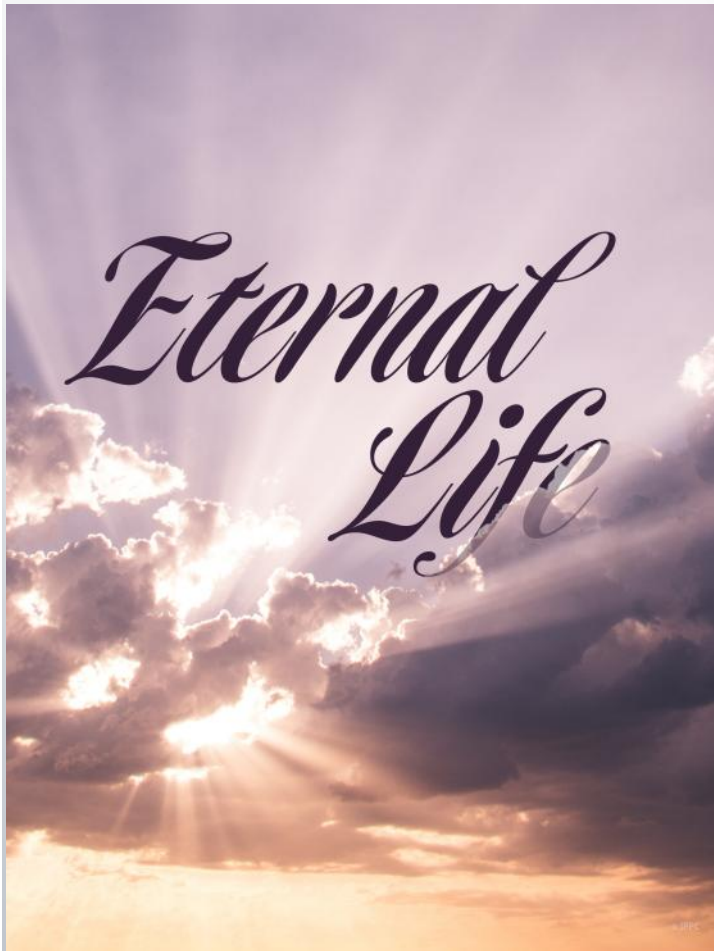

In order to serve the priests and the people of the parish in an orderly manner, we need everyone's help. Regarding the following...

Bulletin Announcements/Articles

While the parish is happy to place all articles/announcements you wish to appear in the parish bulletin we kindly ask you to please submit those articles/announcements to the parish office on Mondays so we can reach the bulletin deadline.

Please refrain from handling administrative affairs in the sacristy of the church, most especially before or after of any of the liturgies. The sacristy of the church is used by priests, deacons and altar servers preparing to celebrate the liturgies and distractions of this nature can easily disturb the holiness and the tranquility they need. Keep in mind that any kind of information, documents, registrations (with the parish, Religious Education/RCIA programs) and appointments are to be handled by the parish office ONLY – not the priests.

Pulpit Announcements

Due to time, diocese and parish priorities, pulpit announcements are limited and subject to the pastor's discretion.

Flyers, cards and/or propaganda in the Church (*bulletin boards at the entrances of the Church*)

Our parish welcomes parishioners, visitors and friends to God's house every day. We are proud of the appearance of our church and our heartfelt thanks to those people working to keep God's dwelling in order, devoid of disturbing distractions, and preserving the décor and respect our Lord deserves.

We ask you to please remember that:

- ♦ NO announcements/articles and/or propaganda of any kind are permitted on the *main bulletin boards* placed in the gathering area of the church
- ♦ Flyers of events that are not taking place in our parish are welcome to be placed at any of the four bulletin boards (side entrances of the church). However, they need to be submitted to the parish office for pastoral approval.

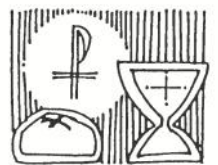

Deadline Dates on the Horizon!!

Due to the upcoming holidays, John Patrick Publishing has informed us of early bulletin transmission deadlines. We kindly ask you to please submit to the Parish office by **NOVEMBER 19th**, (either by mail or email) **ALL** articles/announcements to appear in the Parish bulletin **during the months of November AND December**. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.



Baptisms are celebrated on the last Saturday of the month at 11:00 AM in the parish church. Please call the parish office to make the necessary arrangements two months prior to the Baptism date. Parents are expected to attend a Pre-Jordan Baptism class which is to be held on the **last Friday** of every month at 7:30PM in the parish hall.

Requirements for Godparents in the Catholic Church

They must be chosen by the parents or those acting in their place, and have the capacity and intention to serve as godparents.

They must be at least 16 years old.

They must be baptized, confirmed, and have received the Eucharist.

They must be Catholics who lead a life of faith in keeping with their role.

If married, they must be in a valid Catholic marriage.

A letter of "sponsorship" is required for those godparents who are not members of this parish.

Sacrament of Marriage

Couples planning to marry at St. Gianna are expected to contact the priest to arrange a date and time **FIRST**. Second, they must attend the Pre-Cana conferences as mandated by the Diocese of Camden. The period of preparation for marriage is a minimum of **six** months to ensure completion of all arrangements before the wedding day. Please contact the parish office for more information.

REQUESTS FOR ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATES

The role of a sponsor is primarily a Spiritual role to model a Christian life for the child. Therefore, anyone requesting a certificate **must** be a registered, **participating** member of St. Gianna Beretta Molla Parish, a **practicing** Catholic in good standing (not living in violation of the Church laws), at least 16 years of age and **have received the sacraments of initiation** (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist).
