment,"* she thought, *"I shall be made well."*

The sick person today "touches" Him and experiences Christ's power through the sacramental anointing. This Sacrament is NOT for people who are dead. It is administered during periods of illness to bring the person receiving it spiritual and physical strengths.



Won't you join us and welcome Christ into your life in this unique way? What better way to begin our Forty Hours Devotion than by recognizing Jesus, the Bread of Life, reserved in the Most Blessed Sacrament for our adoration and for the sick.

Calling All Boys and Girls - 4th to 8th Grade & High School

One of the most important things a young man and a young lady can do is to SERVE GOD at the ALTAR!! Why is this so?

1. Because you will be so close to our Lord as He comes down upon the altar at Mass
2. Because you will *help* the priest to say Mass reverently since he relies on you to help him
3. Because you will have the honor of holding the *Mass book*
4. Because you will have the honor of assisting Father with the cruets that he needs to offer Mass
5. You will ring the *Bells* so the people are alerted to the most important part of the Mass, the Consecration when the bread and wine become the Sacred Body and Blood of Christ
6. You will carry the *cross* or *candles*
7. And so many other tasks you will be assisting with to make the Mass special and beautiful



To be an altar server will also be very rewarding because you will feel a closeness to God who will reward you with many graces and blessings!

To be an altar server will also help you to become a responsible person since you will have to be present at the Masses assigned for you to serve.

Father Anthony will be training all the boys and girls who sign up to serve Mass so that they will know exactly what to do and be comfortable at the Altar. Girls and boys will be installed as altar servers at a special Mass on Monday, October 13th at 7 p.m. and will be outfitted in a "new uniform." You'll find out about it at our 1st meeting. Once everyone signs up you will be contacted with the dates and times of practices. They will be scheduled at convenient times so you can all make the practices. 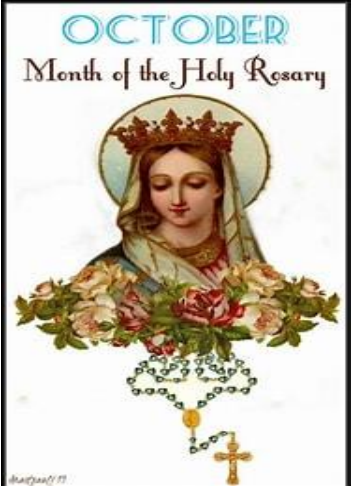

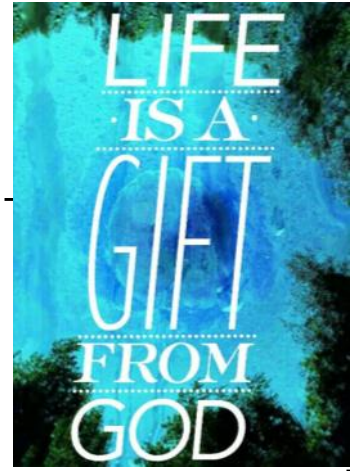

TAKE NOTE:



Baptisms are celebrated on the last Saturday of the month at 11:00 AM in the parish church. Please call the parish office to make the necessary arrangements two months prior to the Baptism date. Parents are expected to attend a Pre-Jordan Baptism class which is to be held on the **last Friday** of every month at 7:30PM in the parish hall.

Requirements for Godparents in the Catholic Church

- They must be chosen by the parents or those acting in their place, and have the capacity and intention to serve as godparents.
- They must be at least 16 years old.
- They must be baptized, confirmed, and have received the Eucharist.
- They must be Catholics who lead a life of faith in keeping with their role.
- If married, they must be in a valid Catholic marriage.
- A letter of "sponsorship" is required for those godparents who are not members of this parish.

Sacrament of Marriage

Couples planning to marry at St. Gianna are expected to contact the priest to arrange a date and time **FIRST**. Second, they must attend the Pre-Cana conferences as mandated by the Diocese of Camden. The period of preparation for marriage is a minimum of **six** months to ensure completion of all arrangements before the wedding day. Please contact the parish office for more information.

REQUESTS FOR ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATES

The role of a sponsor is primarily a Spiritual role to model a Christian life for the child. Therefore, anyone requesting a certificate **must** be a registered, **participating** member of St. Gianna Beretta Molla Parish, a **practicing** Catholic in good standing (not living in violation of the Church laws), at least 16 years of age and **have received the sacraments of initiation** (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist). COMO HACER UNA HORA SANTA

Lo que les escribo a continuación es solo una sugerencia de cómo hacer una Hora Santa durante la Devoción de las 40 Horas. Tu hora santa en frente del Santísimo Sacramento Puede ser dividida en media hora de meditación en silencio y media hora de oraciones vocales.

Por ejemplo:

1. 15 minutos: Santo Rosario
2. 15 minutos: Meditación
3. 15 minutos: Oración al Amor Divino
4. 15 minutos: Meditación



ORACIONES APROPIADAS

La Iglesia imparte Indulgencia plenaria a aquellos que rezan el Santo Rosario en presencia del santísimo Sacramento. Personas alrededor del mundo encuentran la oración a la Divina Misericordia de mucho beneficio espiritual porque combina todos los valores del Evangelio. El Santísimo Sacramento es el trono de misericordia, y rezar la oración de la Divina Misericordia es un camino seguro para pedirle a Dios que cubra con su misericordioso amor a todos los hombres de la tierra.

LA CORONILLA DE LA DIVINA MISERICORDIA

Para rezar esta oración, que se reza utilizando el rosario, se necesitan de siete a diez minutos aproximadamente, y es muy sencilla de aprender. Jesús dijo a Sor Faustina, "Rezarás este rosario de la siguiente forma":

*Primero, dirás un PADRENUESTRO, un AVEMARÍA y un CREDO.

*Después, en las cuentas del rosario correspondientes al PADRENUESTRO, dirás las siguientes palabras: *Padre Eterno, te ofrezco el Cuerpo, Sangre, Alma y Divinidad de tu amadísimo Hijo, Nuestro Señor Jesucristo, como propiciación de nuestros pecados y de los del mundo entero.*

*En las cuentas del AVEMARÍA, dirás las siguientes palabras:

Por su dolorosa Pasión, ten misericordia de nosotros y del mundo entero. Seguido por el GLORIA

*Para terminar, se debe de decir tres veces estas palabras: *Santo Dios, Santo Fuerte, Santo Inmortal, ten piedad de nosotros y del mundo entero.*

OTRAS ORACIONES QUE TAMBIEN PUEDEN SER REZADAS CON EL ROSARIO

1. *Corazón Eucarístico de Jesús, te adoramos y glorificamos en unión con los nueve coros celestiales*
2. *Corazón Eucarístico de Jesús, lleno de amor por nosotros, llena nuestros corazones con amor para ti*
3. *Corazón Eucarístico de Jesús, Venga a Nosotros Tu Reino!*
4. *Corazón Eucarístico de Jesús, haznos uno contigo, el Padre y el Espíritu Santo en corazón, voluntad*
5. *Corazón Eucarístico de Jesús, gentil y humilde de corazón, haz nuestros corazones a tu semejanza*
6. *Corazón Eucarístico de Jesús, a través del valor infinito de cada Misa que se ofrece ahora y hasta el fin del tiempo, ten piedad de nosotros y del mundo entero!*
