

From the
Pastor's Desk

My dear parishioners: To write you and say something meaningful and worthwhile on the birthday of Jesus Christ is not an easy thing to do. What can anyone say that God in His own silent way has not already said? God, our Heavenly Father says to us "I love you." And to show that love He has given to each of us a gift that is of the very essence of Him. When God sent His son, He knew it was not going to be as simple as it might first appear to be for He knew very well our hearts. He was familiar with the ways of human beings. We are not always people who see the value in the gifts that we are given. And we often take them for granted, as if we deserve them, as if they are owed to us. Many of us are spoiled with all we've been given over the years. God knew that we would treat His Son the way we treat everything else we receive as gifts. Some of us would reject Him, others ignore Him. But that didn't stop God. He knew that some would accept His gift of His Son with open arms, would treasure it, and treat it with the precious care it deserved. He knew some would love it and worship it. And that is why we have Christmas. But do you know what? I think we would have Christmas even if God knew there was going to be only one person who would accept His Son, even if you were that only person.

God loves you so very much that He would send his Son into the world to go through anything and everything necessary to bring you and you alone back to Him and into Heaven. Think of that! Imagine it! Christmas happened and continues to happen every year for you! No, not just every year – every day! God gives you His Son every day of your life – to live with you, to teach you, to comfort, and love you. And it all started in darkness, at night, in the cold of a little stable, while many people were asleep. Was there anyone present besides Mary and Joseph and the animals? Probably not – so God went out and found people He knew would appreciate what He was doing. We are told He sent His angels to tell the shepherds. The royal, the wealthy and wise would take a little longer to arrive.



I hope that you will receive some very lovely Christmas gifts, but let me remind you of Christ, *the best gift of all!!* But, if sadly, no one comes along with a beautifully wrapped present, be assured you are not being left out. God is not forgetting you. You have heard that all things are possible with God. Well, let me clue you in. There is at least one thing that isn't! It is not possible for God to forget you, to stop wanting to give you the gift of His Son and Himself. Christmas is a time for giving, and our Heavenly Father, the greatest Giver of all, shows us how to do it. Like He sort of slipped Jesus into the world, unknown to most everyone, we are to slip goodness into the lives of others without making them feel obligated to us, inferior to us, nor embarrassed by us.

I wish you a most wonderful Christmas day. May it be made merry by your growing awareness that God really loves you. He must, because He went to all the trouble of coming down here to show you. Like Mary, treasure this day and often reflect on all that happened – and what it means, “A savior has been born to you.” This is just the present we all need. Thank you for your prayers and support. 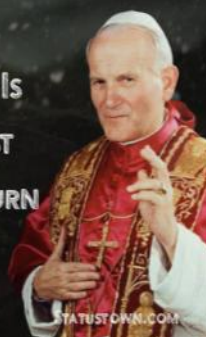

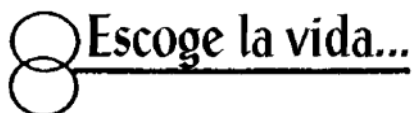

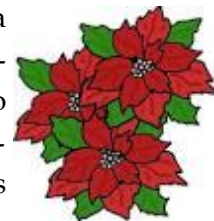
