The Anointing of the Sick Sunday, October 12, 2025

This Sunday, October 12, 2025 Saint Gianna Beretta Molla Parish will begin the celebration of Forty Hours Devotion. We, the priests of your parish, invite you to be *a part* of these three very special days filled with spiritual growth for you, your loved ones, and our entire parish community.

We will start the Forty Hours Devotion with the Mass of the Anointing of the Sick this Sunday, October 12, 2025 at 4:00 PM and will conclude with a Eucharistic procession and benediction at the end of the closing Mass on Tuesday, October 14, 2025 at 7:00 PM.

The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is, as the words of St. James make clear, for the sick. It is no longer considered *Last Rites*. This sacrament is for anyone who is sick and also for anyone over the age of 65. In the Sacrament of the Sick, the Church extends the healing Hand of Christ to the sick person. It is an encounter with Christ the Healer, Christ the Divine Physician. Remember the woman in the Gospel. She was eager to touch the Lord's cloak. "*If I touch even His garment,*" she thought, "*I shall be made well.*"

The sick person today "touches" Him and experiences Christ's power through the sacramental anointing. This Sacrament is NOT for people who are dead. It is administered during periods of illness to bring the person receiving it spiritual and physical strengths.

Won't you join us and welcome Christ into your life in this unique way? What better way to begin our Forty Hours Devotion than by recognizing Jesus, the Bread of Life, reserved in the Most Blessed Sacrament for our adoration and for the sick.

FORTY HOURS DEVOTION

How to Make a Holy Hour

The following is just a suggestion as to how to make a Holy Hour. It may be divided into a half hour of silence and a half hour of vocal prayer.

1. First 15 minutes – The Rosary
2. Next 15 minutes – Quiet Prayer and Meditation
3. Next 15 minutes – Prayer of Divine Love
4. Last 15 minutes – Quiet Prayer and Meditation

Appropriateness of These Prayers

The Church imparts a plenary indulgence to those who pray the rosary before the Most Blessed Sacrament. People all over the world find the *Divine Love Prayer* very spiritually beneficial since it combines all the Gospel values. Because the Most Blessed Sacrament is the Throne of Mercy, the Divine Mercy Prayer is an effective way of asking God to embrace all mankind with His merciful love.

The Divine Love Prayer

Prayed on the beads of the Holy Rosary, this inspirational prayer is very easy to learn and to follow. Each prayer is repeated ten times, followed by a “Glory Be.” This Divine Love Prayer to the Eucharistic Heart of Jesus takes only seven to ten minutes to pray. It is prayed as follows: “Eucharistic Heart of Jesus, we adore You and we praise You in union with the Nine Choirs of Angels.” This is repeated ten times, followed by a “Glory Be.”

Below are some additional prayers that may be said on your Rosary beads:

1. Eucharistic Heart of Jesus, we adore You and we praise You – **in union with the Nine Choirs of Angels!**
2. Eucharistic Heart of Jesus, burning with love for us – **in flame our hearts with love for You!**
3. Eucharistic Heart of Jesus – **Thy Kingdom come!**
4. Eucharistic Heart of Jesus – make us one in mind, heart and will – **with You, the Father and the Holy Spirit.**
5. Eucharistic Heart of Jesus, gentle and humble of Heart – **make our hearts like unto Thine.**
6. Eucharistic Heart of Jesus, through the infinite value of each Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, offered now and until the end of time – **have mercy on us and on the whole world!**
7. Eucharistic Heart of Jesus, thank you – **for the personal love You have for me in the Blessed Sacrament**
8. Eucharistic Heart of Jesus, with all my heart – **I Love You!**
9. Eucharistic Heart of Jesus – **I put all my trust in You!**

Jesus will spend all eternity thanking you and loving you in Heaven for your faithful commitment on earth of spending one hour with Him in the Blessed Sacrament. This hour Jesus wants you to spend with Him is spent any way you want. You may bring your own prayer books, use the books provided by the parish, read the Bible, pray the Rosary or just sit and enjoy the sweet peace that comes from simply being in the presence of God. You may feel you can't pray well. Don't let this discourage you. The mere fact that you take time out, at a specific time, to spend an hour with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament pleases Him very much and is in itself a prayer of great faith.

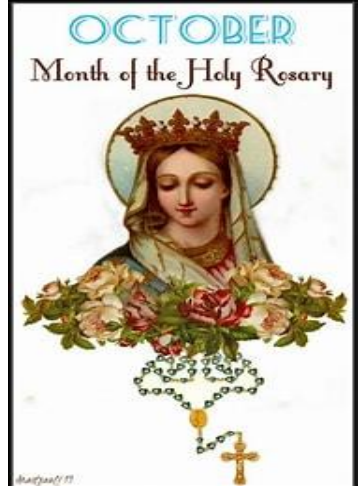

Baptisms are celebrated on the last Saturday of the month at 11:00 AM in the parish church. Please call the parish office to make the necessary arrangements two months prior to the Baptism date. Parents are expected to attend a Pre-Jordan Baptism class which is to be held on the **last Friday** of every month at 7:30PM in the parish hall.

Requirements for Godparents in the Catholic Church

- They must be chosen by the parents or those acting in their place, and have the capacity and intention to serve as godparents.
- They must be at least 16 years old.
- They must be baptized, confirmed, and have received the Eucharist.
- They must be Catholics who lead a life of faith in keeping with their role.
- If married, they must be in a valid Catholic marriage.
- A letter of "sponsorship" is required for those godparents who are not members of this parish.

Sacrament of Marriage

Couples planning to marry at St. Gianna are expected to contact the priest to arrange a date and time **FIRST**. Second, they must attend the Pre-Cana conferences as mandated by the Diocese of Camden. The period of preparation for marriage is a minimum of **six** months to ensure completion of all arrangements before the wedding day. Please contact the parish office for more information.

ORACIONES APROPIADAS

La Iglesia imparte Indulgencia plenaria a aquellos que rezan el Santo Rosario en presencia del santísimo Sacramento. Personas alrededor del mundo encuentran la oración a la Divina Misericordia de mucho beneficio espiritual porque combina todos los valores del Evangelio. El Santísimo Sacramento es el trono de misericordia, y rezar la oración de la Divina Misericordia es un camino seguro para pedirle a Dios que cubra con su misericordioso amor a todos los hombres de la tierra.

LA CORONILLA DE LA DIVINA MISERICORDIA

Para rezar esta oración, que se reza utilizando el rosario, se necesitan de siete a diez minutos aproximadamente, y es muy sencilla de aprender. Jesús dijo a Sor Faustina, "Rezarás este rosario de la siguiente forma":

*Después, en las cuentas del rosario correspondientes al PADRENUESTRO, dirás las siguientes palabras: *Padre Eterno, te ofrezco el Cuerpo, Sangre, Alma y Divinidad de tu amadísimo Hijo, Nuestro Señor Jesucristo, como propiciación de nuestros pecados y de los del mundo entero.*

*En las cuentas del AVEMARÍA, dirás las siguientes palabras:

Por su dolorosa Pasión, ten misericordia de nosotros y del mundo entero. Seguido por el GLORIA

*Para terminar, se debe de decir tres veces estas palabras: *Santo Dios, Santo Fuerte, Santo Inmortal, ten piedad de nosotros y del mundo entero.*

OTRAS ORACIONES QUE TAMBIEN PUEDEN SER REZADAS CON EL ROSARIO

1. *Corazón Eucarístico de Jesús, te adoramos y glorificamos en unión con los nueve coros celestiales*
2. *Corazón Eucarístico de Jesús, lleno de amor por nosotros, llena nuestros corazones con amor para ti*
3. *Corazón Eucarístico de Jesús, Venga a Nosotros Tu Reino!*
4. *Corazón Eucarístico de Jesús, haznos uno contigo, el Padre y el Espíritu Santo en corazón, voluntad*
5. *Corazón Eucarístico de Jesús, gentil y humilde de corazón, haz nuestros corazones a tu semejanza*
6. *Corazón Eucarístico de Jesús, a través del valor infinito de cada Misa que se ofrece ahora y hasta el fin del tiempo, ten piedad de nosotros y del mundo entero!*
7. *Corazón Eucarístico de Jesús, gracias por el amor personal que tienes por mi en el Santísimo Sacramento*
8. *Corazón Eucarístico de Jesús, con todo mi corazón te amo!*
9. *Corazón Eucarístico de Jesús, pongo toda mi confianza en Ti!*

Jesús va a pasarse toda la eternidad agradeciéndote y amándote por haberte comprometido a pasar una hora con Él en el Santísimo Sacramento. Esta hora Jesús quiere que tu la disfrutes a tu manera. Puedes traer tu propio libro de oraciones o utilizar los libros que podrás encontrar en la iglesia. Puedes leer la Biblia, rezar el Rosario, o sentarte y hacerle compañía dejando que tu corazón se comunique directamente con Dios y disfrutar de la paz que viene simplemente de estar en su Presencia. Quizá pienses que no puedes rezar correctamente. Si ese es el caso, no te desalientes. El solo hecho de haber reservado una hora para estar junto a Jesús en el Santísimo Sacramento lo hace feliz y es en si una hermosa oración. Dios te espera. No lo abandones.
